THE CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, a symbol of presidential authority, is carried at the head of the academic procession by the Mace Bearer. A gift of the Alumni Association, the mace was designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel and Dr. Seymour Blinderman, former chairman of the Art Department. It was first used at the inauguration of Edinboro State College President Chester T. McNerney, in 1967.

The mace, twenty-seven inches in length, is topped by a sterling silver sphere studded with circular cabochon rubies, secured by bezels. The collar of the mace is inlaid with ebony, alternated with silver relief fleur-de-lis design elements. The cultured pearls mounted in cups encircle the bottom of the collar symbolizing the thirteen state colleges of Pennsylvania. The shaft of the mace is composed of Brazilian rosewood sections, separated by sterling silver rings. The mace is terminated by a cast sterling silver finial; the five cultured pearls represent the existing curricula. The rib-like cone form is terminated by a small silver sphere symbolizing the world.

The metal working processes incorporated in the ceremonial mace include turning, forging, inlaying, stone setting, and lost wax centrifugal casting.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The first presidential medallion was presented to former President Foster F. Diebold during the May, 1981 Commencement ceremonies. Designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel, the sterling silver medallion consists of a three and one-half inch pectoral pendant featuring on its face the figure of a Gordon Highlander with pipes. To the right of the piper is the Cross of St. Andrew. To the left is the Cross of England. Flanking the figure is the date 1857, the opening year of the University, and garland thistles. In the background are the hills of Scotland, and beneath the piper is an open book, a symbol of knowledge. On the reverse side is the sunken crest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The pendant descends from a shield containing a triple-towered castle. The collar of

the medallion is comprised of a series of two-inch shields, alternately bearing three different designs: the meigle, an interlacing knotwork peculiar to the Pictish school of Celtic art; the Tudor rose design; and "ESC" in interlocking letters on a background of tabby weaving. Connecting each of the collar shields is a Cross of St. George, representing the union of Scotland and England. The entire medallion was fabricated and cast in the cire perdue (lost wax) process.

Surrounding the silver medallion is a gold crafted circle which reads "Edinboro University of Pennsylvania." Professor Katzwinkel, now retired, added this piece to the medallion especially for the Inauguration of President Frank G. Pogue in 1997, and it is now a permanent fixture to the medallion representing the school's current status as a University.

ACADEMIC VESTMENTS

The gown, the cap, and the hood, representing the major components of the academic dress, are a ceremonial inheritance from the medieval universities of the eleventh and twelfth centuries, where dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility. The academic dress worn by those participating in today's academic processional symbolizes the level of their academic attainment and the institution they attended.

GOWN

Although the gown is more frequently black, certain universities have authorized the use of colored gowns. The bachelor's and master's gowns are fashioned from black serge. The yoke for the bachelor's gown is designed to be worn closed and features long, flowing and pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn open or closed. Its sleeves are very long with square ends, and the front part has an arc cut away. The arms protrude through a slit at the elbow. The gown for the doctor's degree is made of wool, serge, or silk with an open front faced with wide velvet panels. The sleeves are loose and

bell-shaped with three bars of velvet in black or the color of the discipline in which the doctorate was obtained.

HOOD

The most outstanding feature of the academic dress is the hood. It is usually worn only for the master's and the doctor's degrees. The doctor's hood is longer than the master's hood and has distinguished panels. The college or the university granting the degree is indicated by the color of the hood lining. The velvet trim of the hood indicates the field in which the degree was granted.

CAP

The standard cap is the mortarboard, usually the color of the gown. The tassel is black for the baccalaureate and master's degree and is worn over the left front quarter of the cap. The tassel for the doctor's mortarboard is of gold thread. Undergraduates wear the tassel on the right side of the cap until the moment the degree is conferred by the president.

INTERIM PRESIDENT JAMES D. MORAN



Dr. James D. Moran became Interim President of Edinboro University of Pennsylvania on June 1, 2011. Since his arrival at Edinboro nearly a year ago, Dr. Moran has successfully led the University through a period of fiscal challenge and a number of i m p o r t a n t

student-centered initiatives, while at the same time becoming fully engaged with virtually every University constituency, as well as reaching out to the local communities. Under his leadership, Edinboro University has launched the extensive planning and self-study process in preparation for reaccreditation by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education.

Before coming to Edinboro, Dr. Moran was the Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs for the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education (PASSHE). PASSHE's 14 Universities – including Edinboro – represent some 120,000 students. In his administrative position there, Dr. Moran provided strategic leadership and direction for the Division of Academic and Student Affairs, which is responsible for overseeing academic program approval and review, faculty development, academic and student policy development, and articulation and transfer policies. He worked closely with the Pennsylvania Department of Education on a number of initiatives and provided testimony before various committees of the Pennsylvania General Assembly.

Dr. Moran serves on the advisory board for the National Center for the Study of Collective Bargaining in Higher Education, and is a member of the Governor's Early Learning Council. He provides leadership for PASSHE's Access to Success Initiative in partnership with EdTrust.

Previously, Dr. Moran served in the University of Tennessee System Office as Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs.

There, he facilitated development of a Knoxville business incubator, formation of a statewide multi-university academic consortium in public health and federal funding for the Center for Nutrition and Fitness.

Dr. Moran held several other positions at the University of Tennessee, including Dean of the College of Human Ecology. He also has been Department Head of Family Relations and Child Development at Oklahoma State University, and a faculty member at the University of Tennessee, Oklahoma State University, Virginia Tech University and the University of Oklahoma.

He is the recipient of the Distinguished Alumnus Award from the College of Human Environmental Sciences at Oklahoma State University, the Environmental Design Award from the American Society of Interior Designers, and the AHEA Leaders Award from the American Home Economics Association. He was elected and served as the President of the American Association of Family and Consumer Sciences in 2004.

Interim President Moran holds Bachelor of Arts degrees in Psychology and History from Duke University, a Master of Science degree in Psychology from the University of Oklahoma, and a Ph.D. in Family Relations and Child Development from Oklahoma State University.

MACE BEARER

Leading the academic procession and representing his faculty colleagues by carrying the Ceremonial Mace at today's Master's Commencement is Dr. Ronald Spiller of Edinboro University's Department of History, Anthropology, and World Languages.

As an Assistant Professor of History, Dr. Spiller's distinction as Mace Bearer for the Master's Commencement is symbolic of the central role which faculty play in the academic and personal development of Edinboro students.

A native of Natchitoches, Louisiana, he grew up in a U.S. Army family and attended nine different schools before entering Northwestern State University in Natchitoches as a Music Education major.

Dr. Spiller graduated from NSU in 1970 with a Bachelor of Arts in International Relations and was commissioned an officer in the U.S. Army. He graduated from the John F. Kennedy Center for Special Warfare and the Defense Language Institute, and served with the United Nations Protection Force for the former Yugoslavia in 1994.

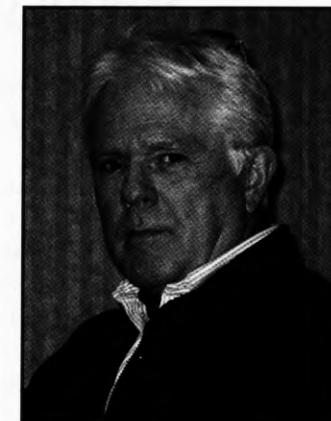
In 1986, Dr. Spiller earned the Master of Arts in History at Stephen F. Austin State University, and in 1993, he was awarded the Ph.D. in History from Texas A&M University. His specialty is American military history.

Dr. Spiller joined the Edinboro faculty in 1996. The year after his arrival, however, he was again mobilized and served for nine months as the U.S. Army's senior historian in Europe. He retired from the Army in 1998 with the rank of Colonel.

His most recent publication was a chapter entitled, "The U.S. Army Since 1900," in *A Companion to American Military History*, edited by James Bradford.

Several years ago, Dr. Spiller was instrumental in the coordination of a very significant event on the Edinboro campus, the installation of the traveling Vietnam Memorial Wall. The exhibit was open to the public for a week of visitation and educational programs in which he participated, including those for hundreds of regional school students.

Currently, Dr. Spiller serves as the head of the University's Master of Arts program in Social Sciences. He is a member of the University-Wide Curriculum Committee and served on the University Tenure Committee.



In recognition of his talents as a teacher and mentor, Dr. Spiller was recently named Advisor of the Year for 2011-2012.

Dr. Spiller and his late wife, Kay, are the proud parents of two daughters, Elizabeth Roper of Houston, Texas, and Sharon Spiller of Erie.

Dr. Spiller's extensive experience in teaching and learning, along with his credentials as an accomplished historian, define a professional career that serves his students, colleagues, and the entire University community with distinction. He exemplifies the dedication and commitment of our faculty to the "Edinboro Experience," to educational excellence, and to our students' success.

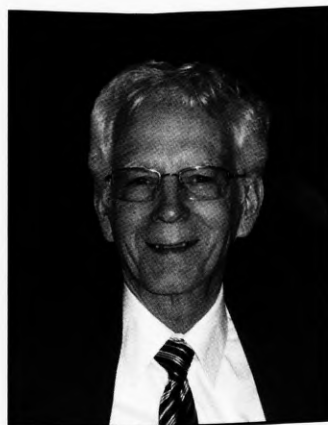

MACE BEARER



Leading the academic procession and representing his faculty colleagues by carrying the Ceremonial Mace at today's undergraduate Commencement is Dr. Albert O. "Tim" Cordell of Edinboro University's

Music Department.

As a Professor of Music, Dr. Cordell's distinction as Mace Bearer for the undergraduate Commencement is symbolic of the central role which faculty play in the academic and personal development of Edinboro's students.

A native of Greenville, South Carolina, Dr. Cordell was the first member of his family to attend college. He earned the Bachelor of Music Education from East Carolina University in 1969, and the Master of Music from Catholic University in 1973. He completed the Ph.D. in Musicology, also from Catholic University, in 1992, with a specialty in the orchestration of the operas of the Italian master, Giuseppe Verdi.

During his tenure at Edinboro, Dr. Cordell directed the "Spirit of Scots" Marching Band, the Symphonic Band and the University Orchestra, as well as the Erie Junior Philharmonic. He is a past president of District 2, Pennsylvania Music Educators Association and a member of Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity. He received the Orpheus Award from Phi Mu Alpha for significant and lasting contributions to music in America, and the Innovative Excellence in Teaching and Learning Award.

An early adopter of web technology in the classroom, Dr. Cordell was the first Edinboro University Technology Scholar. He participated in multiple international conferences on the innovative use of technology in teaching. In 1995, his class on "Opera" was possibly the first

ever to use the web to publish class work, including student research, and an account of that process appeared in *Musicus*, a journal of higher education councils in England and Scotland.

Through the efforts of Dr. Cordell and a colleague, Dr. Brian Zimmerman, the University's Scotland study-abroad program Edinboro@Edinburgh became a reality in 1997. In 2000, a proposal by Edinboro faculty for an interdisciplinary study-abroad experience on the Scottish Enlightenment was accepted by the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education as its annual, System-wide Summer Honors Program. The highlight of that visit was an audience with His Royal Highness Prince Phillip.

Dr. Cordell served for two years as Associate Provost for Student-Centered Initiatives, and as Director of the University Honors Program. He completed a textbook, "Encounters with Music through Listener Actions," and contributed a chapter for a proposed book by a group of Verdi scholars.

Dr. Cordell and his wife, DiAnne, are the proud parents of two daughters, Alison Cannon and Kelly Johnson, both Edinboro University graduates.

Dr. Cordell's career as an educator, musician, conductor, innovator and scholar has served his students, colleagues, and the entire University community with distinction. He exemplifies the dedication and commitment of our faculty to the "Edinboro Experience," to educational excellence, and to our students' success.

COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS

Edinboro Alumna Kathleen A. Dahlkemper has been selected to address the graduating class at today's Undergraduate Commencement ceremony. Ms. Dahlkemper is being honored in this manner for her leadership in government, business, and her community, as well as her volunteerism and commitment to women's leadership and the environment.

A 1982 Magna Cum Laude graduate of Edinboro University with a Bachelor of Science in Dietetics, Ms. Dahlkemper also recently completed the Executive Education program, "Women and Power: Leadership in a New World," at Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government.

A member of the U.S. House of Representatives representing Pennsylvania's 3rd Congressional District from 2009 to 2011, Ms. Dahlkemper served on the Agriculture Committee; the Small Business Committee, where she was Chair of the Subcommittee on Regulations and Healthcare; and on the Science and Technology Committee, where she served as Vice Chair of the Subcommittee on Investigations and Oversight.

Currently, she is the Director of Business Development for Dahlkemper Landscape Architects and Contractors. Previously, she served as the company's Human Resources Director, as well as its Special Projects Coordinator. She is also currently a broker for Agility Marketing in Erie, Pennsylvania, as well as a national speaker on women's leadership issues. Ms. Dahlkemper's dedication and commitment to the environment and her community was clearly in evidence between 1998 and 2008 when she served as the volunteer director of the Lake Erie Arboretum at Frontier. A co-founder of this non-profit organization, she was instrumental in raising over \$1.75 million through grant awards and private donations to fund the development of what has become an important regional asset in. In addition, Ms. Dahlkemper planned and successfully implemented various community educational and recreational programs at the arboretum. She continues to serve as vice president of the board of directors of the Arboretum.

Ms. Dahlkemper previously operated a nutrition consulting practice, concentrating on wellness, diabetes and childhood early intervention. Earlier, after her graduation from Edinboro, she was employed as Chief Clinical Dietitian at the Medical Center Hospital in Conroe, Texas.

Her community and national involvement includes the Advisory Board of the Pennsylvania Center for Women and Politics, the faculty of Project 2012, the board of directors for the Non-Profit Partnership, the board of directors of Democrats for Life, and Athena International in the Erie area.

Married to Daniel Dahlkemper, she is the mother of two sons and three daughters and the grandmother of four.

In recognition of her significant accomplishments and contributions, Ms. Dahlkemper will receive the degree, Doctor of Public Service (Doctor Beneficiorum Publicorum, Honoris Causa, at today's Undergraduate Commencement ceremony.

EDINBORO UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT



Dr. Julie E. Wollman

Dr. Julie E. Wollman became Edinboro University's 17th President on June 1, 2012. Since arriving at Edinboro, President Wollman has led an unrelenting focus on the highest levels of excellence for the University. Initiatives in her first months as President have included the expansion of programs to support student success and the launch of a listening and strategic planning process that has engaged all constituencies of the campus community.

The first woman to lead the university, President Wollman came to Edinboro from Wheelock College in Boston, Massachusetts, where she served as Vice President for Academic Affairs for four years. At Wheelock, she was responsible for overseeing the college's academic programs. She was also involved both

in fundraising, helping to boost the college's grant funding from \$300,000 to more than \$4.3 million, and in the establishment of multiple community partnerships to help expand program options and recruit new students.

Dr. Wollman earned her Bachelor of Arts degree in English and American literature and language with a minor in French from Harvard University in 1981. She holds a Master of Science degree in elementary education from the University of Pennsylvania and a doctoral degree in elementary education from New York University. She also attended the Institute for Education Management at the Harvard Graduate School of Education.

She began her academic career as a social studies teacher and curriculum coordinator at Germantown Academy in Fort Washington, Pennsylvania. Additionally, she was a teacher at Ethical Culture School in New York City for three years, during which time she also served as a research assistant at New York University. She later worked as a professional development facilitator at the New York Coalition Center for Education Leadership and, in 1989, was hired as an instructor at both New York University and Pace University. She was hired as a faculty member in elementary education at Rhode Island College in 1992 and spent nearly 15 years at the college, including three years as Dean of the Feinstein School of Education and Human Development. Dr. Wollman was named vice president for academic affairs at Worcester State College in Worcester, Massachusetts, in 2007, where she was responsible for overseeing academic programming. She also led the college's strategic planning efforts, established an online scholarly journal and redesigned the college's program review process.

Over the years, President Wollman has written numerous articles that have been published in academic journals, and has written two books on teaching writing and literature. She is a member of The American Association of State Colleges and Universities and serves on AASCU's Committee on Policies and Procedures, and is an institutional representative to the Association of American Colleges and Universities, the American Council on Education, and the Council on Undergraduate Research, among other professional associations. She has worked with numerous community organizations, and is a member of the Erie Regional Chamber and Growth Partnership Board of Directors and the UPMC Hamot Board of Corporators.

President Wollman is married to Dr. Dan L. King, Executive Director of the American Association of University Administrators, a national professional organization. She has two daughters: Sara Bonilla, 21, a recent graduate of Wesleyan University, and Rosa Bonilla, 17, a senior in high school.

MACE BEARER



Dr. Kathleen Benson

Leading the academic procession and representing her faculty colleagues by carrying the Ceremonial Mace at today's undergraduate Commencement is Dr. Kathleen Benson, chairperson of Edinboro University's Department of Elementary, Middle and Secondary Education.

As a department chairperson and Professor of Education, Dr. Benson's distinction as Mace Bearer is symbolic of the central role that faculty play in the academic and personal development of Edinboro University students.

An Edinboro alumna, Dr. Benson earned her Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education in 1972 and Master of Education with a Reading Specialist Certificate in 1975, both from Edinboro State College, and her Elementary Principal Certificate in 1983, the year the college achieved University status. She earned her Ph.D. in Elementary Education at the University of Akron in 1998.

She was a classroom teacher in the Millcreek Township School District, a community liaison representative for the Career Assessment Center, Inc., in Erie, Pennsylvania, and a career development coordinator and reading specialist for the Northwest Tri-County Intermediate Unit #5 prior to returning to her alma mater to teach in 1990. She was named Edinboro University's Educator of the Year in 2010.

Dr. Benson has helped prepare hundreds of teachers during her years at Edinboro and has been the University's Director of Student Teaching since 2008. "I still love teaching and believe that my enthusiasm for the profession and in particular for what I teach is contagious," she said. "I have even stood on my head for my students if they promise to be good teachers and integrate reading strategies into their regular teaching and learning in their middle and secondary classrooms."

In addition to her work in the classroom and in the field as an advisor, Dr. Benson has served on numerous committees in her department and the School of Education; chaired regional middle-level education conferences; and made many presentations at state, national and international conferences. Her community involvements have included election to two terms on the Millcreek Township School Board and an active role as an appointed member of the Erie Vital Signs project. "In my future, I hope to continue my lifelong advocacy for middle level education as well as being a strong voice for equal educational opportunities for all students, including those least served by our current education system," she said.

Dr. Benson's career as an educator, department chair, student teaching director and enthusiastic mentor has served her students, colleagues and the entire University community with distinction. She exemplifies the dedication and commitment of our faculty to educational excellence and to our students' success.

COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS



John E. Brown

John E. Brown is a writer, ordained minister, pastoral counselor and musician, but he considers his salient life's work the founding in 1989 of the Medicare-certified Hospice of Crawford County, Pennsylvania. The organization was the only such hospice in the region at the time, and he served as its first CEO, Pastoral Counselor and Music Therapist. After his first retirement in 1998, he continued as President of the Board of Directors and has held subsequent positions to this day. He also served on the Board of Directors of Pennsylvania Hospice Network.

Currently, Rev. Brown's job title is Pastoral Counselor at Meadville Medical Center, but he often is referred to as "Pastoral Troubadour." He is on the staff of the hospital's Pastoral Care Department, where in the past 10 years he has developed a unique ministry combining music and inspiration for patients in their rooms. He is an accomplished folk, blues and popular song musician, and over the years has taught guitar and banjo to dozens of children and young people.

Rev. Brown earned two undergraduate degrees and a Master of Divinity from Eastern Theological Seminary of Philadelphia (now Palmer Seminary) and has done doctoral work at the University of Pennsylvania. He is an ordained American Baptist minister and has served as Director of Youth Publications for The American Baptist Board of Education and Publication in Valley Forge, Pennsylvania, and later as Managing Editor for Macrae-Smith Company of Philadelphia, a publisher of educational and children's books.

In Rev. Brown's extensive writing career, more than 150 of his articles have been published in a variety of publications, including four in *The American Journal of Hospice and Palliative Care*. He is listed in *Contemporary Authors*, Volume 45; most of the seven titles attributed to him are in the field of religious education. He also is a published poet and essayist, writing for several small daily newspapers on a wide range of topics, and serves as a speaker and seminar leader in addition to occasionally stepping in as a supply minister for a range of denominations.

Rev. Brown and his wife, Martha, reside in Meadville, Pennsylvania, and have traveled widely. He considers his most riveting journey a trip to Russia in 1996 at the invitation of the fledgling hospice movement there. At a time when there were only 20 hospices in all of Russia, he traveled with a group of American hospice professionals to share their expertise with their Russian counterparts.

THE CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, a symbol of presidential authority, is carried at the head of the academic procession by the Mace Bearer. A gift of the Alumni Association, the mace was designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel and Dr. Seymour Blinderman, former chairman of the Art Department. It was first used at the inauguration of Edinboro State College President Chester T. McNerney, in 1967.

The mace, twenty-seven inches in length, is topped by a sterling silver sphere studded with circular cabochon rubies, secured by bezels. The collar of the mace is inlaid with ebony, alternated with silver relief fleur-de-lis design elements. The cultured pearls mounted in cups encircle the bottom of the collar symbolizing the thirteen state colleges of Pennsylvania. The shaft of the mace is composed of Brazilian rosewood sections, separated by sterling silver rings. The mace is terminated by a cast sterling silver finial; the five cultured pearls represent the existing curricula. The rib-like cone form is terminated by a small silver sphere symbolizing the world.

The metal working processes incorporated in the ceremonial mace include turning, forging, inlaying, stone setting, and lost wax centrifugal casting.

PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The first presidential medallion was presented to former President Foster F. Diebold during the May 1981 Commencement ceremonies. Designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel, the sterling silver medallion consists of a three and one-half inch pectoral pendant featuring on its face the figure of a Gordon Highlander with pipes. To the right of the piper is the Cross of St. Andrew. To the left is the Cross of England. Flanking the figure is the date 1857, the opening year of the University, and garland thistles. In the background are the hills of Scotland, and beneath the piper is an open book, a symbol of knowledge. On the reverse side is the sunken crest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The pendant descends from a shield containing a triple-towered castle. The collar of the medallion is comprised of a series of two-inch shields, alternately bearing three different designs: the meigle, an interlacing knotwork peculiar to the Pictish school of Celtic art; the Tudor rose design; and "ESC" in interlocking letters on a background of tabby weaving. Connecting each of the collar shields is a Cross of St. George, representing the union of Scotland and England. The entire medallion was fabricated and cast in the *cire perdue* (lost wax) process.

Surrounding the silver medallion is a gold crafted circle which reads "Edinboro University of Pennsylvania." Professor Katzwinkel, now retired, added this piece to the medallion especially for the Inauguration of President Frank G. Pogue in 1997, and it is now a permanent fixture to the medallion representing the school's status as a University.

ACADEMIC VESTMENTS

The gown, the cap, and the hood, representing the major components of the academic dress, are a ceremonial inheritance from the medieval universities of the eleventh and twelfth centuries, where dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility. The academic dress worn by those participating in today's academic processional symbolizes the level of their academic attainment and the institution they attended.

Gown

Although the gown is more frequently black, certain universities have authorized the use of colored gowns. The bachelor's and master's gowns are fashioned from black serge. The yoke for the bachelor's gown is designed to be worn closed and features long, flowing and pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn open or closed. Its sleeves are very long with square ends, and the front part has an arc cut away. The arms protrude through a slit at the elbow. The gown for the doctor's degree is made of wool, serge, or silk with an open front faced with wide velvet panels. The sleeves are loose and bell-shaped with three bars of velvet in black or the color of the discipline in which the doctorate was obtained.

Cap

The standard cap is the mortarboard, usually the color of the gown. The tassel is black for the baccalaureate and master's degree and is worn over the left front quarter of the cap. The tassel for the doctor's mortarboard is of gold thread. Undergraduates wear the tassel on the right side of the cap until the moment the degree is conferred by the president.

Hood

The most outstanding feature of the academic dress is the hood. It is usually worn only for the master's and the doctor's degrees. The doctor's hood is longer than the master's hood and has distinguished panels. The college or the university granting the degree is indicated by the color of the hood lining. The velvet trim of the hood indicates the field in which the degree was granted.
