INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENT REGISTRATION

Step I. PROGRAM OF STUDIES

- A. Arts and Science students must have a preliminary program approved by their advisor on file.
- B. Education students must have an advisor approved program of studies and curriculum projection on file with the department.

Step II. SCHEDULING

- A. At time and place announced for schedule advising, accurately complete the schedule card and have it approved by your schedule advisor.
- B. Take approved schedule to the tally post--wait for card to be completed and stamped; tallied.

Step III. REGISTRATION - NEW DINING ROOM

- A. Present approved tallied schedule card.
- B. Pick up envelope containing all other registration forms.
- C. Fill in all cards completely and accurately.
- D. Have all cards checked and stamped.
- E. Take envelope containing all approved forms to Business Office window in Main Hall.

Step IV. PAYMENT OF FEES

- A. All students must pay their college fees by May 15, 1968, in order to complete the registration process.
- B. Residents of college dormitories on campus must pay the housing fee of \$272.00 by May 15, 1968.
- C. Residents of private dormitories off campus must pay the dining hall of \$144.00 by May 15, 1968. (Room rent must be paid directly to the Dormitory Manager according to instructions to be issued to residents in the category.)
- D. No student has a dormitory reservation unless (a) it has been assigned through the Offices of the Dean of Women or Dean of Men, and (b) the housing fee has been paid by May 15, 1968.
- E. The Business Office will inspect the schedule card and the Bursar's fee card. Once this has been done, the student will receive a statement of fees and the date the fees are due.

Step V. FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

- A. At the beginning of the term, students must report to the Library to secure or renew their Library Cards.
- B. Report to the Student Activities Office to secure or renew your Student Activities Card.
- C. Register your motor vehicle in Main Hall 135.

REGISTRATION

Registration for Summer Trimester will be held on Monday, June 3 from 8:00 to 3:00 p.m. in Herron Hall. Registration for Summer Session (in-service teachers, part-time students, etc) will be held June 4 from 8:00 to 2:00 p.m. in Herron Hall. Final registration for the Second Six-Week Session will be held July 15 from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. in Herron Hall.

ADMISSION

Teachers-in-service who have never attended California State College should request required application forms prior to registration day.

Students from other colleges should request required application forms prior to registration day.

SCHEDULE LIMITATIONS

College standards and Pennsylvania Department of Public Instruction regulations permit the earning of one semester hour of credit for each week of attendance during the summer sessions.

Courses carry resident credit and are offered only for the number of semester hours indicated after the titles.

HOUSING REGULATIONS AND ACCOMMODATIONS For 1968 Summer Sessions Only

I. GENERAL

1. In the Summer Sessions, dormitory facilities on campus are available for all who desire such accommodations.
2. All dormitory residents must accept an assignment to the college dining room.
3. Students who must have special diets that cannot be satisfied within the limits of the regular college dining hall menus should not apply for dormitory housing.
4. All requests for dormitory housing should be directed to the Dean of Women or the Dean of Men, California State College, California, Pennsylvania 15419.

II. HOUSING REGULATIONS FOR WOMEN:

1. All women students must reside in college dormitories unless they commute from their homes.
2. Sorority members may reside in their respective sorority houses if adult supervision is provided.

III. HOUSING REGULATIONS FOR MEN

1. All freshmen with the exception of commuters and fraternity members must reside in college dormitories.
2. Upperclassmen and transfer students may apply for dormitory housing and will be assigned in order of application.

FEEES AND DEPOSITS

The enrollment fee for the Summer Session is:

Elementary Curriculum	\$12.50 per credit hour
Secondary Curriculum	\$12.50 per credit hour
Industrial Arts Curriculum	\$6.00 and \$12.50 per credit hour
Special Education Curriculum	\$6.00 and \$12.50 per credit hour
Liberal Arts Curriculum	\$12.50 per credit hour

For all curriculums there is a minimum charge of \$37.50.

Out-of-state residents must pay \$20.00 per credit plus curriculum fees. An additional contingent fee of \$1.00 a day is charged those who enroll after the date officially set for registration, provided that the total amount of this late registration fee will not exceed \$5.00.

The housing fee, which includes room and board, is \$17.00 per week.

All fees must be paid in full at the time of registration.

Checks must be made payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the exact amount of the fees. Do not include the Activity Fee on the same check.

ACTIVITY FEE

An activity fee is charged every student. Students taking a Six or Twelve Week Session are to pay \$5.00 per registration. Checks are made payable to Student Activity Fund.

(Fees are subject to change, without notice, upon approval of the Board of Trustees and the Superintendent of Public Instruction.)
