#### Commonwealth University Announces Dean's and President's Lists

Commonwealth University congratulates more than 2,350 students who were named to the Fall 2023 Dean's List and more than 775 students who were named to the President's List.

The lists, prepared at the end of each semester, recognize those students who have achieved academic distinction. To qualify for the Dean's List, the student must have earned a GPA of at least 3.50, on a 4.0 scale, in 12 or more semester hours of letter grades. To qualify for the President's List, the student must have earned a GPA of 4.0 or higher.

Starting Oct. 1, 2024, Creative Cloud Synced files will be discontinued for business accounts associated with organizations that existed before Dec. 11, 2023 (learn more <a href="here">here</a>).
