




In fall and winter the student remains the same

With programs such as round-table discussions of classical authors, and group commentary on contemporary literature, the fraternity provides an interesting and informative outlet for English majors.





Serving double duty as head coach of wrestling and football, Russ Houk can be seen spurring the Huskies on the gridiron as well as the mats. In his third year as helmsman of the football team, he is working to establish a well-fortified team with depth and an ability to present a varied and respected offense.

BASKETBALL—EARL VOSS—Head Coach

Taking over the Varsity team after a 1965 record of 17 wins and 4 losses as coach of the freshman basketball team, Mr. Voss comes to the top position with an impressive backlog of basketball experience. He is a former captain of the West Chester State College basketball team, and as coach at Wilmington High School had a number of players who made All-State selections.

VARSITY SWIMMING COACH— ELI McLAUGHLIN

Coach McLaughlin came to head Bloomsburg's tankmen in 1961. In the past five years his concentration on building a well-rounded and experienced swimming team proved itself in the 1965-66 season. It was the year the team posted a winning season with a record of 8 wins and 4 losses, an impressive accomplishment when one considers the competition we face. McLaughlin, who has an extensive background as a swimming coach and is an active collegiate swimming official, hopes to continue developing the depth that is needed to build a championship swimming team. This year his sights are set on the Pennsylvania State College Championships, no easy goal, but one we know the ambitious coach and his team will work for in every way.

WRESTLING—RUSSELL E. HOUK

Since Coach Houk came to Bloomsburg in 1957, the grappling mats in Centennial Gym have never been the same. He has taken the Huskies to five Pennsylvania State College championships, three N. A. I. A. titles and one Wilkes Tournament title. In 1959-60, 1961-62, and 1964-65 the team was undefeated. Under his coaching, many of our wrestlers have claimed national recognition. He has given Bloomsburg one of its outstanding claims to fame in the sports area, teaching and inspiring

those who work for him to achieve the victories which give the name of the wrestling team a proud ring on Bloomsburg's campus.

GERALD MAUREY—Assistant Wrestling Coach

Behind every man on top, so the saying goes, there's a fellow who the man on top couldn't get along without. Mr. Maurey, coach of the Freshman wrestling team, has supplied the varsity with top notch material. He has had two undefeated seasons so far, and by the time you read this we hope he has had a third. A veteran of Penn State's mat squad, Maurey is a valuable asset to the wrestling program at Bloomsburg, providing the necessary foundation to the champion varsity team.

CROSS COUNTRY AND TENNIS— JOHN H. JONES—Head coach

Mr. Jones comes to the top position of the Tennis team as an experienced member of East Stroudsburg's varsity tennis squad. Last year, as coach of the Freshman team, he had a 2-2 season, and with those boys coming to the varsity, plus several returning lettermen, he is looking forward to a winning season in 1967. With the advent of indoor practice, beginning in January of this year, Jones hopes to have the squad in top condition for their first match.

The Cross Country team had a 2-5-1 record this year compared to an 0-8 record last year. The freshmen ran up an undefeated score of 5 wins and no losses under his coaching. On this basis Jones feels that next year's Cross Country will be the most impressive to date at BSC.
