

Director's Statement

Every University Art Student Exhibition is different. Each exhibition is formed according to the type of art work submitted, the quantity and quality of the entries, and the aesthetic taste and expertise of the juror(s). This year the selected show indicates concern both with the making of art (and the very nature of art) and with personal expression with ideas basic to content and with references to today's culture.

My regret is that when so much exciting quality art work is submitted for exhibition that we cannot include all of the art that deserves to be seen because of lack of exhibition space. So what is shown is simply a representation of a larger body of art work also possessing much artistic merit and value.

There were 251 entries for the exhibition entered by 108 graduate and undergraduate students. Sixty-three works of art representing forty-one students were chosen for display by our juror, Texas artist and educator, Susan Galey. The result is an exhibition that is varied in approach and media and compelling in visual and ideational appeal.

Juror's Statement

Pieces of art work submitted to the 1994 Spring Exhibition reflected the many diverse trends and directions of this century. The role I have taken as juror has been to select works not necessarily representative of

current social or political trends but to choose pieces by students who produce work of high personal integrity and who demonstrate the potential for mastery of their media.

While submissions were made by students of all ages and experiences, the selected pieces were those that achieved the highest levels of both technical and conceptual skills which support the creative process. I attributed the strength of the majority of art works presented to stand as testimony to the quality of Edinboro's Department of Art. Difficulty in selecting award recipients further demonstrated the calibre of education offered within the Department.
