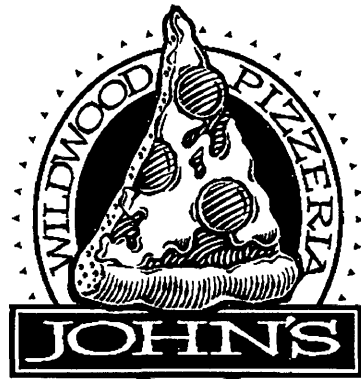

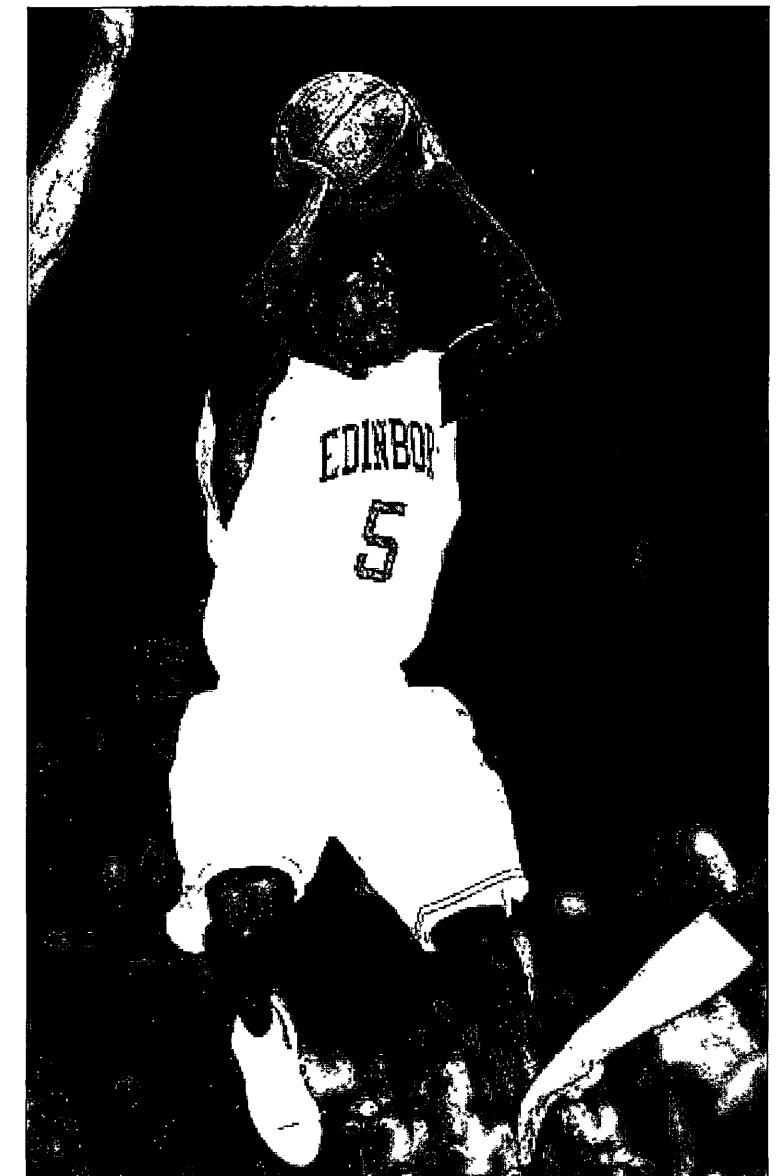

Welcome to McComb fieldhouse as the Edinboro University men's basketball team opens up the home portion of its schedule against local rival Allegheny. If tonight's contest is anything like Monday's Edinboro-Mercyhurst affair, the fans are in for a real treat. That contest saw the two teams battle into double overtime before Mercyhurst handed the Boro its first loss by a 90-86 count. Allegheny, meanwhile, returns to the hardwood for the first time since last Saturday, when the Gators dropped an 84-78 decision to Westminster in the championship game of the DAD's Holiday Classic.

THE BORO-ALLEGHENY SERIES

This is the first meeting between the two schools in team years, with Edinboro capturing a 100-99 overtime decision against the Gators in 1989-90. Allegheny holds a 14-11 edge in the all-time series which first began in 1930-31.

THE COACHES

Edinboro mentor **Greg Walcavich** is in his 11th season, posting a record of 185-102 during that period. He broke the Edinboro record for coaching victories last year. Walcavich has guided the Scots to the PSAC Tournament the last four years and seven times overall. In addition, the Scots have reached the NCAA Division II Playoffs three times. Edinboro has won twenty-or-more games five times under Walcavich, including a 26-8 finish in 1997-98, the most wins in school history. Overall, Walcavich has a record of 339-164 and is in his 18th season as a head coach. Allegheny head coach **Phil Ness** has enjoyed great success, as well, now in his tenth campaign. He has a 159-111 record. Ness has led the Gators to back-to-back NCAA Division III playoff appearances.

SCOUTING THE SCOTS

Edinboro brings a record of 2-1 into the contest, having won the championship of the Wendy's Classic. After playing more of a defensive brand of ball in '98-99, permitting just 69.5 ppg., the Scots are a more up-tempo team, averaging 87.3 ppg. while giving up 77.3 ppg. Most

impressively, despite facing constant size disadvantages, Edinboro has out-rebounded its first three foes by wide margins ... the guard tandem of **Adam Kaufman** and **Jean Paul** rates as highly as any one in the PSAC. Kaufman, a 5'11" junior, is the consummate floor general. While averaging 12.3 ppg., he has handed out 27 assists in just 5 turnovers. He has made 9 of 18 three-pointers. Paul, meanwhile, a 6'4" sixth-year senior with a sweet jumper. He comes off career-highs of 26 points and 13 rebounds at Mercyhurst, boosting his averages to 18.7 and 7.3, respectively ... fans will surely like what they see of **Kenny Tate**. The sophomore is undersized at 6'4" for a power forward, but he doesn't play like it. The transfer from New Mexico JC has already had two double-doubles, including 27 points and 16 boards at Mercyhurst. He leads the Scots in scoring (23.0 ppg.), rebounds (12.0 rpg.) and steals (8). Tate was the MVP of the Wendy's Classic ... another juco transfer is 6'4" junior **Keith Allen**. After averaging 25.1 points at Community College of Beaver County to earn All-American honors, Allen is finding the going more difficult at the Division II level, but he still comes in at 10.3 ppg. and 7.0 rpg... freshman **Jason Roseto** opens at center. At 6'10", 255 lbs., he provides a presence in the middle. He already owns 11 blocked shots in addition to averages of 5.7 ppg. and 4.7 rpg. Roseto played his high school ball at Harbor Creek ... another local product, McDowell's **Rob Schodt**, paces the bench brigade. The 6'8" junior averages 7.3 ppg... look for 6'4" sophomore **James Dickerson** to also see plenty of reserve duty. Dickerson averages 5.7 points and 6.0 rebounds.

SCHODT, DELSANDRO REUNITED

As high school performers, Rob Schodt and Jake Delsandro combined to make McDowell High School one of the best programs in the state. Now the two will renew acquaintances for the first time. Schodt is a 6'8" junior for Edinboro, while Delsandro, is a 6'0" senior who earned first team All-North Coast Athletic Conference honors a year ago.

KAUFMAN LAUDED

Adam Kaufman has received plenty of preseason recognition. The 5'11" junior guard landed on three preseason All-American teams. He was listed among *Basketball News* Players to Watch, and earned a spot on the honorable mention preseason All-American teams of *Street & Smith's College Basketball* and *Division II Bulletin*. Kaufman was a first team All-PSAC West performer a year ago after earning second team accolades as a freshman. He was recently chosen to the PSAC West preseason all-conference squad.

MORE ON ADAM'S ASSISTS

Kaufman's forte is the assist, and he is fast approaching the school record for scoring passes. He passed Dave Knowlton on Monday to move into second place with 503 assists. Now only Steve Senko's 515 career assists stand

between him and the school record. The Boro floor general handed out a school-record 273 assists as a freshman, good enough to tie the PSAC record and rank third in Division II, then was credited with 203 assists last season.

TATE TERRIFIC

Kenny Tate has made quite a first impression. The 6'4" sophomore, a transfer from New Mexico JC, scored 32 points and had 12 rebounds in his Boro debut vs. West Liberty. He went on to earn MVP honors at the Wendy's Classic. On Monday, he led the Scots with 27 points and had a season-high 16 rebounds in the double overtime loss at Mercyhurst. Tate is a former standout at fabled Chester High School.

SCOUTING THE GATORS

The Gators of Allegheny come off a 19-9 finish a year ago and a second straight berth in the NCAA Division III playoffs. Coach Phil Ness' team is off to a 2-2 start thanks to a stingy defense that is permitting just 65.0 ppg. and holding opponents to 44.1 percent shooting ... Allegheny features three double figure scorers, with former McDowell High School standout **Jake Delsandro** leading the way. The 6'0" senior averages 13.5 ppg., and has also been deadly from the line, canning 15 of 17 freebies (88.2 percent). A first team All-North Coast Athletic Conference choice last year, he leads the team with 27 assists and 10 steals ... sophomore **Damon Clayton**, a 6'4", 220 lb. forward, provides the inside muscle. Clayton averages 12.8 points and a team-high 6.5 rebounds. He is a very efficient shooter, making 68.8 percent of his field goal attempts ... the third double figure operative is **Kevin McGarrah** (10.2 ppg.). The senior guard has made 5 of 12 three-pointers ... in addition to McGarrah, the Gator's rely on **Chris Good** for outside firepower. The senior guard has made 5 of 13 triples ... nine players average twelve or more minutes per game ... in addition to Delsandro, **Adam Straub** is another Erie native on the Gator roster. Straub, a 6'2" freshman, is a reserve guard.
