INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENT PRE-REGISTRATION
FOR FALL TRIMESTER 1965

Step I. PROGRAM OF STUDIES

- A. Arts and Science students must have a preliminary program approved by their adviser on file.
- B. Education students must have an adviser approved program of studies and curriculum projection on file with the department.

Step II. SCHEDULING

- A. At time and place announced for scheduling, accurately complete the schedule card and have it approved by your schedule adviser.
 - (1) Changes from the approved preliminary schedule must receive specific approval of the personal adviser or the dean.
- B. Take approved schedule to the tally post--wait for card to be completed and stamped; tallied.
 - (1) Do not schedule closed classes.

Step III. REGISTRATION

- A. Present approved tallied schedule cards (green edged).
- B. Pick up envelope containing all other registration forms.
- C. Dormitory students will secure dormitory application form and pre-billing instructions from Dean of Men or Dean of Women--135 Main Hall.
Non-dormitory students secure a copy of pre-billing instructions at the registration center.
- D. Fill in all cards completely and accurately.
- E. Have all cards checked and stamped.
- F. Take envelope containing all approved forms to Business Office window in Main Hall.

Step IV. PAYMENT OF FEES

- A. The Business Office will inspect the schedule card and the Bursar's fee card. You will receive a statement of fees and the date fees are due.

Step V. REGISTRATION DAY (September 30, 1965)

- A. Pick up grade report, if available.
- B. Pick up envelope with receipt and permit to attend class.
- C. Fill in general information cards.
- D. Freshmen and transfer students will have their picture taken.
- E. Go to the Library to secure or renew your Library card.
- F. Go to the Student Activities Office to pick up your Student Activities card.
- G. If you drive a motor vehicle (including Honda's and motorbikes), register your vehicle in the Dean of Men's office and receive a campus parking permit (bumper stickers) for Student lot (S).
