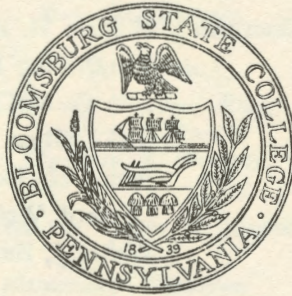

The Academic Costume

The academic costumes worn by members of the faculty have a special significance. The inside collar of the hood indicates the colors of the college or university which awarded the degree. The color of the outside rim of the hood symbolizes one of the following departments of learning:

Arts, Letters, Humanities - White
Business - Drab
Economics - Copper
Education - Light Blue
Fine Arts - Brown
Library Science - Lemon

Music - Pink
Philosophy - Blue
Physical Education - Sage Green
Science - Gold Yellow
Social Science - Citron
Theology or Divinity - Scarlet
