

The map above is of Edinboro in 1865. At top part Edinboro lake is shown. At that time it was called Conneauttee Creek. The names of those living there at that time are shown. A Culbertson was the first to settle and many of that name were residents at this period. Culbertson golf course is named for the family.

Lower right is the Pennsylvania State Normal schools. It had been taken over by the state in 1861. Before that it had been an Academy.
