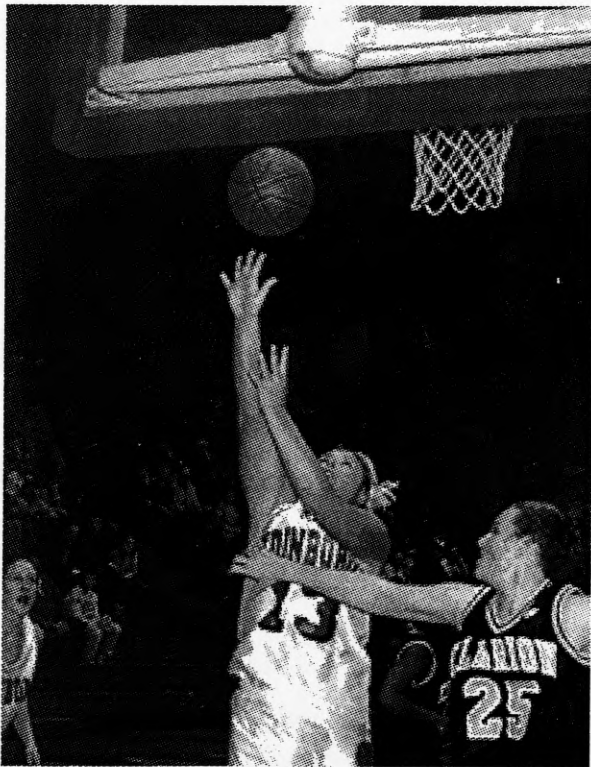
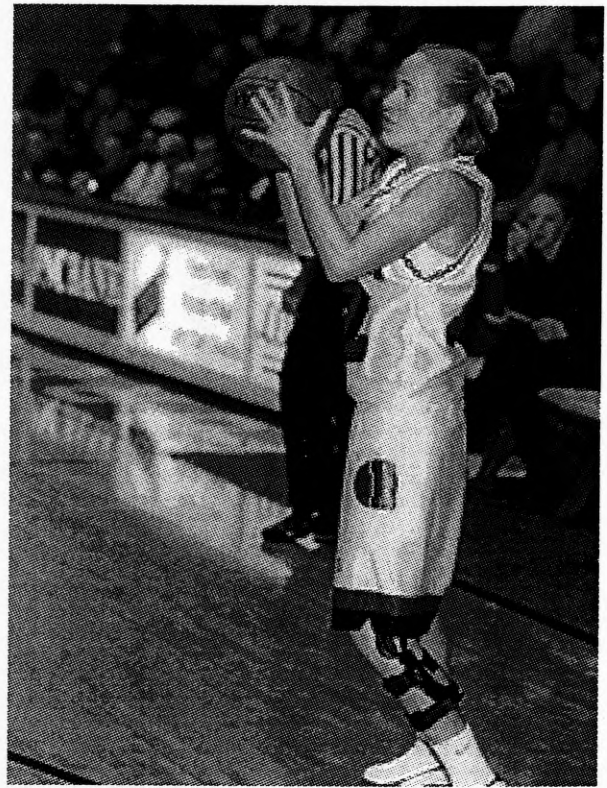

# Tonight's Game

The Edinboro women's basketball team plays its final regular season home contest tonight versus Slippery Rock. The contest could mark the final home contest for seniors Kim Vay and Julie McNees, while also playing a major role in the shaping of the PSAC Tournament brackets. The Fighting Scots, 16-8 overall and 6-4 in the PSAC West, are currently one game behind Slippery Rock in the conference. Both teams are battling to host an opening round contest in the PSAC Tournament. Tonight's contest will not finalize the landscape of the conference tournament, but it will definitely clear up a clouded picture.

### PSAC PLAYOFF SCENARIOS

Edinboro, 16-8 overall and 6-4 in conference play, has won 5 of its last 7 contests and is currently in fourth place, one game behind Slippery Rock and California(Pa.), who are both 7-3 in conference play. Shippensburg remains atop the PSAC West with a 9-2 ledger. Edinboro has clinched one of the four Western Division playoff berths and with two games remaining still has an outside chance of hosting a first round PSAC Tournament contest. Two Fighting Scots victories, paired with an 0-2 finish by California(Pa.) and Slippery Rock would produce another home contest for Edinboro. Two Edinboro victories, coupled with splits by California(Pa.) and Slippery Rock, would create a three-way tie for second place in the conference. Due to tiebreakers Edinboro would finish in fourth place. Slippery Rock could sneak into first

place in the PSAC West with victories over Edinboro and Shippensburg. California(Pa.) wins the conference with two wins, two Shippensburg losses and a Slippery Rock loss to Edinboro. The top two teams in the conference will host the opening round of the PSAC Tournament on Tuesday, February 27. The PSAC East top seed hosts the tournament final four.

### VAY AND MCNEES WRAP UP EDINBORO PLAYING CAREERS

Barring a pair of wins and some help from conference foes, Kim Vay and Julie McNees will play their final contest at McComb Fieldhouse tonight. Vay, a 5'10" forward, will leave Edinboro among the all-time rebounding leaders, despite playing just three seasons. The former California(Pa.) transfer ranks seventh with 666 career rebounds. The Lowber, PA native has 936 career points to go along with 775 rebounds. Vay registered one of the most impressive games in Edinboro history with 37 points and 25 rebounds in a 89-66 win over Clarion earlier this season. McNees, a 5'6" guard, has been a key role player over the past four years. The Blackhawk High School product has 207 points, 206 rebounds, 98 assists and 86 steals in her 92 game career. While she won't rank among the statistical leaders, McNees has enjoyed a successful career helping the Fighting Scots to three PSAC Tournaments and an NCAA Division II tournament appearance.

### SCOUTING EDINBORO

**Kim Vay**, a 5'10" forward, has led the Fighting Scots in rebounding in 21 of the team's 24 contests and in scoring 9 times this season. Vay, who began her career at California(Pa.), is closing in on the 1,000-point plateau with 936 career markers. The Yough High School product is the only Fighting Scot to start all 24 games for coach Stan Swank ... freshman **Courtney**

**Thompson**, a 5'6" guard from Girard High School, averages 4.9 ppg. with 72 assists ... **Wendy Wiggins**, a 5'9" guard, averages 9.9 ppg. with 73 assists ... freshman **Megan Zitner** (5.9 ppg., 2.3 rpg., 24 steals) registered a career-high 15 points in the loss to Shippensburg ... at 6'2" **Arlena Winn** (4.0 ppg., 4.1 rpg.) has combined with **Katie Raymond** for a solid one-two punch at center. Raymond, a 6'2" center, contributes 7.0 points and 4.7 rebounds per game ... sen-

### THE ROCKET LINEUP

Last season's Rookie of the Year, **Becky Siembak** leads Slippery Rock in scoring (15.3 ppg.) and rebounding (9.9 rpg.). The 5'10" sophomore is ranked 13th in Division II in field goal percentage at 55.9 percent ... senior **Tracy Whitting** controls the paint, averaging 10.6 ppg. and 8.3 rpg. The 6'4" center shoots just 36.0 percent from the foul line. junior **Jackie Altenweg** tallies 15.2 points and 3.7 rebounds per game. The 5'7" guard has 34 three-point field goals, 69 assists and 36 steals ... **Shelbey Wardman**, a 5'9" junior, contributes 13.5 ppg. and 3.8 rpg. The Uniontown, PA native leads the team with 57 trifectas to go along with 69 assists and 43 steals ... sophomore **Melissa McKavish** rounds out the starting lineup. The 5'4" guard averages 9.2 points and 4.1 rebounds with 81 assists and 65 steals.

### VAY RANKS SEVENTH IN CAREER REBOUNDS AT EDINBORO

Senior **Kim Vay** ranks seventh in the Edinboro record books with 666 career rebounds. The 5'10" forward is 8th in Division II at 11.0 rpg. this season. Vay has eleven double-doubles on the year and 23 in her career at Edinboro. The former California(Pa.) transfer has 936 career points to go along with 775 rebounds. Vay's Edinboro totals stand at 760 markers and 666 boards.
