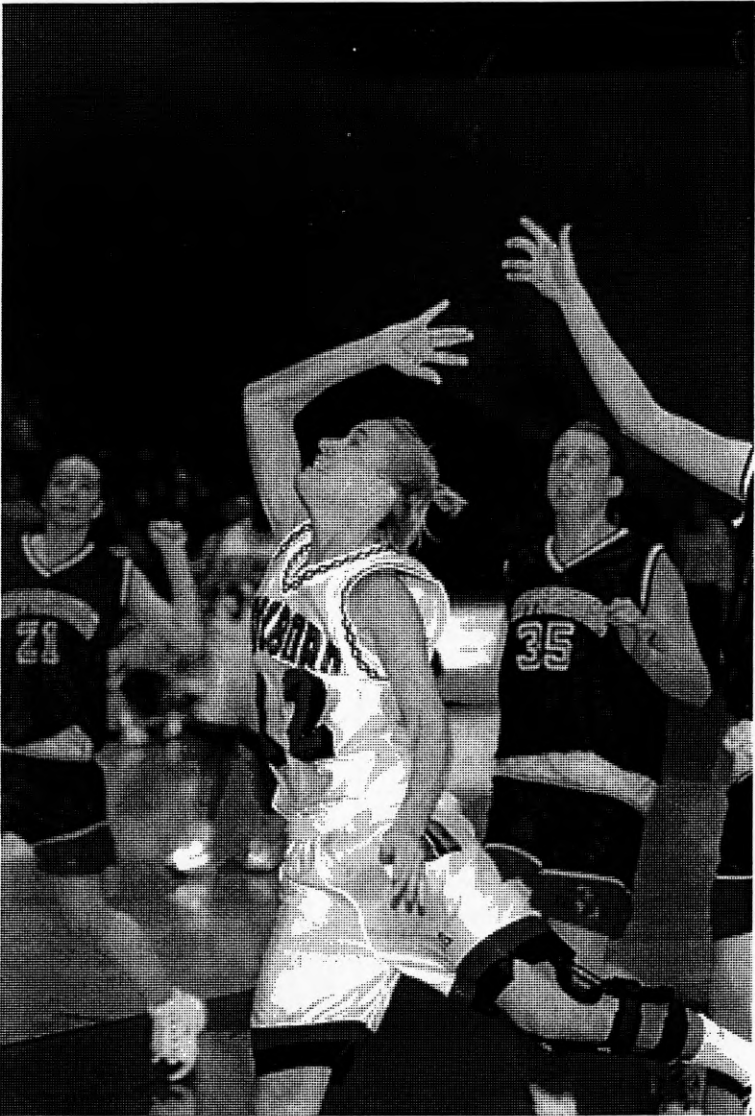

The Edinboro women's basketball team returns home for a PSAC West contest with Clarion. Tipoff is scheduled for 6:00 p.m. The Fighting Scots, 14-7 overall and 4-3 in conference play, are currently in a tie with Slippery Rock for third place in the PSAC West. Indiana(Pa.) is just one game behind at 3-3 in the PSAC West.

THE EDINBORO-CLARION SERIES

Edinboro leads 30-20

The Fighting Scots won the first meeting with Clarion this year, 89-66. Edinboro fell behind early before exploding to outscore the Golden Eagles, 84-52, over the final 35 minutes of the contest. **Kim Vay** had a career game with 37 points and 25 rebounds in the win.

THE COACHES

Stan Swank is in his 14th season at the helm of the Fighting Scot program. The record-holder for career wins at Edinboro, Swank shows an overall mark of 240-146. He has guided the Fighting Scots to eight PSAC Tournaments, including four in the last five seasons, along with five NCAA Division II Tournament appearances. Five of his squads have posted 20-or-more wins, including the 1996-97 edition which went 24-9 and advanced to Edinboro's only Elite Eight ... Clarion head coach **Gie Parsons** has led the Golden Eagles to a 182-147 ledger over the past 12 years. In 19 years as a head coach, Parson has accumulated a record of 292-220. Clarion has finished 9-17 in each of the past two seasons.

SCOUTING THE FIGHTING SCOTS

Kim Vay, a 5'10" forward, has been Edinboro's most consistent player all year. In the Slippery Rock contest, she recorded her ninth double-double with 18 points and 18 rebounds. Vay has registered seven double-doubles in the last eight games. The Yough High School product is the only Fighting Scot to start all 21 games for coach Stan Swank ... freshman **Courtney Thompson**, a 5'6" guard from Girard High School, averages 4.9 ppg. with 59 assists ... **Wendy Wiggins**, a 5'9" guard, averages 9.4 ppg. with 65 assists ... freshman **Megan Zitner**, a 5'10" wing, has started the last

three contests. Zitner (5.9 ppg., 18 steals) tallied 13 points, 7 rebounds and 5 assists versus Slippery Rock ... **Arlena Winn** (4.1 ppg., 4.4 rpg.), contributed a season-high 12 points in the loss to Slippery Rock ... **Katie Raymond** and **Krystal Henson** remain the top two reserves off the bench. Raymond, a 6'2" center, contributes 7.2 points and 4.7 rebounds per game ... sophomore **Krystal Henson**, a 5'4" guard, is averaging 12.8 points and 3.6 rebounds per contest over the past eight games. Henson has led Edinboro in scoring four times and has reached double figures on 14 occasions ... senior **Julie McNees** (3.0 ppg., 2.0 rpg) also sees time in the backcourt ... other reserves include sophomore forwards **Lachelle Crawl** (4.3 ppg. and 1.6 rpg.), **Suzanne Petruska** (2.3 ppg. and 2.2 rpg.) and **Adann Williams** (4.1 ppg. and 3.3 rpg. with 18 blocked shots).

VAY RANKS EIGHTH IN REBOUNDING RECORD BOOKS

Senior **Kim Vay** ranks eighth in the Edinboro record books with 634 career rebounds. The 5'10" forward is 11th in Division II at 11.1 rpg. this season. Vay has nine double-doubles on the year and 21 in her career at Edinboro. The former California(Pa.) transfer has 902 career points to go along with 744 rebounds. Vay's Edinboro totals stand at 727 markers and 634 boards.

THOMPSON NAMED PSAC WEST ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Freshman **Courtney Thompson** was named the conference rookie of the week after leading Edinboro to a pair of wins last week. The Girard High School product averaged 11.5 ppg., 3.5 rpg. and 6.5 assists per game, while shooting 50.0 percent from the floor. Most importantly, the point guard recorded 13 assists and only 3 turnovers, despite playing 72 of the team's 80 minutes. Since joining the starting lineup eight games ago, Thompson has led Edinboro to a 5-3 record.

THE LAST TIME OUT

Poor shooting again plagued Edinboro in its last outing as the Fighting Scots fell to Slippery Rock, 75-69. Edinboro managed to shoot just 35.6 percent (26 of 73) from the floor, including just 1 of 11 from the three-point arc. The guard combination of **Courtney Thompson**, **Wendy Wiggins** and **Krystal Henson** combined to convert 3 of 24

shots. Despite the poor shooting, four Fighting Scots reached double figures with **Kim Vay** leading the way with 18 markers. Vay also added a game-high 18 rebounds. **Megan Zitner** had a strong showing with 13 points, 7 rebounds and 5 assists. The center duo of **Arlena Winn** (12 points, 4 boards) and **Katie Raymond** (13 points, 4 rebounds) combined for 25 points, 8 rebounds and 2 blocked shots.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES

Clarion has lost six of its last seven contests, including a 68-67 overtime thriller to California(Pa.) on Monday ... the Golden Eagles have three players averaging double figures with **Christina Lantz** leading the way at 11.3 ppg. The 6'0" forward also averages 7.1 rebounds per game ... **Melissa Yearous**, a 5'10" senior, tallies 10.8 ppg. and 5.5 rpg. In the loss to California(Pa.), Yearous registered 23 points, 9 rebounds and 3 steals ... **Allison Stodart** is Clarion's outside threat. The 5'7" sophomore has 55 three-point field goals this season and is averaging 10.6 points per game. Stodart is ninth in Division II with 2.8 three-point field goals made per contest ... 6'2" sophomore **Courtney Willman** contributes 9.1 points and 7.8 rebounds per game ... junior **Tiffany Taylor** rounds out the starting lineup. The 5'4" guard records 6.3 points, 2.1 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game ... **Tameka Washington** is a scoring threat off the bench, registering 9.7 ppg. along with 3.7 rpg. ... **Erin Stinnette** (2.3 ppg., 2.7 rpg.), **Jen Duhnke** (3.3 ppg., 1.4 rpg.) and **Judy Zimmerman** (3.0 ppg., 1.4 rpg.) also see time for coach Gie Parsons ... Clarion won five straight PSAC West titles from 1991-95, but have not had a winning season since the 1994-95 season.

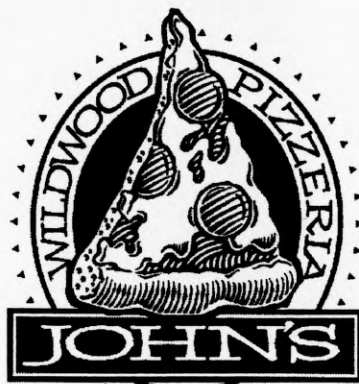

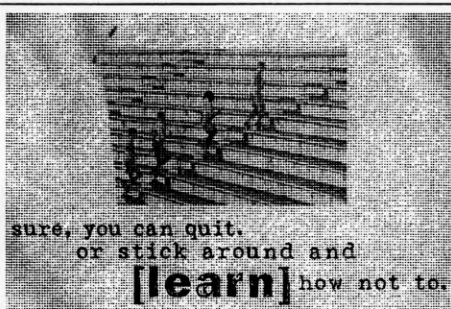
