Finally, the PA SPORTSfever Network will televise four Edinboro games in 2014. Those games are designated on the above schedule with the STN logo.

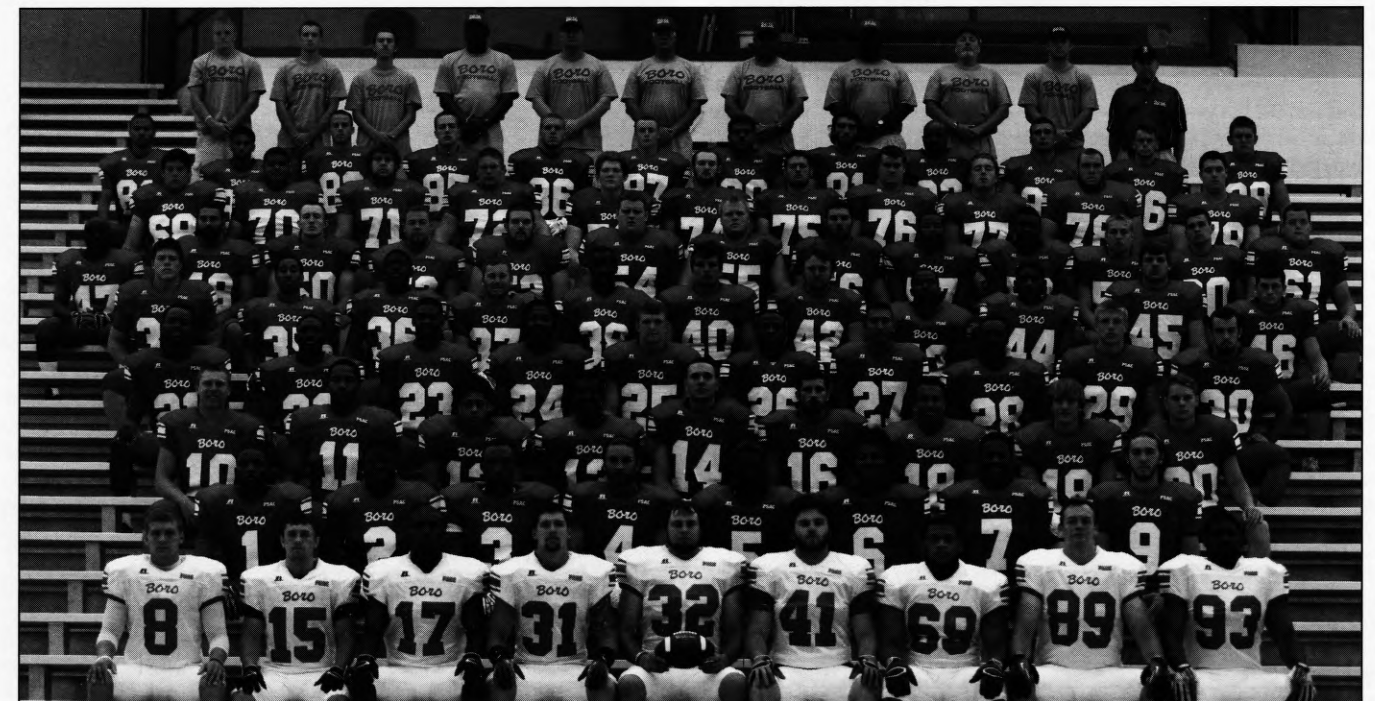

## Mike S. Zafirovski Sports & Recreation Dome

The Mike S. Zafirovski Sports & Recreation Dome was officially opened on November 30, 2009. Named after the former Edinboro swimmer and soccer player, the Zafirovski Dome is the largest air-supplied facility in the tri-state area at over 85,000 square feet. It measures 370 feet in length, 230 feet in width and is 72 feet high. The interior area is approximately 85,000 square feet.

The facility has a six-lane 230 meter indoor track as well as four multi-purpose courts. The Zafirovski Dome serves as the home for indoor track & field meets, and in fact Edinboro has hosted the PSAC Indoor Track & Field Championships the last four years and is scheduled to do so again in 2014.

The Zafirovski Dome serves as a practice facility for all of Edinboro's varsity teams, including football, and is available for all students to use for recreation. It is also available during certain hours for the community. During the spring the Erie Express indoor professional football team used the dome as its practice facility, and it has hosted numerous wrestling camps, along with AAU and high school competitions in several sports.

# Assistant Coaches

Golden Eagles to the 1996 PSAC Championship, the NCAA Northeast Regional championship, and a berth in the NCAA Division II semifinals. Clarion won the 1996 Lambert Cup.

Prior to joining the Millersville staff, Kelly served as the defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at Indiana State in 2005 and '06. In 2006 he was selected as one of 25 coaches to attend the NCAA Expert Coaches Academy in Miami, Fla.

In addition, Kelly was the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at Delaware State in 2004; the offensive coordinator and quarterback/receivers coach at Elizabeth City State in 2003; the interim head coach/defensive coordinator/secondary coach at Norfolk State in 2002; and the head football coach at Newport News Apprentice from 1998-2001.

He also was the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at Salisbury State from 1990-93, working with current Edinboro defensive coordinator Wayne Bradford.

Kelly began his coaching career as a graduate assistant coach at Southern Connecticut State in 1986, coaching the receivers and tight ends coach. He then moved on to Texas State University, where he was an assistant from 1987-89, working with the receivers, tight ends, and the secondary.

In addition to his college coaching experience, Kelly served National Football League Summer Fellowships with the Houston Oilers in 1989 and the Washington Redskins in 1990.

Kelly received his bachelor of science degree in Business Administration/Hotel Management from James Madison in May 1985. He completed work on his master's degree in Interdisciplinary Studies of Education Administration from Southwest Texas State in August 1989. He is the father of five children -- Aisoyhina Kelly (21), a senior at Millersville University; Aianna Kelly (19), a sophomore at Presbyterian College and a guard on the basketball team; Aubrey Kelly (16); Aidahlia Kelly (14); and Alexis McKinney (15).

2011 he took over as the offensive line coach, working side-by-side with head coach Scott Browning. He is now back with the running backs.

Henson joined the Edinboro staff after serving as a mathematics teacher, football coach and athletic director at Grand Valley High School in Ohio for 22 years. He led the Mustangs to a 150-68-4 record, with five Grand River Conference championships, three East Suburban Conference titles, and three state playoff appearances.

In the 1990's, Henson's charges posted three undefeated campaigns and a 23-game regular season winning streak. He was named the Conference Coach of the Year eight times and County Coach of the Year three times, culminated by his selection as the Ohio Division V Coach of the Year in 1997 and the Division IV Coach of the Year in '92. In 2007 he was a member of the first class inducted into the Ashtabula County Football Hall of Fame. His son has since been inducted, as well.

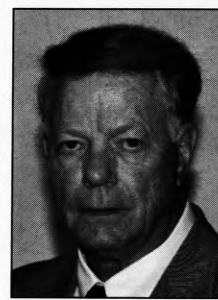
He will add to his honors in June of 2015 as he is one of six members of the 2015 class of the Ohio High School Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame. He will be officially inducted next June in Columbus, Ohio.

Prior to beginning his stellar career at Grand Valley, Henson debuted as an assistant coach at Cardinal Middlefield (OH) High School, where he served for eight years.

Henson graduated from Hiram College in 1968 with a bachelor of arts degree in Mathematics, then completed work on his master of science degree in Education with a major in Mathematics from Youngstown State in 1972. He and his wife, Evelyn, reside in Edinboro. They are the parents of a son, Jim, who is the head football coach at Jefferson (Oh.) High School and a daughter, Jennifer, along with four grandchildren.

## Tabitha Bemis and Dan Altavilla Named 2013-14 PSAC Pete Nevins Scholar-Athletes of the Year

The Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference is pleased to announce Mercyhurst's Dan Altavilla and Edinboro's Tabitha Bemis as its 2013-14 Pete Nevins Scholar-Athletes of the Year. Altavilla and Bemis were selected by the league's sports information directors.

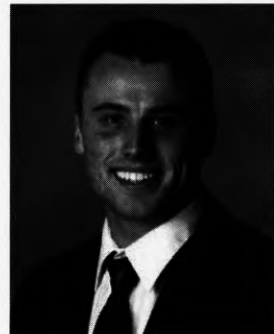
The Pete Nevins Scholar-Athletes of the Year are presented to the top student-athletes who have achieved at least a 3.50 cumulative grade point average while competing at an outstanding athletic level. To be eligible for the awards, a student-athlete must have been recognized as a fall, winter or spring PSAC Top 10 award winner in the same academic year.

Bemis, a sports and recreation major with a 3.92 grade point average, was a two-time All-American at the 2014 NCAA Division II Outdoor Track and Field Championships, making her a six-time All-American (four indoor, two outdoor). She is a two-time PSAC Outdoor Field Athlete of the Year and a three-time PSAC Indoor Field Athlete of the Year, as she has won 15 PSAC Championship titles in her career. This season she placed fifth in the triple jump (43' 3 1/4") at the NCAA Outdoor National Championship and eighth in the long jump (19' 9"). At the indoor championship she placed second in the long jump (19' 8 1/4") and seventh in the triple jump (40' 9 3/4"). Bemis is the first PSAC athlete to be named to six PSAC Top 10 rosters, and is a three-time Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-American.

Altavilla, a sports medicine/pre-physical therapy major with a 3.70 grade point average, was a baseball Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team selection as well as being the inaugural winner of the Brett Tomko Award given to Division II's most outstanding pitcher. He was named the ABCA/Rawlings Division II National Pitcher of the Year, and the Daktronics' Ron Lenz Division II National Pitcher of the Year, while being a First Team All-American from ABCA/Rawlings, Daktronics, and NCBWA. In 12 starts this season he accumulated nine wins and established a 1.23 ERA. He led Division II with 129 strikeouts to set a new Mercyhurst season standard and limited opponents to a .167 batting average. Altavilla broke a 99 year-old PSAC record when he tossed 19 strikeouts in 7.2 innings of work in the opening game of the PSAC Championship against West Chester. Altavilla was drafted in the fifth round and 141st overall in the Major League Baseball First Year Player Draft by the Seattle Mariners, marking the highest draft pick in Mercyhurst history.

# Sox Harrison Stadium

## Sox Harrison Stadium



Sox Harrison Stadium serves as the home of the Fighting Scots. Dedicated in 1965, the stadium honors the memory of B. Regis "Sox" Harrison, the head football and basketball coach at Edinboro University for 34 years. Sox Harrison was the key figure in the building of Edinboro's athletic program, unselfishly devoting 34 years of service to the University as an athletic director, coach and physical education instructor. Appropriately, he was the first member inducted into the Edinboro Athletic Hall of Fame in 1982.



Harrison coached the Fighting Scot football team from its inception in 1926 to 1938, the returned to guide the gridders in 1941 and '42. In addition, he coached the men's basketball team for 23 seasons, from 1928-53, winning 175 games.

The stadium received a facelift several years ago, giving it a spanking new look. Most noticeable was the installation of an artificial surface, Sportex, to replace the natural grass. And it is now illuminated, with lights being installed for the first time. The first night game was played on xxx against xxx. Finally, a new scoreboard was installed.

Sox Harrison Stadium seats 6,000 people in its two grandstands, along with plenty of standing room. In addition to press boxes on both sides of the stadium, the facility has locker rooms, a training room and complete amenities for fans.

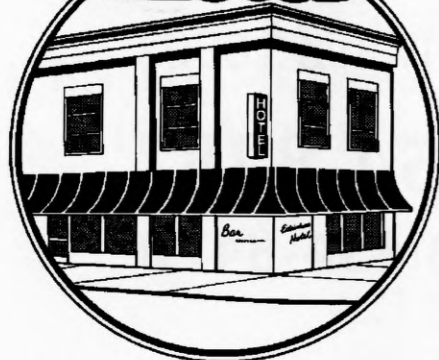
The stadium has undergone several renovations, including a new sound system and improved handicapped access areas in 1999. In 1997, a new grandstand was constructed on the visitor's side of the field, adding 2,500 permanent seats, along with a press box, locker rooms and a training room.

In addition to the football field, the facility contains complete track facilities.

# All-Americans

## Harlan Hill Trophy



Trevor Harris (below) became the third Edinboro University football player to finish as a finalist for the Harlan Hill Trophy, presented annually to the top player in NCAA Division II football. Harris was a finalist in 2008 after being a Northeast Region finalist in 2007.

Running back Elbert Cole was one of three finalists in 1989, while wide receiver Ernest Priestler was a finalist a year later. Cole placed third in the '89 balloting. He earned All-American honors in 1989, receiving first team accolades from Kodak/American Football Coaches Association, second team recognition from Football Gazette, and third team status from Associated Press.

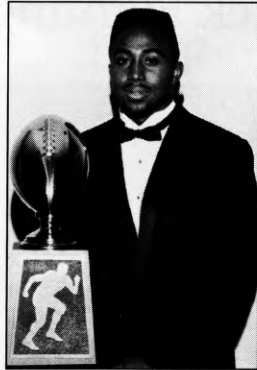
Cole rushed for 1,507 yards and set Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference records for touchdowns (24) and points (148). He led the Fighting Scots to the PSAC West title, a 8-3 record and a number seven ranking in the final Division II poll.

Priester was runnerup to North Dakota State's Chris Simdorn in 1990 when the Bison claimed the Division II national title. Priestler was the PSAC Western Division Co-Player of the Year in 1990. He was also recognized by Kodak/American Football Coaches Association, Associated Press and the Football Gazette as a first team All-American.

The wide receiver hauled in 47 passes for 1,102 yards and 15 TDs. Edinboro finished 9-3, reaching the Division II quarterfinals.

Andre Burke made a run at the Harlan Hill Trophy in 2004, as the tailback was a Northeast Region semifinalist. Burke ended up with a school-record 1,713 yards and 19 TDs.

## The Cactus Bowl

Trevor Harris continued the tradition of Edinboro Fighting Scots playing in the Cactus Bowl in January 2009. (NOTE: The 2007 contest was suspended.) The quarterback completed 10 of 13 passes for 97 yards and ran three times for 17 yards to help the West All-Stars to a 16-0 win over the East All-Stars. In 2000 the contest was moved to Kingsville, Texas and renamed the Cactus Bowl. The contest features the top small college seniors in the country. # Today's Feature

## Question & Answer .... with Cody Harris

This week we talk with quarterback Cody Harris. On the field he ranks second in most passing and total offense career statistics, trailing only his brother Trevor. Off the field he is a Human Performance major with a 3.86 GPA who will graduate in December.

**Q. You were granted a sixth year of eligibility after breaking ribs last year. What were your thoughts when you were first injured and learned of the severity?**

A. "I went home and got an x-ray. I was pretty upset honestly because I wanted to play football that year but it was God's plan for me. Kind of just went with it after that and listed to Coach Browning and the coaches and got the sixth year."

**Q. At what point did you realize that you wouldn't be able to return during the season?**

A. "It was actually the following week when I went home, got the x-ray, and 'hey you broke two of your ribs'. I was like 'that's a good thing (laughed)'. I called Coach Browning and we talked about the sixth year to see if that would be a possibility."

**Q. You are working with a third offensive coordinator in Mike Miller. What are thoughts in regards to being with a third offensive coordinator during your time here?**

A. "Actually it's my fourth (he grinned). It's my fourth offensive coordinator but it's awesome working with Coach Miller. He's a professional. We're getting close. We're getting there. Kind of takes some time to put an offense in. Continue repetition, repetition. We're getting there."

**Q. How difficult was it with Mike Miller not coming in until August and having to pick up a new system? How different is that system?**

A. "It's very different, very different. There's a lot of different things with protection-wise and the way you throw hot routes and the way that receivers run routes. It's very, very different, something completely new to me. But it's something that I really like and really adapting to. I'm starting to really love it."

**Q. You've played three games so far, the fourth one coming up at Cal this weekend. Where would you say the offense is? How much has been put in, how much growth for this offense?**

A. "The sky's the limit for us. Especially with Coach Miller. Just because he has so much knowledge and so much information that we've yet to even tap into. So far as the season we've kind of struggled here and there and put ourselves in bad situations but we just look forward to one game at a time. The sky's the limit for us."

**Q. You graduate in December. What are your plans when you finish up with your degree?**

A. "Actually I've applied to PA school. I have an interview on October 20. That's coming up. I'm trying to get prepared for that at St. Francis in Pennsylvania, preparing for that, that's about it as far as I know right now."

**Q. Your brother Trevor was a somewhat renowned quarterback at Edinboro. How difficult was it following in his footsteps?**

A. "I didn't really look at it like that. Trevor's my best friend and we always talk and stuff. He's always been there hand and foot for me and ready if I have any questions or what not. It's been a gradual process with him. I really didn't think of it like that. Kind of came in and did my own thing tried to develop and do the best I could"

**Q. Trevor is now playing professionally in Canada. How has he impacted your career as a football player and a student?**

A. "Experience. Professionalism. Trevor knows more than I do. Calling him to get just little tips of information. What he sees and how he would deal with certain situations or kind of things you see in a film room. I kind of call him and say 'hey what would you do'. He kind of tells me and I can talk to the offensive coordinator and we can kind of come up with something that maybe would be a little bit better than what he initially thought. It's awesome to have him as sort of a go-to guy to go to outside of the coaching staff to have some real good knowledge."

**Q. We talked a little bit about your academics. You are a 3.8+ student. How do you balance the demands of football along with being such a successful athlete? What would you recommend for others.**

A. "It's really prioritizing your schedule and your time and stuff. You know, when you have 15 minutes you have to open the books for a little bit, glance at your notes and kind of look over stuff so that when it comes to test time or a project or whatever you're ready to go. It's not like your cramming the night before. It's kind of a gradual thing you really have to prioritize your scheduling. Schedule when you're going to study and practice."

**Q. Your mother and father have rarely missed a game. They both have been through a lot during that time period. Talk about how they impacted you and what their support has meant to you.**

A. "I can't even explain that. It's tough to explain. Their love for me is unreal. They're always here for me. It's extraordinary how great of parents they are. I've literally never had any problems with my parents. Anything I've ever wanted I've gotten. If I've needed anything they've always been there. I can't even put it into words."

**Q. There's a time period, particularly early in your career, where your mom was pretty seriously ill. How much did that impact what you're doing now both as a student and an athlete?**

A. "When she was sick and they got in a motorcycle accident I kind of took care of them just because my brother and my sisters were gone or they have their own family. It's tough for them so I kind of was the guy there. Just little things like that kind of pushed me towards like really that's what I want to do. You know because I enjoy doing that. Especially taking care of my parents. Also I just like the medical field and understanding what was going on with them and how I can help them really impressed me towards being a PA and that's kind of the track I've taken and understanding that's what I want to do."

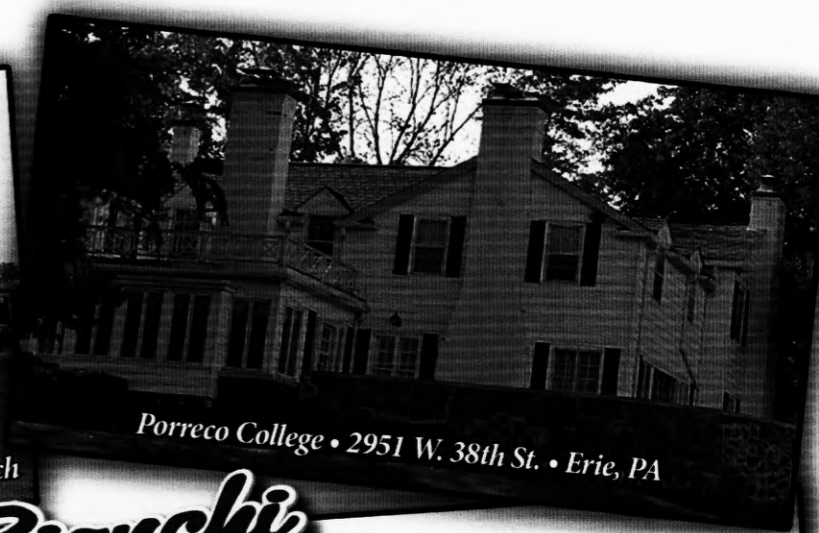

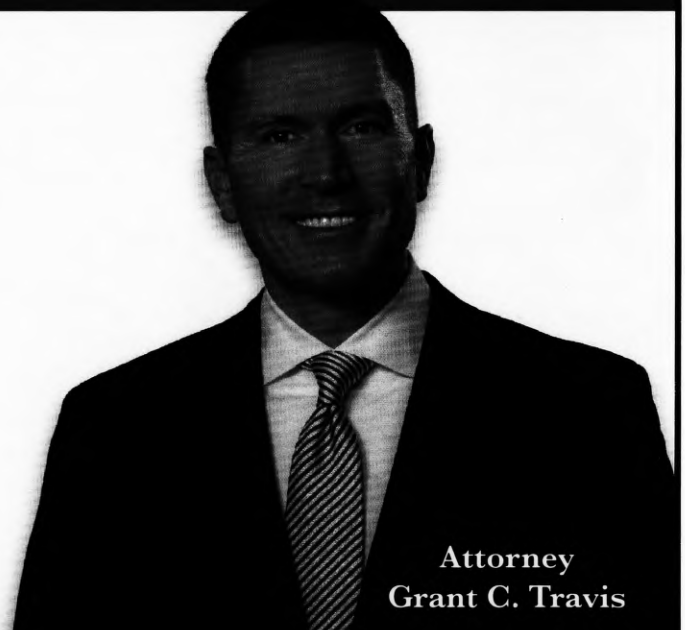
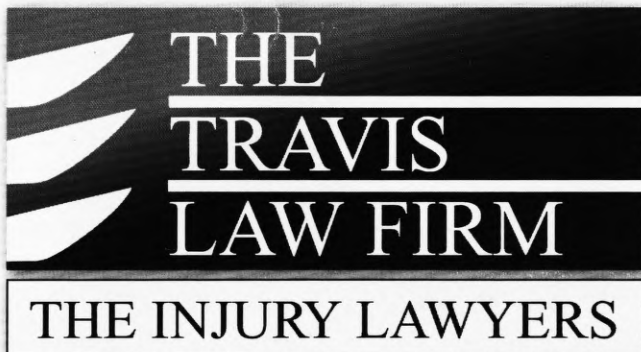
