THE CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, a symbol of presidential authority, is carried at the head of the academic procession by the Grand Marshal, Dr. Thomas White. A gift of the Alumni Association, the mace was designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel and Dr. Seymour Blinderman, former chairman of the Art Department. It was first used at the inauguration of Edinboro State College President Chester T. McNerney, in 1967.

The mace, twenty-seven inches in length, is topped by a sterling silver sphere studded with circular cabochon rubies, secured by bezels. The collar of the mace is inlaid with ebony, alternated with silver relief fleur-de-lis design elements. The cultured pearls mounted in cups encircle the bottom of the collar symbolizing the thirteen state colleges of Pennsylvania. The shaft of the mace is composed of Brazilian rosewood sections, separated by sterling silver rings. The mace is terminated by a cast sterling silver finial; the five cultured pearls represent the existing curricula. The rib-like cone form is terminated by a small silver sphere symbolizing the world.

The metal working processes incorporated in the ceremonial mace include turning, forging, inlaying, stone setting, and lost wax centrifugal casting.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The first presidential medallion was presented to former President Foster F. Diebold during the May, 1981 Commencement ceremonies. Designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel, the sterling silver medallion consists of a three and one-half inch pectoral pendant featuring on its face the figure of a Gordon Highlander with pipes. To the right of the piper is the Cross of St. Andrew. To the left is the Cross of England. Flanking the figure is the date 1857, the opening year of the University, and garland thistles. In the background are the hills of Scotland, and beneath the piper is an open book, a symbol of knowledge. On the reverse side is the sunken crest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The pendant descends from a shield containing a triple-towered castle. The collar of the medallion is comprised of a series of two-inch shields, alternately bearing three different designs: the meigle, an interlacing knotwork peculiar to the Pictish school of Celtic art; the Tudor rose design; and "ESC" in interlocking letters on a background of tabby weaving. Connecting each of the collar shields is a Cross of St. George, representing the union of Scotland and England. The entire medallion was fabricated and cast in the cire perdue (lost wax) process.

Surrounding the silver medallion is a gold crafted circle which reads "Edinboro University of Pennsylvania." Professor Katzwinkel, now retired, added this piece to the medallion especially for the Inauguration of President Frank G. Pogue in 1997, and it is now a permanent fixture to the medallion representing the school's current status as a University.

ACADEMIC VESTMENTS

The gown, the cap, and the hood, representing the major components of the academic dress, are a ceremonial inheritance from the medieval universities of the eleventh and twelfth centuries, where dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility. The academic dress worn by those participating in today's academic processional symbolizes the level of their academic attainment and the institution they attended.

GOWN

Although the gown is more frequently black, certain universities have authorized the use of colored gowns. The bachelor's and master's gowns are fashioned from black serge. The yoke for the bachelor's gown is designed to be worn closed and features long, flowing and pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn open or closed. Its sleeves are very long with square ends, and the front part has an arc cut away. The arms protrude through a slit at the elbow. The gown for the doctor's degree is made of wool, serge, or silk with an open front faced with wide velvet panels. The sleeves are loose and bell-shaped with three

bars of velvet in black or the color of the discipline in which the doctorate was obtained.

HOOD

The most outstanding feature of the academic dress is the hood. It is usually worn only for the master's and the doctor's degrees. The doctor's hood is longer than the master's hood and has distinguished panels. The college or the university granting the degree is indicated by the color of the hood lining. The velvet trim of the hood indicates the field in which the degree was granted.

CAP

The standard cap is the mortarboard, usually the color of the gown. The tassel is black for the baccalaureate and master's degree and is worn over the left front quarter of the cap. The tassel for the doctor's mortarboard is of gold thread. Undergraduates wear the tassel on the right side of the cap until the moment the degree is conferred by the president. Dr. Jeremy D. Brown became the 16th president of Edinboro University on July 1, 2007. Since his inauguration, he has established new pathways to academic excellence while leading the university in continued physical growth of the Edinboro campus. Dr. Brown has also traveled abroad to China, Korea, Panama, Poland, Russia and Taiwan to renew or establish new articulation and collaboration agreements with higher education institutions. In the coming months and years, he will continue to take Edinboro to the world and bring the world to Edinboro.

Since Dr. Brown assumed Edinboro's presidency, undergraduate and graduate enrollment has increased significantly along with the university's distance and online learning offerings. Under his leadership, the university is currently in the midst of a five-year construction window during which some \$200 million is being spent on physical campus improvements in the areas of academics, sports and recreation and student housing.

A renewed "Fighting Scots" school spirit accompanies the Brown presidency, which emphasizes Edinboro's Scottish heritage with events such as Tartan Day, the Purple Thistle Award to recognize outstanding faculty and staff, and a fresh marketing campaign directed at audiences in the traditional recruiting area as well as beyond the boundaries of northwestern Pennsylvania.

In athletics and recreation, Dr. Brown added another varsity sport, women's lacrosse, to Edinboro's lineup, and dedicated the new Mike S. Zafirovski Sports and Recreation Center, the region's largest freestanding domed facility. Men's and women's tennis, once one of the top programs in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference, will be reinstated beginning in 2010-11.

Dr. Brown came to Edinboro from SUNY Canton where he served as provost and vice president for academic affairs since 2003. As the 2,600-student university's chief academic officer, he steered campus-wide strategic planning, oversaw vigorous growth in distance learning opportunities and cultivated many international collaborations.

A native of Manchester, England, he earned both a Bachelor of Science and a Ph.D. in physics from the University of Birmingham, England. His doctoral work in experimental nuclear physics was conducted at the University of Birmingham. Immediately following the completion of his Ph.D. requirements, Dr. Brown spent two years at Indiana University doing nuclear physics research.

Following his stint at Indiana, Dr. Brown accepted a faculty position in the Physics Department of Princeton University, where in addition to continuing his research, he taught undergraduate and graduate-level physics courses. Transitioning into academic administration, Dr. Brown was named associate dean of the Graduate School at Yale University. Later, he returned to Princeton as associate dean of the faculty. In 2000, Dr. Brown was named rector of Florida State University-Panama, serving as the chief executive officer of a small U.S. university operating in Latin America.

During his career, Dr. Brown published many scholarly articles and has been an invited speaker at international conferences, research institutions and universities. He served as a visiting scientist at the University of Stellenbosch, the University of Manitoba, the Department of Nuclear Physics at Oxford University and the National Accelerator Centre in Cape Town.

The President's community service includes membership on Board of Corporators of the Hamot Health Foundation, the Board of Trustees for the Saint Vincent Health Center and System, and the Erie Philharmonic Orchestra's Board of Directors and chairmanship of the Board's education committee.

Dr. Brown and his wife, Rebeca, are the proud parents of Andrew Jeremy Brown. When not traveling for the university or engaged in myriad presidential duties, Dr. Brown likes to play squash. Weather permitting, Dr. Brown also enjoys sailing or skiing, and particularly takes delight in spending time with his sons Lucas, Gabriel, and Andrew, or visiting his family in England and Panama.



Having taken film courses while on sabbatical at Oxford University, Dr. Brown thoroughly enjoys unwinding Ьy watching movies. He is also an avid fan of England's Manchester United soccer team.

GRAND MARSHAL

Leading the academic procession and representing his faculty colleagues by carrying the ceremonial mace at today's Commencement is Dr. Thomas White of Edinboro University's Nursing Department.

As an Assistant Professor of Nursing and President of the University Senate, Dr. White's distinction as Mace Bearer for the Spring Commencement is symbolic of the central role which faculty play in the academic and personal development of Edinboro's students.

Dr. White, a native of nearby Venango and graduate of Cambridge Springs High School, began his post-secondary academic career in New Castle, Pennsylvania, where he earned a diploma in Professional Nursing from the Jameson Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. From there, it was off to Edinboro University and a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing in 1994, followed by a Master of Science degree in nursing in 1999.

By 2000, he had earned an additional 10 postmasters credits from Edinboro, and in 2006 he was awarded the Doctor of Education in Administrative and Leadership Studies degree from Indiana University of Pennsylvania.

His professional certifications are many and include Basic Life Support, Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Certified Emergency Nursing, Basic Life Support Instructor and National Board-Certified Family Nurse Practitioner.

Dr. White has made many professional presentations at the state and national levels, and his licensure by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and by the Drug Enforcement Agency includes Registered Nurse and Family Nurse Practitioner.

He began teaching at Edinboro University in 1995. His current assistant professorship responsibilities include providing clinical instruction for sophomore, junior, senior and graduate (nurse practitioner) students; classroom instruction in the area of medical/surgical nursing, pediatrics, pharmacology, and community health for undergraduate nursing students; and classroom instruction in assessment and diagnosis for graduate family nurse practitioner students. Dr. White is also employed at Saint Vincent Health Center's Emergency Department where his responsibilities include providing direct care for a wide variety of critical and non-critical patients, and serving as a charge nurse and trauma nurse leader.

His educational philosophy demonstrates a visceral understanding of the importance of providing complete health care education to students enrolled in one of Edinboro's most sought-after programs. In fact, that philosophy engenders a belief he conveys to students that education has no culmination. "Education is a lifelong journey," he tells his students. "My education truly began when I graduated from college!"

An avid traveler, Dr. White is particularly fond of his trips to Italy and to Hawaii.

Dr. White's background as an undergraduate and graduate student at Edinboro served to enhance and highlight a professional career here that has benefited his students and his colleagues. Like many in his field, he is respected Universitywide as well as in the local health care delivery system in the region beyond Edinboro.

Re-elected this year as President of the University Senate, one of Dr. White's tasks is to bring all segments of the Edinboro community together to participate in dealing with challenges facing higher education in general and at Edinboro University in particular.

Dr. White typifies the dedication and commitment of Edinboro University's faculty to



e d u c a tion a l excellence and service to s t u d e n t s . That's why his selection as our Commencement Grand Marshal honors not only Dr. White, but also Edinboro's entire faculty.

HONORARY DOCTORATE



Edinboro Alumnus Patrick J. Santelli has been selected to receive the degree, Doctor of Public Service (*Doctor Beneficiorum Publicorum, Honoris Causa*), at today's Commencement ceremony.

Mr. Santelli is being honored by President Jeremy D. Brown and the Edinboro University Council of Trustees for his leadership in business, his positive and lasting impact on individuals and institutions, for his commitment to education, for his dedication to the ideals of diversity in the workplace, for his enthusiastic and generous support of his Alma Mater, and "for reminding us by your own example that those to whom much has been given can make a difference in the world by being givers themselves."

A 1962 Edinboro graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Secondary Social Studies, he earned his Master's degree at the University of Pittsburgh in 1963. He taught at various high schools in Pittsburgh and New Jersey before joining Pfizer, Inc., in 1966.

Mr. Santelli enjoyed a distinguished career in sales and senior sales management at Pfizer's San Francisco and Pittsburgh offices. He was named "Salesperson of the Year" for the Great Lakes Region after his first year with the company, and was a charter member of the senior management team. In 1982, his district was the first in Pfizer's history to record \$10 million in sales. Mr. Santelli earned the company's All-Star award 16 times and the prestigious Pacesetter Award five times. In 1999, during his last year with Pfizer, his district was one of the first to break the \$100 million mark. Mr. Santelli retired in January 2000 after 34 years with Pfizer. For the next eight years, he was a member of the Ambassador Team representing Pfizer at national conventions, as well as those in Paris and Madrid, and also a consultant for management and representatives' teams.

With his lifelong passion for education and reaching out to the less fortunate, Mr. Santelli dedicated much of his professional energy to the ideals of diversity in the workplace. Striving for equal opportunity and access for all persons, he was appointed to Pfizer's Diversity Committee to implement a program for 90,000 Pfizer employees. His endeavors also led to the creation of the Patrick J. Santelli Diversity Scholarship, which helps alleviate social, cultural and economic barriers to educational and vocational opportunities. His scholarship promotes educational access for, among others, racial and ethnic minorities, single parents and female heads-of-household with children, older adults, displaced workers, and those with learning or physical disabilities.

Since 2002, Mr. Santelli has served with distinction on the Edinboro University Alumni Association's Board of Directors and its nominating and executive committees. He served on the Cabinet for the university's capital campaign in 2001, and was active in the Academy Hall and Normal Hall clock restoration projects. In 2005, he was part of the Business and Economics Department Speaker Series, and in 2009 was nominated for a Distinguished Alumni Award in Business and Industry.

Having served on the Boards of the American Heart Association of Western Pennsylvania and the American Diabetes Association, Mr. Santelli is an active supporter of the Christian Foundation for Children and Aging, Meals on Wheels, the National Italian-American Foundation, and the Sons of Italy. Each year he sponsors an Eagle Scout as well as the education of a child in India.

Mr. Santelli and his wife, Patricia, have been married for more than 45 years. They are the parents of two: Julie Lynn Santelli, M.D., a radiation oncologist in Stuart, Florida, and Michael Stuart Santelli, president of Labat-Anderson, a professional services firm providing litigation and information systems support to government agencies in McLean, Virginia.

broadens



Dr. Richards has a very unique way of meeting a student on their level in order to bring out the best in them. He not only fosters, but maintains a high level of intrinsic motivation in his students. "He is a man of his word, honor, mutual respect, dignity and intelligence," said



student La Rene Sanders. He goes above and beyond what is expected, and he treats everyone equally.

He is a dedicated, informed, passionate instructor that is a benefit to Edinboro University and the students he

teaches. "Because of Dr. Richards, I can honestly say that he made a positive impact on my life," said Black. "If there were more professors like him, there would be more students willing to learn, participate in class and leave the university with much more than an education."

Dr. LISA UNICO, of the Chemistry Department, is the 2010 Advisor of the Year. This award is presented each year to an Edinboro faculty member who stands out as an excellent academic counselor and who enables students to achieve their academic, personal and professional goals.

"Dr. Unico is a phenomenal teacher who inspired me to challenge myself," states an Edinboro alumnus, Jeremy Jonas. "Although she was not my appointed advisor, she took it upon herself to


Dr. MARY PANICCIA CARDEN, English and Theatre Arts Department, is Edinboro University's 2010 Scholar of the Year. The award was created as a means of recognizing the excellent practices and successes of the august members of our faculty. In so doing, our aim is not only to underscore the quality of the scholarship at Edinboro University, but also to encourage continued best practices among our faculty.

Dr. Carden has recently published Sons and Daughters of Self-made Men: Improvising Gender, Place, Nation in American Literature, a book of literary scholarship that promises to make a lasting and original contribution to the fields of both contemporary American Literature and contemporary American Culture Studies.



She has published numerous essay-length articles in major journals of literary scholarship, including four peer-reviewed articles since 2006. Three of Dr. Carden's articles have in the last four years been chosen for reprint as chapters in scholarly books whose shared publishers aim is to bring together the most important recent scholarship on their themes, authors and/or texts. She regularly contributes to literary encyclopedias and other reference works, and has presented at six nationally-recognized peerreviewed scholarly conferences since 2005. **Ms. LINDA LACNY**, Director of Grants and Sponsored Programs, is the 2010 Staff Member of the Year. The award is presented to an employee demonstrating uncommon commitment to students and to the achievement of our University-wide goals, objectives and priorities.

Nominator Dr. Jerra Jenrette states Ms. Lacny's superb writing skills, attention to the details of grant administration, and her commitment to the office have resulted in external awards that have risen from \$1.8 million in 2003 to \$4.8 million in 2009. Linda is a first rate colleague and a great asset to Edinboro University states Jenrette.



Ms. Lacny has helped to obtain funding which lead to acquisition of a 30-station, state-ofthe-art computer training center at Edinboro University in 2004, complete renovation of the center in 2010, and the opportunity to train more than 500 serving law enforcement personnel in computer investigation and forensic skills. Nominator Dr. David Ferster credits the success of the computer training center to Linda and states that if it weren't for Linda's encouragement, assistance and guidance, the computer training center would not be on our campus.

Linda uses her gracious manner and skillful negotiating style to encourage grant applications. She receives a great deal of respect among the faculty and staff because of her expertise, her knowledge, her positive and caring attitude, and her desire to give quality service to our university.

THE CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, a symbol of presidential authority, is carried at the head of the academic procession by the Grand Marshal, Dr. Thomas White. A gift of the Alumni Association, the mace was designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel and Dr. Seymour Blinderman, former chairman of the Art Department. It was first used at the inauguration of Edinboro State College President Chester T. McNerney, in 1967.

The mace, twenty-seven inches in length, is topped by a sterling silver sphere studded with circular cabochon rubies, secured by bezels. The collar of the mace is inlaid with ebony, alternated with silver relief fleur-de-lis design elements. The cultured pearls mounted in cups encircle the bottom of the collar symbolizing the thirteen state colleges of Pennsylvania. The shaft of the mace is composed of Brazilian rosewood sections, separated by sterling silver rings. The mace is terminated by a cast sterling silver finial; the five cultured pearls represent the existing curricula. The rib-like cone form is terminated by a small silver sphere symbolizing the world.

The metal working processes incorporated in the ceremonial mace include turning, forging, inlaying, stone setting, and lost wax centrifugal casting.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The first presidential medallion was presented to former President Foster F. Diebold during the May, 1981 Commencement ceremonies. Designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel, the sterling silver medallion consists of a three and one-half inch pectoral pendant featuring on its face the figure of a Gordon Highlander with pipes. To the right of the piper is the Cross of St. Andrew. To the left is the Cross of England. Flanking the figure is the date 1857, the opening year of the University, and garland thistles. In the background are the hills of Scotland, and beneath the piper is an open book, a symbol of knowledge. On the reverse side is the sunken crest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The pendant descends from a shield containing a triple-towered castle. The collar of the medallion is comprised of a series of two-inch shields, alternately bearing three different designs: the meigle, an interlacing knotwork peculiar to the Pictish school of Celtic art; the Tudor rose design; and "ESC" in interlocking letters on a background of tabby weaving. Connecting each of the collar shields is a Cross of St. George, representing the union of Scotland and England. The entire medallion was fabricated and cast in the cire perdue (lost wax) process.

Surrounding the silver medallion is a gold crafted circle which reads "Edinboro University of Pennsylvania." Professor Katzwinkel, now retired, added this piece to the medallion especially for the Inauguration of President Frank G. Pogue in 1997, and it is now a permanent fixture to the medallion representing the school's current status as a University.

ACADEMIC VESTMENTS

The gown, the cap, and the hood, representing the major components of the academic dress, are a ceremonial inheritance from the medieval universities of the eleventh and twelfth centuries, where dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility. The academic dress worn by those participating in today's academic processional symbolizes the level of their academic attainment and the institution they attended.

GOWN

Although the gown is more frequently black, certain universities have authorized the use of colored gowns. The bachelor's and master's gowns are fashioned from black serge. The yoke for the bachelor's gown is designed to be worn closed and features long, flowing and pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn open or closed. Its sleeves are very long with square ends, and the front part has an arc cut away. The arms protrude through a slit at the elbow. The gown for the doctor's degree is made of wool, serge, or silk with an open front faced with wide velvet panels. The sleeves are loose and bell-shaped with three bars of velvet in black or the color of the discipline in which the doctorate was obtained.

HOOD

The most outstanding feature of the academic dress is the hood. It is usually worn only for the master's and the doctor's degrees. The doctor's hood is longer than the master's hood and has distinguished panels. The college or the university granting the degree is indicated by the color of the hood lining. The velvet trim of the hood indicates the field in which the degree was granted.

CAP

The standard cap is the mortarboard, usually the color of the gown. The tassel is black for the baccalaureate and master's degree and is worn over the left front quarter of the cap. The tassel for the doctor's mortarboard is of gold thread. Undergraduates wear the tassel on the right side of the cap until the moment the degree is conferred by the president.

PRESIDENT JEREMY D. BROWN

Dr. Jeremy D. Brown became the 16th president of Edinboro University of Pennsylvania on July 1, 2007. In the short time since his inauguration, President Brown has already established new pathways to academic excellence while leading the University in continued physical growth of the Edinboro campus. He has also traveled to Russia, Taiwan, China, Poland and South Korea, renewing or establishing new articulation and collaboration agreements with higher education institutions abroad, and has plans to travel to Bosnia and Mexico for the same purposes.

Since Dr. Brown assumed Edinboro's presidency, graduate studies program enrollment has increased significantly along with the University's distance and online learning offerings. His tenure also includes oversight of more than \$150 million in new and future construction projects.

A renewed "Fighting Scots" school spirit accompanies the Brown presidency, which emphasizes Edinboro's Scottish heritage with events such as Tartan Day, the Purple Thistle Award to recognize outstanding faculty and staff, and a fresh marketing campaign directed at audiences in the traditional recruiting area as well as beyond the boundaries of northwestern Pennsylvania.

Dr. Brown came to Edinboro from SUNY-Canton where he served as provost and vice president for academic affairs since 2003. As the 2,600-student university's chief academic officer, he steered campus-wide strategic planning, oversaw vigorous growth in distance learning opportunities and cultivated many international collaborations.

A native of Manchester, England, he earned both a Bachelor of Science and a Ph.D. in physics from the University of Birmingham, England. His doctoral work in experimental nuclear physics was conducted at the University of Birmingham and the University of California-Berkeley. Immediately following the completion of his Ph.D. requirements, Dr. Brown spent two years at Indiana University doing nuclear physics research.

Following his stint at Indiana, Dr. Brown accepted a faculty position in the Physics Department of Princeton University, where in addition to continuing his research, he taught undergraduate and graduate-level physics courses. Transitioning into academic administration, Dr. Brown was named associate dean of the Graduate School at Yale University. Later, he returned to Princeton as associate dean of the faculty. In 2000, Dr. Brown was named rector of Florida State University-Panama, serving as the chief executive officer of a small U.S. university operating in Latin America.

During his career, Dr. Brown has published many scholarly articles and has been an invited speaker at international conferences, research institutions and universities. He served as a visiting scientist at the University of Stellenbosch, the University of Manitoba, the Department of Nuclear Physics at Oxford University and the National Accelerator Centre in Cape Town.

As an Assistant Professor of Nursing and President of the University Senate, Dr. White's distinction as Mace Bearer for the Winter Commencement is symbolic of the central role which faculty play in the academic and personal development of Edinboro's students.
