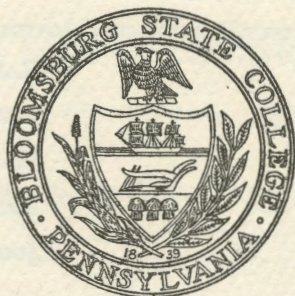

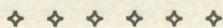

DR. EDWIN W. MARTIN

Dr. Edwin W. Martin was appointed Deputy Director of the Bureau of Education for the Handicapped in the United States Office of Education, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, in 1974.

When the Ad Hoc Subcommittee on the Handicapped was organized in the U.S. House of Representatives in 1966, Dr. Martin served as its Director. He organized the hearings and assisted with legislation and reports, which led to the passage of the Education of the Handicapped Act in November of that year. The new act provided for a program of grants to the states to initiate, expand, and improve educational programming for handicapped children, and established the Bureau of Education for the Handicapped and the National Advisory Committee on Handicapped Children.

As Director of the Bureau since 1970, he has had a leading role in articulating the need for a national goal of providing educational opportunities for all handicapped children by 1980. That goal became public policy through the Education of All Handicapped Children Act of 1975.

A native of Oceanside, N.Y., he received his Bachelor of Arts degree, with a major in English Literature, from Muhlenberg College in 1953, his Master of Arts degree in Speech from the University of Alabama in 1955, and his Ph.D. degree, with a major in Speech and Hearing Disorders and Pathology, from the University of Pittsburgh in 1961. He served on the faculty of the Speech Department of the University of Alabama from 1960 to 1966. He and Mrs. Martin have two sons, Scott and Bruce.
