Moved by Mr. Marsh, seconded by Dr. Renz, that the Board of Trustees of the Edinboro State Teachers College, after a careful consideration of the purchase price, recommend to the Department of Property and Supplies the purchase, under Act 534, of the following properties located in Edinboro and adjoining present property of the College, for the purpose of straightening property lines and to acquire necessary land for the construction of the Training School under State Authority:

 House and lot on Normal Street belonging to George Welker, lot dimension, 200° x 50° for \$3,350.

(2) House and lot on Normal Street belonging to Mrs. Emma Kinter, lot dimension 440° x 99° for \$1,500.

(3) House and lot on Normal Street belonging to Charles H. Harned, lot dimension, 214% x 66% for \$3,150.

Motion unanimously passed.

Moved by Mr. Marsh and seconded by Dr. Renz that the Plans and Specifications, with such supplements as may be necessary, submitted by the architects, Meyers and Johnson

(Gymnasium and Training School); G. W. Stickle (Auditorium) and Richard Irvin (Central Heating Plant) be approved; that these plans and specifications and such supplements as may be necessary be submitted to the Department of Public Instruction and the General State Authority; that said plans and specifications, as approved, together with such supplements as may be necessary, constitute the recommendation and authority of the said Board of Trustees for the construction and location of the following buildings, subject to the regulations and requirements of the Department of Fublic Instruction and the General State Authority:

One Gymnasium One Training School One Auditorium One Central Heating Plant

Motion unanimously passed.

Upon motion of Mrs. Mahoney, seconded by Mr. Thomas, the secretary was instructed to send resolutions of respect for Major Bordwell to his family in Warren, Pennsylvania.

Upon motion of Mr. Loveland, seconded by Mr. Thomas, the Board authorized group insurance for covering personal preperty of students.

Upon motion of Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mrs. Mahoney, the Board approved an advance deposit fee of \$2.00 (a damage fee for students) subject to the approval of the Department at Harrisburg.

Upon motion of Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mrs. Mahoney, the Board voted to allow the Methodist Episcopal Church Mission School to hold their School of Instruction in the Edinboro State Teachers College Buildings during the early part of the summer of 1938, subject to the approval of the Department of Public Instruction.

Upon motion of Mr. Loveland, seconded by Mr. Thomas, the meeting was adjourned until Friday, January 14, 1938.
