Manderino Library is dedicated to providing materials that support your classroom objectives. We encourage your students' research through subscriptions to premier online research databases, full of peer-reviewed, scholarly journal articles. We have a substantial collection of print and electronic books and journals, DVDs, and thousands of streaming videos on-demand.

Can't find it here?

Manderino Library can assist you with your own research needs. Our E-ZBorrow system can retrieve books from scores of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York and West Virginia libraries easily and quickly. If this system fails to find your materials, our Interlibrary Loan Office will work hard for you to obtain books and journal articles from libraries around the world.

Help us help your students

If you have a copy of a book you want your students to read, you can place it on reserve in the library. Your students will be able to use it for three-hour periods in the library. If you want your students to read an article, you can have it loaded into our **Course Reserves** system. This will provide your students with 24/7 access to it.

Information Literacy Instruction

It's hard for students to know how best to utilize all the resources the library has to offer. Our librarians, who are members of the faculty, can help your students become better researchers through in-class library instruction sessions tailored specifically to your course needs.

THE LIAISON PROGRAM

How we help you

Each academic department on campus has a librarian assigned to work with it as a library liaison. Your library liaison is an expert in knowing how to use the library's resources in your discipline. She or he has created an online **Subject Guide** within the library's website that directs students to appropriate discipline-specific research tools. When requested, your librarian can create class-specific guides that target particular research assignments.

You can work with your library liaison to get the books, videos, journals and other resources you need for your teaching. Contact him or her to arrange for an **Information Literacy Instruction** session in order to ensure that your students have the research skills needed to complete your assignments. Librarians are also available to make research easier and faster by providing **Research Services** to you and your students. Just contact us in the library to get started!

The library provides extensive, easy-to-use online research resources that are accessible wherever you are. Work on one of the library's first-floor computers, or in our third-floor Computer Lab. Borrow a laptop (or use your own) and work where you want within the building using our Wi-Fi network. Using your Cal U login, you can access library resources from anywhere in the world where you have Internet access. The library also provides meeting spaces and multimedia technology for collaborative projects, quiet nooks for focused, individual study, as well as amenities and activities for when you need to relax or let loose.

A universe of information at your fingertips.

Manderino Library focuses on providing materials that support the classes you take here at Cal U. We subscribe to a large number of specialized online research databases full of scholarly journal articles. Consistently reliable and reviewed resources are readily available to you. We have a substantial collection of print and electronic books and journals, DVDs, and thousands of streaming videos available online on demand.

You can search for the books you need in the library's catalog 24 hours a day, from wherever you happen to be. Log into your catalog account and you can place an **Item Retrieval Request**. Give us 24 hours and we'll find and gather your books off the shelves for you! Pick them up at the Circulation Desk.

We have many other resources to help you succeed at Cal U. Check our **Course Reserves** system to see if your professors have made their books available for in-library use.

If you can't find a book in our collection, we can order it for you from another library, generally free of charge. Students may use our E-ZBorrow system to request books easily and quickly from academic libraries across Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York and West Virginia. When items are not available using E-ZBorrow, they can be requested through our Interlibrary Loan Office.
