The husky, was named BU's official mascot in 1933 by a nearly unanimous vote. The first mascot, a husky from a professor's sled dog team, was named Roongo, a contraction of the school colors maroon and gold. From 1930's to 1950's real huskies served as BU mascots, most named Roongo. Mike Wasieleczyk '82 was the first person to don the husky mascot costume in 1979, beginning the spirited Roongo known and loved today. Celebrating every touchdown with pushups, stealing other teams' flags and getting the crowd pumped up for a victory. Today Roongo is seen at athletic matchups, campus events and in the community sharing Husky Pride.

Jan Hutchinson won more games than any other women's coach in the country during her time at BU (1977 - 2010)

Robert "Doc" Warren started the university's first social fraternity (Sigma Iota Omega) in 1964...earning him the title, "The Father of Fraternities"...he was also a history professor

Roy Smith, BU's "most interesting man" is the director emeritus of BU's Quest & Corporate Institute, whose adventures have taken him through many places around the globe

Danny Hale was one of the most respected members of BU Athletics, he holds the University record for most coaching victories

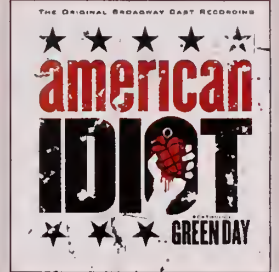


Celebrity Artist Series

Quest has been in operation since the early 70's and they now have over 35 years of outstanding reputation in the region. Quest offers exciting, educational courses, mostly at the beginner and intermediate levels, in Pennsylvania, the United States, Africa, South and Central America and Europe. 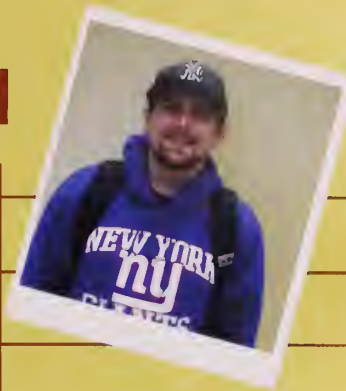
TRiO S.S.S. Student Support Services

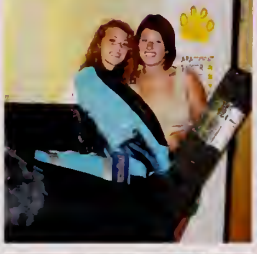

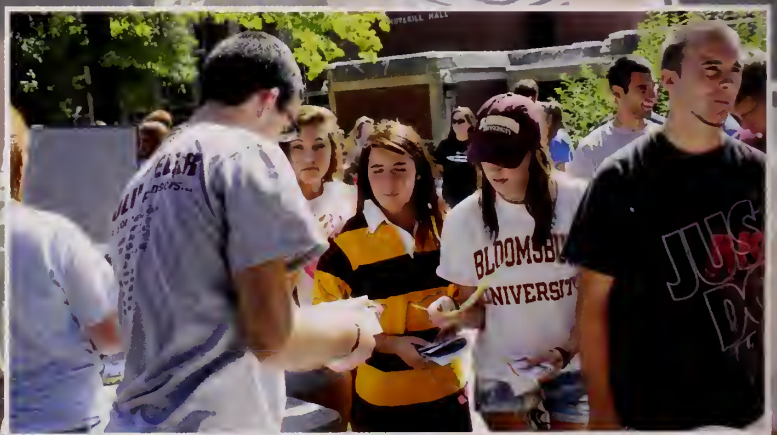
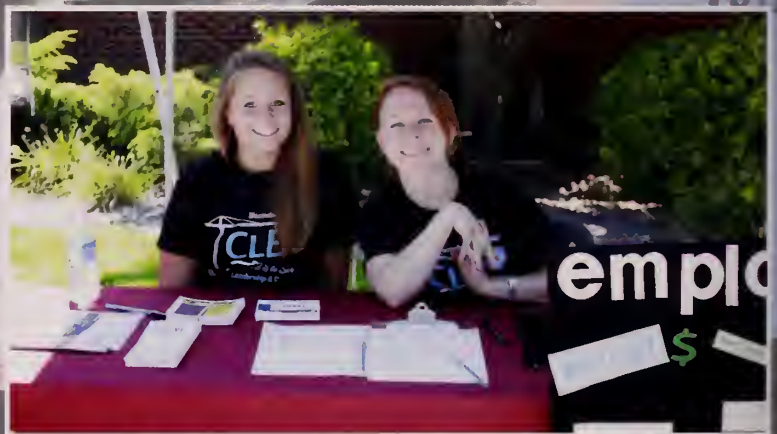
Move-in . . .

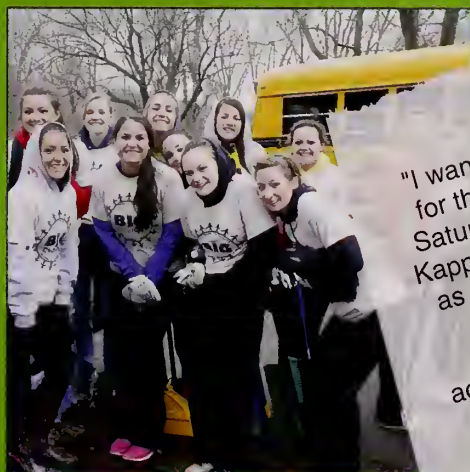

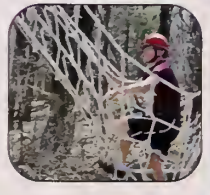
Siblings' & Children's Weekend 2014
