Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference Football Team-by-Team Notes for October 10.

Bloomsburg - The Huskies had their 23-game unbeaten streak in the PSAC East end with the loss to Millersville. They were 22-0-1 heading into the game. Bloomsburg was also shutout for the first time since the 1993 season, a span of 51 games. The last team to shutout the Huskies was Millersville, 26-0, at Bloomsburg. The last time the Huskies were shutout on the road was 1989 at IUP. The four losses for the Huskies are the most since 1993, Danny Hale's first year, when the team went 5-6. The Huskies face West Chester this week, a team they have beaten five straight years.

California - Cal's running game was led by Nartey and Schrenker, both of whom had 86 net yards in a 28-14 loss to Lock Haven. Nartey carried 25 times, while Schrenker had six carries. Quarterback Shawn McClelland added 67-yard on 10 carries. The defense received strong effort from Barry Kralick, who notched 10 tackles and added a tackle for loss.

Cheyney - The Wolves dropped to 0-6 and failed to end their winless streak with a 42-22 loss to Kutztown. Wolves quarterback Ameer Hayes completed 21 of 41 passes for three touchdowns and 280 yards. Bobby McRae was the leading receiver for the Wolves with seven receptions, two of them for touchdowns and gained 120-yards receiving. The loss ups the Wolves NCAA Division II football non-winning streak to 50 consecutive games and extends Cheyney's losing streak to 37 games, currently the longest in the nation.

Clarion - Clarion's defense posted four interceptions, one fumble recovery, four sacks, 14 tll's and blocked a punt out of the endzone for a safety as Clarion defeated Edinboro 33-20. Clarion's defense held Thompson to 87 yards on 21 carries, his lowest total of the year. In two straight weeks the Golden Eagles held SRU's Magulick and Edinboro's Thompson under 100 yards. Demetric Gardner had his first 100+ game, 102 yards on 11 carries. Alvin Slaughter had one catch for one-yard, caught a two-point conversion.

East Stroudsburg - Tailback Andre Myers had his third 100-yard game of the season, going 133-yards on 21 carries, as the Warriors lost to Shippensburg 35-13. Wide Receiver Jason Klush caught five-passes for 75-yards including a seven-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Will Burch.

Edinboro - David Sadler returned to action for the Fighting Scots after injuring his hand against Glenville and had 10 total tackles, two INTs with 19 return yards, three kickoff returns for 75 yards (long of 33). The Scot's however couldn't capitalize on Sadler's performance and were defeated by Clarion 33-20. Edinboro will host Lock Haven for Family/Legacy Weekend on Saturday, last season the Scots posted a 29-23 win in double OT in the program's first-ever overtime game.

IUP - IUP lost its second game in a row to Slippery Rock after winning 13 straight in the series from 1983-96. The Indians fell on Saturday when Randy McKavish hit D.J. Flick on a 52-yard Hail Mary pass on the final play of the game. IUP has now lost six games over the past two seasons, four of them have come by seven points or less, including three defeats in the final minute of play. IUP will look to rebound Saturday against Millersville. The Indians and Marauders have not met since 1991, when IUP claimed a 47-0 victory. The two teams played in the first round of the 1988 Division II playoffs, and Millersville won that game in Indiana by a score of 27-24.

Kutztown - Kutztown bounced back with a 42-22 win over Cheyney. Redshirt freshman running back Yorel Prosser had three touchdowns on eight carries, scoring on runs of one, two, and three yards. Quarterback Mike de Marteleire completed seven passes for 201 yards, throwing TD strikes of 77 and 73 yards. Leading only 28-22 at the start of the fourth quarter, KU scored 14 points to break it open. KU has now outscored opponents 58-27 in the fourth quarter this year. Next up for the Golden Bears is Mansfield, who KU has defeated in each of their last four meetings.

Lock Haven - Jamie Allen's 39-yard run with 2:20 left in the game gave Lock Haven a two-touchdown cushion, and accounted for the game's 28-14 final

score. Allen led Lock Haven with 13 carries for 155 yards and scored three of the Bald Eagles' four touchdowns. In addition to Allen's offensive accolades, the Bald Eagles were led by Jeremy Burkett, who caught six passes for 146 yards. Quarterback Ed Galiczynski was 10-of-17 for 183 yards. Matt Hendricks posted 12 tackles and a sack in leading the LHU defense, along with Chris Hileman, who had nine stops and a sack.

Mansfield - The Mansfield University Mountaineers were plagued by mistakes in failing to West Chester 39-0 in a PSAC East contest. MU piled up yards in offense but failed to get into the endzone with eight drives ending inside the West Chester 30-yard line including five of their first seven possessions. Mansfield had two passes inside the West Chester 20 picked off while having two interceptions by Mountaineer defenders negated by penalties. The Mountaineers continued to be snakebitten in the second. An early third quarter interception by MU's Ian Cooper was called back for roughing the passer to keep alive a West Chester drive that ended in a one-yard pass from Mitros to Bill Lowe. Mansfield drove to the West Chester nine yard line on their next possession but two penalties resulted in a West Chester interception to end the third quarter. Mansfield falls to 0-6 overall and 0-2 in the PSAC East.

Millersville - What goes around, comes around. The circle is complete after Millersville's 30-0 whitewash of Bloom Saturday. It not only was Bloom's first league setback since 1994 (20-15 loss at Millersville) to end a 22-0-1 run, but also it marked the Huskies' first shutout defeat in 51 games since Millersville turned the trick 26-0 at Redman Stadium in 1993. It also was MU's first shutout win since a 54-0 triumph over Cheyney in November 1995. Marauders have surrendered only 41 points over a 4 1/2 game stretch. MU has given up only two rush TDs through five contests.

Shippensburg - Shippensburg gained 605 yards in total offense as the Red Raider defeated East Stroudsburg 35-13. Jamie Ware caught eight passes for 130 yards and three touchdowns and halfback Dave Brown carried the ball nine times for 149 yards. Shippensburg used two quarterbacks in the game. Gicking completed 12 of 24 passes for 162 yards and Kullman gained 85 yards on four completions in 11 attempts. In addition to Brown's running, Brubaker finished the game with 80 yards on 10 carries. Shippensburg boosted its record to 4-2 and resume their Western Division schedule next week when the Raiders travels to Clarion.

Slippery Rock - A Paul Failla pass was intercepted by SRU linebacker Paul Allegretto and after catching the pass Allegretto slipped and fell at his own 48-yard line. When his knee touched down, the clock stopped at 0:01 to play. SRU came out in a shotgun and SRU had three wide receivers to the right. McKavish scrambled around to give his receivers enough time to get to the goal line and heaved the ball as far as he could. The pass was tipped at about the goal line and into the arms of freshman wideout D.J. Flick in the back of the end zone. It was Flick's only catch of the game -- a 52-yard game-winner. The win was the Rock's first at home against IUP since 1982. It gave the Rock a streak of 11 straight wins over PSAC-West opponents, 10 straight wins at home, and 18 straight regular-season wins against Division II opponents. Other SRU defensive highlights -- tackle Rob Anthony had eight tackles including four for losses and two sacks. Allegretto had a total of nine tackles plus the interception that set up the game-winning pass.

West Chester - The Golden Rams routed Mansfield 39-0 in PSAC action. West Chester took the opening kickoff and drove the length of the field to take a 7-0 lead on a 11-yard pass from quarterback Mike Mitros to Andrian Wilkerson 3:40 into the first quarter. The Golden Rams would add another first quarter touchdown on a two-yard run by Conrad Quarles and take a 22-0 lead on a three-yard run by Wally Dickson late in the first half. West Chester would add a fourth quarter field goal and touchdown to round out the scoring. West Chester improves to 4-2 overall and 2-0 in the PSAC East.
