California University, a proud member of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education, is eagerly moving forward in the 21st century, while remaining proud of its 154-year history. Although some of its structures date to the 1860s, others, such as Residence Halls D and E that opened fall 2006, are new and reflect the latest technology and innovation.

Cal U traces its roots to California Seminary, which opened in 1852. California has been a normal school, state teachers college and, since 1983, a university. The campus has grown over the years from a handful of buildings to 34, located on 92 acres. Our location along a bend of the Monongahela River is only 30 miles



from downtown Pittsburgh.

Students can choose from more than 100 undergraduate courses of study and 30 graduate programs, many online. In addition, Cal U offers associate

degrees and certification programs. Its mission is to build character and build careers, and Cal U has been nationally recognized for the excellent curriculum and its emphasis on character-building qualities.

The Welcome Center, located in the Eberly Science and Technology Center, provides visitors with additional information about the university. Explore all that our campus has to offer, such as the exquisite stained glass windows of Pennsylvania wildflowers in Grand Hall of Old Main. Old Main Park with its iron fence and trickling fountain reflects the look of the original campus.



The Founders' Garden, adjacent to Old Main, is a quiet oasis on our busy campus. Pick up a self-guided art tour from the Welcome Center and stroll through the campus. Don't miss the magnificent Ascent

of Humanity, on two walls of Duda Hall.

Off-campus, there are many activities to enjoy in the region including hiking, rafting, bicycling, canoeing, skiing, and horseback riding. Nearby shopping includes Washington Crown Center, Century III and South Hills Village malls, as well as quaint antique shops and specialty stores.

Pittsburgh offers fun from morning to night, including hundreds of restaurants, shopping ranging from boutiques to malls, professional baseball, football, and hockey, dozens of museums and galleries, and numerous musical, dance and performing art groups. 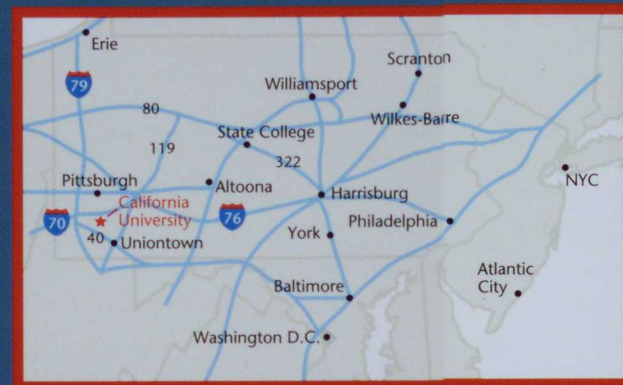
**FROM THE NORTH EAST (Scranton)**
