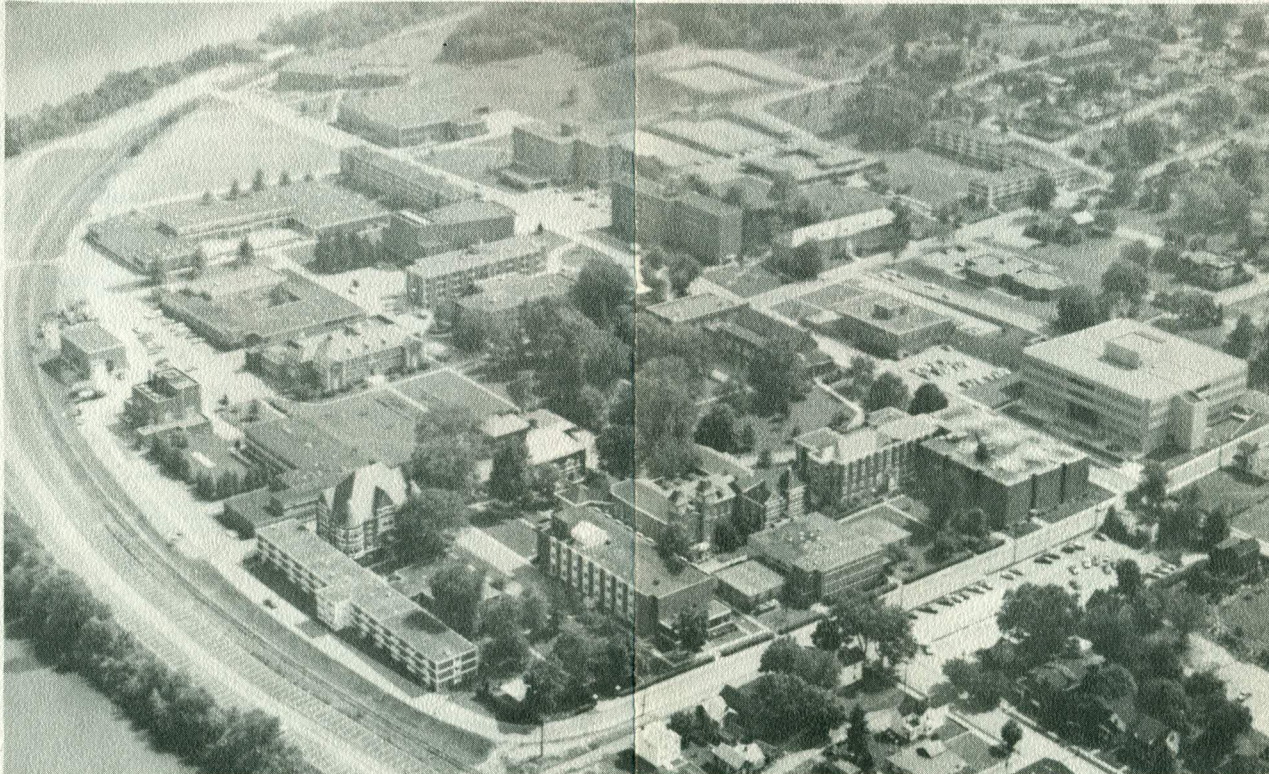
The School of Science and Technology offers degrees in 10 areas, with the Business Administration curriculum offering options in management, marketing, finance, accounting or economics.

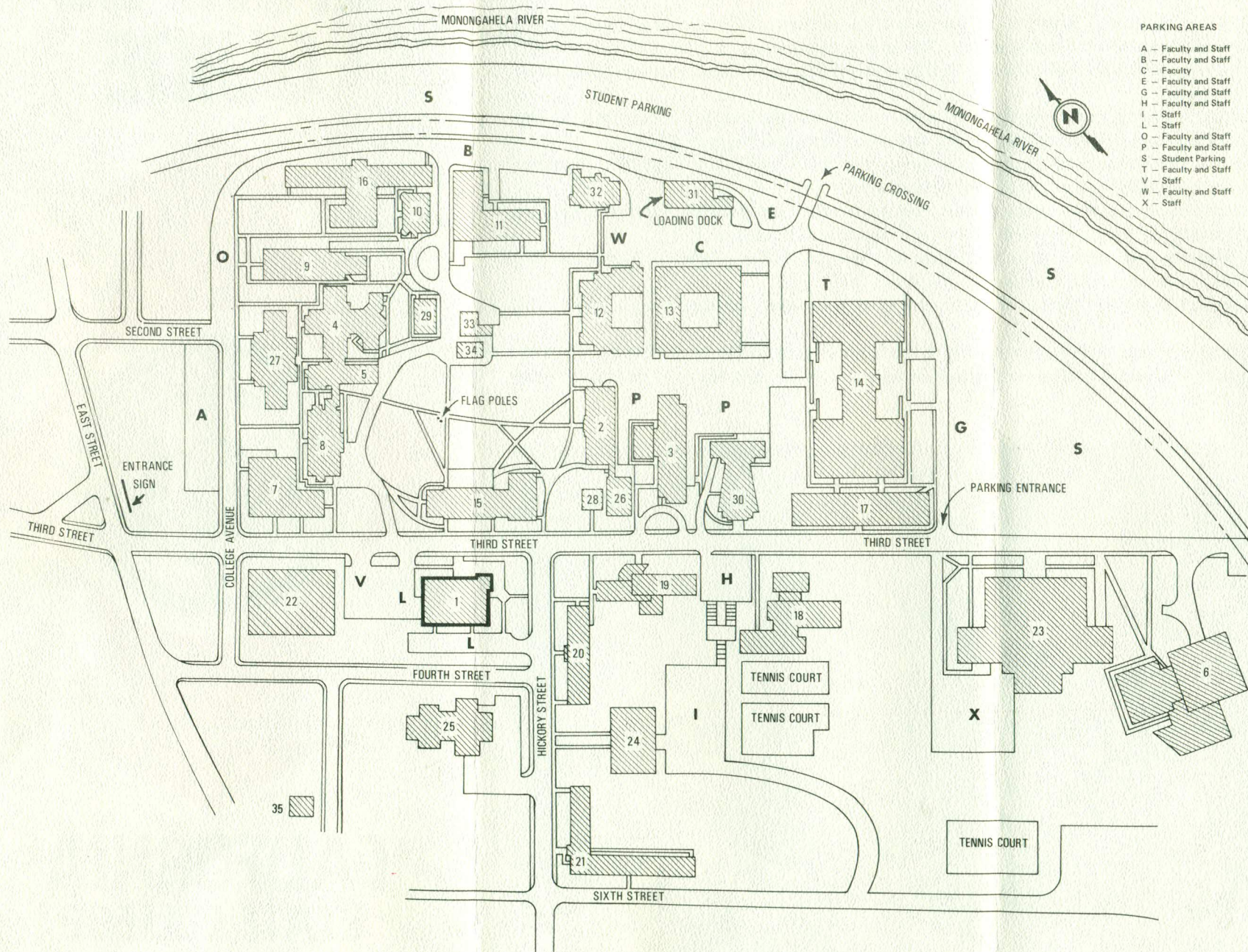
