Karl E. Nordberg, '64, now a member of the Educational Foundations faculty at Edinboro, is the co-recipient of a grant from The Public Committee for the Humanities in Pennsylvania. His project, "The Rural Experience in northwestern Pennsylvania: yesterday, today, and tomorrow," involves the study of a late Victorian farm in the Edinboro area. Once completed, it will be featured at a public workshop to be held on Edinboro's campus in July 1979. Joined with Prof. Nordberg in this undertaking is Dr. John L. Marsh of the English Department. The two photo-historians have previously collaborated on a pictorial history of Edinboro and a history of church architecture in western Pennsylvania. Presently they are researching the life and career of Lawrence V. Kupper, a long time Edinboro photographer, many of whose finest photographs were published in early college yearbooks.
