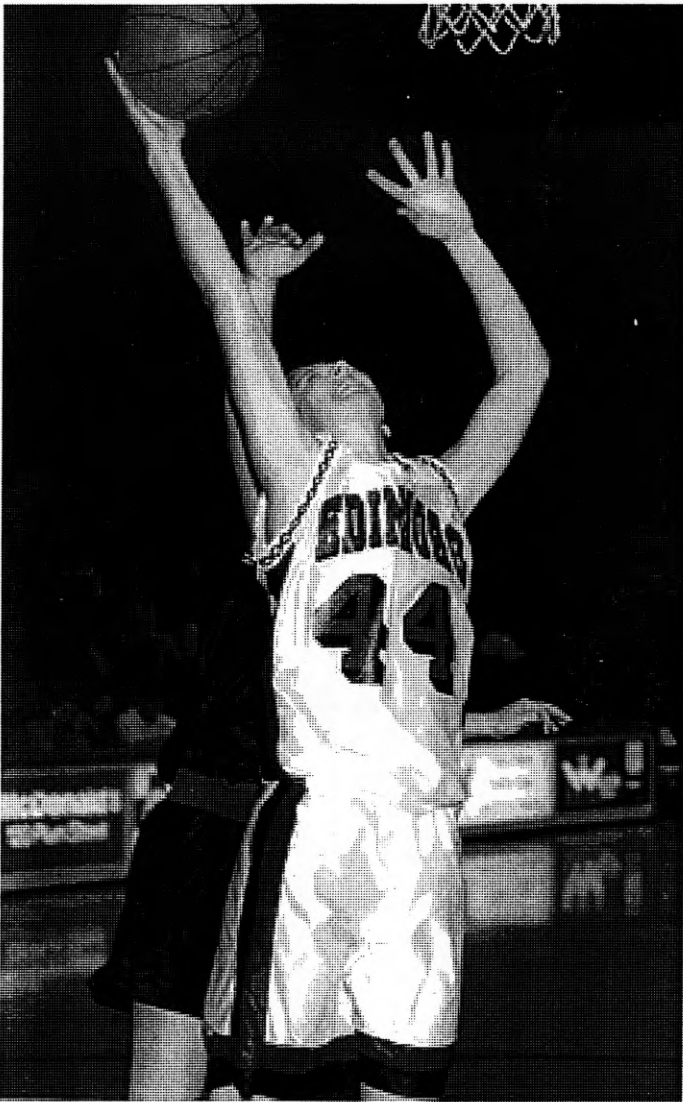

The Edinboro University women's basketball team looks to build on Wednesday's 89-66 win over Clarion in an important PSAC West battle. The Fighting Scots are 11-5 overall and 1-1 in the PSAC West. Shippensburg enters today's game with a 13-2 record overall and a 2-0 ledger in the conference.

EDINBORO-SHIPPENSBURG SERIES

Shippensburg leads the series 18-14
The Lady Raiders have won four straight games in this heated rivalry, including three contests last season. Shippensburg swept Edinboro in the PSAC West regular season and ended the Fighting Scots' year with a 90-76 win in the opening round of the PSAC Tournament.

THE COACHES

Stan Swank is in his 14th season at the helm of the Fighting Scot program. The record-holder for career wins at Edinboro, Swank shows an overall mark of 236-145. He has guided the Fighting Scots to eight PSAC Tournaments, including four in the last five seasons, along with five NCAA Division II Tournament appearances. Five of his squads have posted 20-or-more wins, including the 1996-97 edition which went 24-9 and advanced to Edinboro's only Elite Eight ... Shippensburg head coach **Kristy Trn** holds a 37-8 ledger in two seasons in charge of the Golden Eagles. In her first year at Shippensburg, Trn led the Lady Raiders to the PSAC Tournament championship and a berth to the NCAA Division II East Regional. Shippensburg finished 24-6 last season.

SCOUTING THE SCOTS

Edinboro snapped out of a six-game shooting funk to register a 89-66 win over Clarion in its last outing ... the Fighting Scots shot 46.3 percent from the floor after shooting just 34.9 percent in the previous six contests ... **Kim Vay**, a 5'10" forward, remains a fixture in the starting rotation, tallying four double-doubles in the last five games ... in the win over Clarion, she eclipsed her previous career-highs with a 37-point, 25-rebound effort ... Vay is averaging 14.7 ppg. and 10.4 rpg., both team highs. She

also paces the team with 29 steals, while shooting 53.1 percent from the floor ... a number of players have filled the remaining four slots in the starting lineup ... freshman **Courtney Thompson**, a 5'6" guard from Girard High School, has started the last three contests, tallying a season-high 14 points in the loss to Bloomsburg. Thompson is averaging 4.1 ppg. with 38 assists ... **Julie McNeese**, a 5'6" defensive specialist, rejoined the starting rotation three games ago after starting several games last season. McNeese contributes 3.9 points and 2.1 rebounds per game ... **Lachelle Crawl**, a 5'9" wing player, registers 5.1 ppg. and 1.7 rpg. ... at 6'2" **Arlena Winn** (3.6 ppg., 4.7 rpg.), a transfer from Bethune-Cookman, provides size up front ... Swank continues to shuffle his lineup, using a number of different combinations off the bench as well as in the starting lineup ... sophomore **Krystal Henson** is now coming off the bench after starting 12 straight contests. The 5'4" guard tallies 11.4 ppg. and leads the team with 52 assists. Henson snapped out of a four-game slump with 19 points and 6 three-pointers against Clarion ... **Wendy Wiggins**, a 5'9" guard, has started 14 of the team's 16 games, averaging 10.3 ppg. with 49 assists ... **Katie Raymond**, a 6'2" center, contributes 6.6 points and 4.1 rebounds per game. Raymond matched a career-high with 14 points versus Clarion ... freshman **Megan Zitner** (5.8 ppg., 16 steals) sees time in the backcourt ... first-year sophomore **Suzanne Petruska**, a 5'10" walk-on, averages 2.7 ppg. and 2.4 rpg. ... **Adann Williams**, a 6'0" sophomore, averages 4.5 ppg. and 3.9 rpg. to go along with a team-high 15 blocked shots

VAY HAS HUGE NIGHT VERSUS CLARION

Senior **Kim Vay** erupted for a 37-point, 25-rebound performance in the 89-66 win over Clarion on Wednesday. Both totals surpassed her previous career-highs and approached Edinboro single-game records. Vay finished the night 12 of 16 from the floor and 13 of 15 from the foul line. The 5'11" forward grabbed 12 of her 25 rebounds on the offensive end, while adding four steals in the win.

SCOUTING THE LADY RAIDERS

Shippensburg is off to an outstanding 13-2 start, ranking second in the NCAA East Region ... the Lady Raiders are led by senior **Christa Cline**. The 5'10" forward averages 11.3 ppg. and 7.8 rpg. Cline was a first team All-PSAC West performer last season ... **Jessie Gordon**, a 6'0" junior, has stepped in to fill the void left when **Tamaura Woodson** was lost for the season with a knee injury. Gordon tallies 10.8 points and 8.1 rebounds per game, while shooting 50.0 percent (62 of 124) from the floor ... freshman **Katie Bray** has started the last ten games for Shippensburg, averaging 9.7 ppg. and shooting 53.3 percent (57 of 107) from the field ... senior **Janette Pieczynski**, a 5'7" guard, registers 11.3 ppg. and 3.1 rpg. with 36 steals ... **Vickie Mikesic**, a 5'7" senior, leads the team with 81 assists and 53 steals while averaging 7.7 points and 3.9 rebounds per game ... Pieczynski and Mikesic were second team All-PSAC West performers last season ... Stephanie Rothery, a 5'11" senior, provides depth in the frontcourt contributing 6.5 ppg. and 3.5 rpg. ... **Erin Corrie** (4.2 ppg., 1.2 rpg.) and **Jamie Fredley** (18 assists, 10 steals) supply backcourt depth ... Shippensburg averages 72.7 points per game.

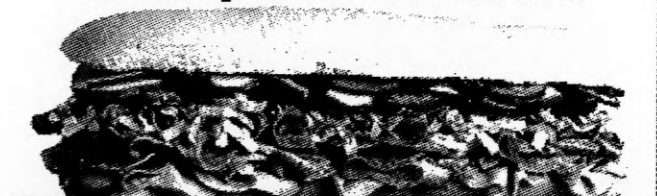

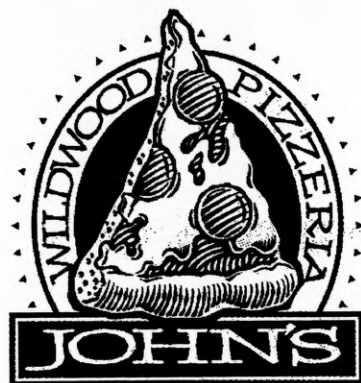

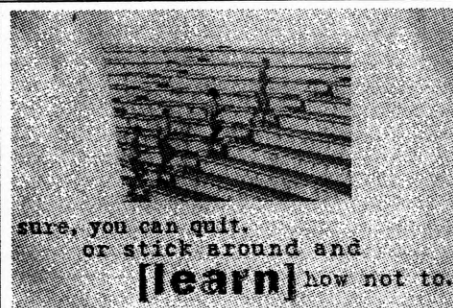
