AMERICAN WAR DEPARTMENT

SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM

REQUEST FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT DEFERMENT

The Military Selective Service Act of 1967 provides in pertinent part as follows:

“(a) The President, as hereinafter provided in this paragraph, the President shall, under such rules and regulations as he may prescribe, provide for the deferment from training and service in the Armed Forces of persons satisfactorily pursuing a full-time course of instruction at a college, university, or similar institution of learning and who request such deferment. A deferment granted to any person under authority of the preceding sentence shall continue in effect until such person completes the requirements for his baccalaureate degree, fails to pursue satisfactorily a full-time course of instruction, or attains the twenty-fourth anniversary of the date of his birth, whichever first occurs. . . . No person who has received a student deferment under the provisions of this paragraph shall thereafter be granted a deferment under this subsection. . . . Except for extreme hardship to dependents (under regulations governing hardship deferments), or for graduate study, occupation, or employment necessary to the maintenance of the national health, safety, or interest. . . . Any person who requests and is granted a student deferment under this paragraph, shall upon the termination of such deferred status or deferment, and if qualified, be liable for induction as a registrant within the prime age group irrespective of his actual age, unless he is otherwise deferred under one of the exceptions specified in the preceding sentence. As used in this subsection, the term ‘prime age group’ means the age group which has been designated by the President as the age group from which elections for induction into the Armed Forces are first to be made after delinquents and volunteers.”

1970-71 . . . a review


the editor of the 1969 obiter marked that year as the turning point of bloomsburg state college; in 1971 we seemed to still be turning as dr. nossen, in his second year at the helm, was finding it difficult to move far in any direction. an air of uncertainty settled over the campus.

throughout the fall of the year many people were surprised at the quietness that surrounded the many universities and colleges of our land. the hartford green—previously the scene of much demonstrating—was vacant and little noise came out of berkeley. student leaders were unable to interest their people in any sort of demonstration for apathy apparently had settled among them.

on the international scene the horrible war between nigeria and biafra ended with the latter's defeat. in the middle east egypt and israel signed a cease-fire and the united states and her allies in viet-nam launched a disastrous campaign in laos. we learned of the persecution of jews in russia. france's charles de gaulle died and spain's monarchy was re-established. in south america chile became the first nation to vote into power (legally) a marxist government, while in northern ireland catholics fought protestants. here at home milton shapp was elected governor of our state.

meanwhile at b.s.c. the students cast aside newly bought books and escaped into a world of amusement. the bloomsburg fair was upon us, followed closely by homecoming—that time of year when students democratically elect a group of girls to assume positions of royalty. with a parade, a football game and a concert we welcomed alumni back to b.s.c. while classes and the student union occupied our days the theatre occupied a few of our nights with entertainment of the finest quality. **marat sade, summertree, man of la mancha** and **time of your life** showed the college community the bloomsburg players could successfully present the most difficult of plays.

professors porter and skehan were dismissed, leading to unusual developments that continued throughout the year. a new system of registration was initiated—the computer overthrew the system of student choice. in january many students returned to find they had been removed (dropped) by a new academic policy. and finally, to top all things off, we learned that the sovereign state of pennsylvania was on the verge of bankruptcy which did nothing to lessen uncertainty on the campus. in may we remembered the kent state dead and in june we demonstrated support for athletic coaches.







the huskies ended the 1971 season with an impressive 5-3 record. this has been the best year since 1967, when russel houk compiled a 6-3 record.


wingback bob warner carried the ball 189 times gaining 801 yards for a 5.03 yards per carry average. dan steilfox had an outstanding 40.6 yards per punt record. neil oberholtzer kicked a total of 6 field goals, the longest being a conversion from 44 yards.

warner was the leading scorer with 52 points followed by oberholtzer with 29. fullback paul skrimcovsky and mike devereux had 18 each. bob firestine and mike kolojchick tallied 12, reserve fullback john rossi and john davis each had 6 points.

tom brokenshire did an excellent job filling in for injured mike devereux, after throwing for 264 yards. brokenshire threw for 493 yards and 4 touchdowns. their favorite receivers were; mike kolojchick, bob warner, bill firestine, and jeff white.

bill nagy received honorable mention from the national athletic inter-collegiate association. he was also named along with bob warner to the division 3 squad of the eastern collegiate athletic conference. the eastern division of the penn conference named bob warner and scott ketterman offense, and bill nagy and galen troop defense to their team.




at the state meet, floyd hitchcock and ron sheehan had first honors, mike shall second, and randy watts third honors.

this was truly a great year for this has been the toughest schedule the huskies have faced in the college's history, not to mention a series of injuries to key personnel.

the best single record was posted by sophomore "shorty" hitchcock. he racked up 19 wins and only one loss, this includes his 14 pins. mike shall posted an impressive 13-6-1 record with six pins. sophomore ron sheehan was injured twice during the season but ended up with a 9-6-3 record. all of these guys and others put together a great winning team.




bsc finished its 1970-71 basketball season with five straight victories. this enables the huskies to post an overall winning season of 11-9 and a pennsylvania conference record of 5-9.


leading scorer for the team was senior jim platukis, west hazleton, who averaged 20.7 points per game and was second leading rebounder with 11.7 per game. platukis climaxed his college career with outstanding performances in the final two games of the season against lock haven s.c. and shippensburg s.c. as a result of a 52 point two games total, hitting on .687 shooting and collecting 26 rebounds, he was named to the ecag all-east division III basketball team for that week. he received honorable mention in the year-end selections.

sophomore howard johnson, new castle, delaware, followed on the husky scoring list with a 15.9 ppg average and led the team in rebounding averaging 13.8 per contest. junior paul kuhn, lebanon, and senior dennis mummey, west hazleton, averaged 14.4 and 14.3 ppg respectively.

coach earl voss attributes the success of the fine team play of the final six games, starting with the cheyney game february 10, to the performance of sophomore art luptowski, ridley park, who, with his ball handling, ball hawking, and scoring, provided the spark that seemed to be missing most of the season. luptowski worked hand in hand with senior playmaker, tom wilson, elkins park, who led the team in total assists and kuhn, who was second in total assists. when luptowski broke into the starting unit, mummey was used as the sixth man to come off the bench for needed scoring punch.

coach voss has a fine nucleus of nine players from this years squad, plus several players from this year's freshmen squad, to form his 1971-72 aggregation.














editor's message . . .
