
The husky, was named BU's official mascot in 1933 by a nearly unanimous vote. The first mascot, a husky from a professor's sled dog team, was named Roongo, a contraction of the school colors maroon and gold. From 1930's to 1950's real huskies served as BU mascots, most named Roongo. Mike Wasielczyk '82 was the first person to don the husky mascot costume in 1979, beginning the spirited Roongo known and loved today. Celebrating every touchdown with pushups, stealing other teams' flags and getting the crowd pumped up for a victory. Today Roongo is seen at athletic matchups, campus events and in the community sharing Husky Pride.




"About 2 1/2 years"

"Was being so close to the players! I played football, baseball and basketball in high-school, but when I got to Bloomsburg I was a bit too small to try out for the team. It was so much fun being able to be on the field and dancing in the middle of the basketball court because, I always loved to be the center of attention!"

"I became Roongo after a few friends of mine and my girlfriend thought that I had the personality and energy to do it. I just kind of tried out and Tom (my boss) loved what he saw, so the position fit me very well. I am kind of like an energizer bunny and just have so much energy and will just keep going no matter how tired I get. I was also very skilled at doing hand stands and cartwheels before hand, so that helped my chances of becoming Roongo."

"The suit was probably the hottest thing I ever had to be in! I would sweat bullets every time, but didn't let it bother me. Also, the crowds were so much larger for the football games and its much easier to get them into the game and riled up!"

'For me, I just had a lot of fun being Roongo and that was enough for me! I am a very outgoing personable guy and I love kids, making people laugh and being center of attention. I enjoyed doing my hand stands, flips and working with the cheerleaders while being at the games. I gained a lot of experience as well, my boss Tom would send me to a few mascot camps and I was able to learn some more flips and tricks of the trade. It also helped me earn my internship with the Reading Fightin Phils baseball team. During the day I worked in the front office as an intern and at night I was the mascot for the baseball games. That was a very fun experience!"

'Of course I would do it all over again and if I had to go back in time, I would have tried out to be Roongo my freshman year. That way I could have done it for all 4 years! It was a great experience and so much fun and I miss it so much already!"
