Drop Thy still dews of quietness,

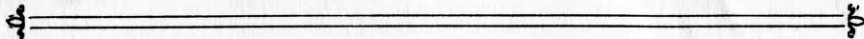
Till all our strivings cease;

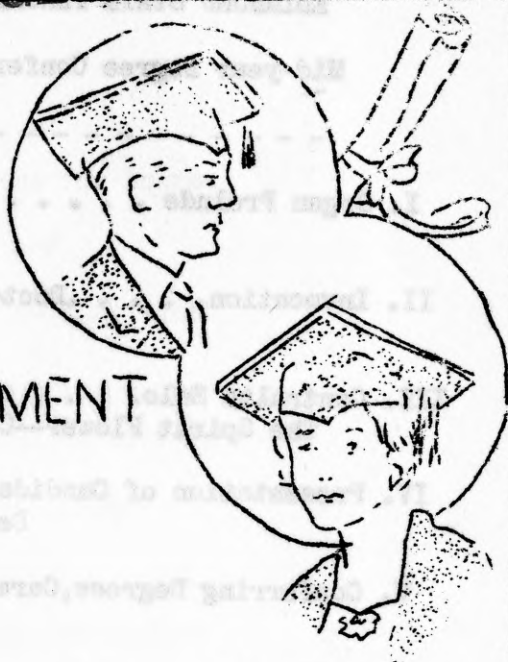
