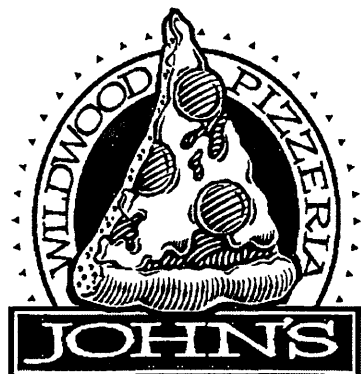

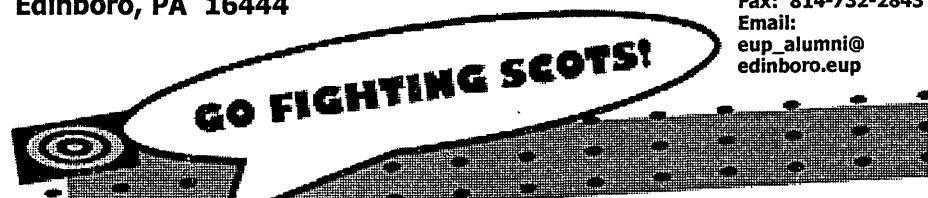

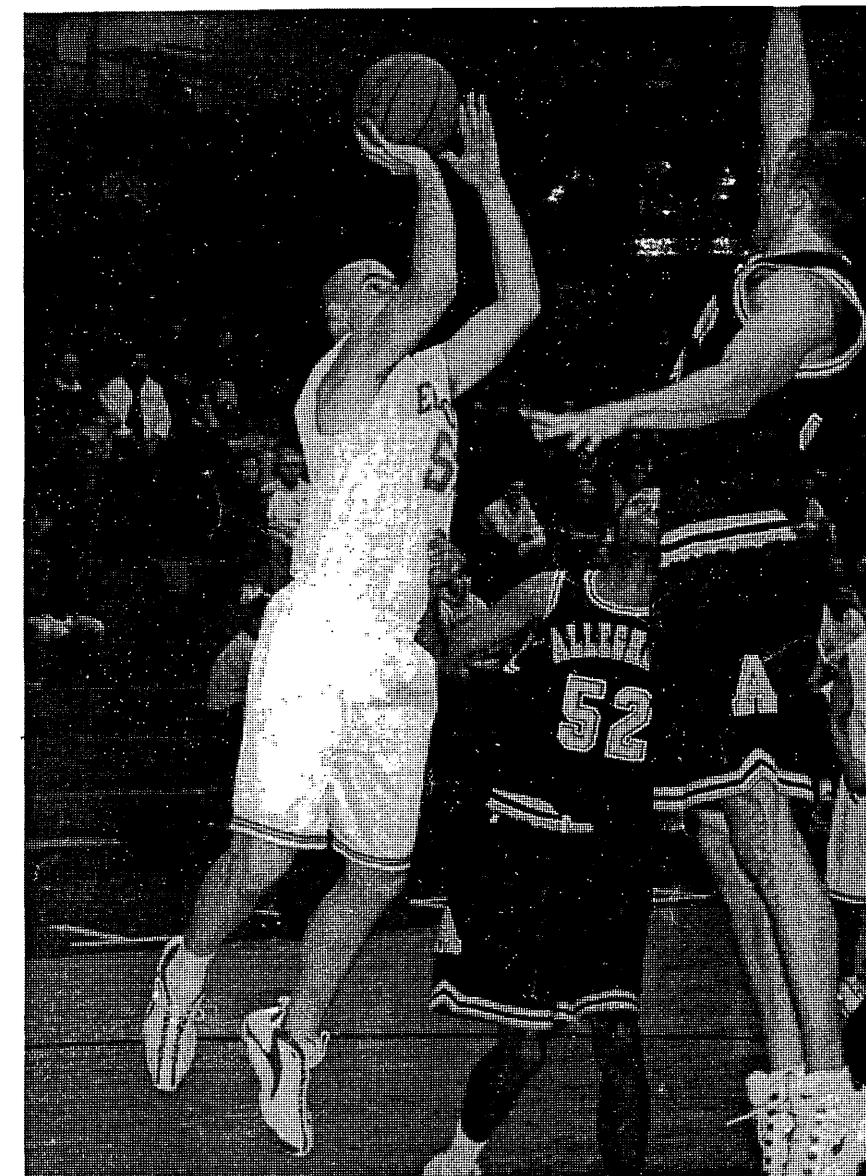

# Tonight's Game

It's an early meeting of Western Division leaders as Edinboro entertains California(Pa.). Both teams opened conference play with wins on Wednesday, the Boro with a pulsating 85-74 triumph over Clarion, while the Vulcans subdued Slippery Rock, 63-51.

## THE BORO-CALIFORNIA(PA) SERIES

Cal leads 72-64  
 The Vulcans were the only PSAC team to capture both meetings against Edinboro a year ago. The Vulcans prevailed at home by an 81-69 count, then upended the Scots in McComb, 69-54.

## THE COACHES

Edinboro mentor **Greg Walcavich** is in his 11th season, posting a record of 190-106 during that period. The all-time leader in coaching wins at Edinboro, Walcavich has an overall career mark of 341-164 and is in his 18th season as a head coach. California(Pa.) mentor **Bill Brown** is in the midst of his fourth season in charge of the Vulcans, with a 76-26 mark. His overall record in 14 years as a head coach is 196-142.

## SCOUTING THE SCOTS

Edinboro opened PSAC West action with a n 85-74 overtime win over Clarion on Wednesday. The Fighting Scots were left for dead with less than seven minutes to play and trailing 58-48. Despite losing leading scorer and rebounder **Kenny Tate** to fouls moments later, the Boro would outscore Clarion 7-1 in the last 90 seconds, with **James Dickerson's** layup with 19 ticks left sending the contest into overtime. Led by **Adam Kaufman**, the Scots romped in the extra five minutes, holding the Golden Eagles to just three free throws ... Kaufman notched a season-high 21 points while adding 8 assists. **Jean Paul** contributed 18 points, Tate 15 plus 11 rebounds, and **David Gartrell** scored 14 points. **Jason Roseto** helped the Boro rule the glass with 10 grabs, adding 4 blocked shots.

## KAUFMAN STILL CLIMBING

Junior point guard **Adam Kaufman** broke the Boro career assist record earlier in the sea-

son, and is now climbing the PSAC career assist chart. He owns 579 career assists, good for eighth all-time. In addition, he is climbing on the Boro career charts for steals and three-pointers made. His most impressive numbers must still be 25 turnovers in 447 minutes.

JC transfer **Kenny Tate** has registered six double-doubles in his first 12 games as a Fighting Scot. The 6'4" sophomore is the only Scot to score in double figures in every game, leading the team in both scoring (18.7 ppg.) and rebounding (10.5 ppg.).

## PATROLLING THE PAINT

Freshman **Jason Roseto** is providing the scots with an intimidating presence in the middle. The 6'10", 255 lb. center leads Division II in blocked shots, now owning 49. He is becoming more of a rebounder each time out, tying his season-high with 10 vs. Clarion.

## WINDEX MEN

Edinboro figures to have its hands full tonight on the glass against a tall Vulcan squad, but the Boro hasn't backed down from anybody in the rebounding department. The Scots have outrebounded their opponent in 11 of 12 games, with Gannon the only team to own an advantage.

## MCCOMB MADNESS

Edinboro is a perfect 5-0 at home in 1999-2000, and has a record of 35-2 at McComb Fieldhouse dating back to 1996-97.

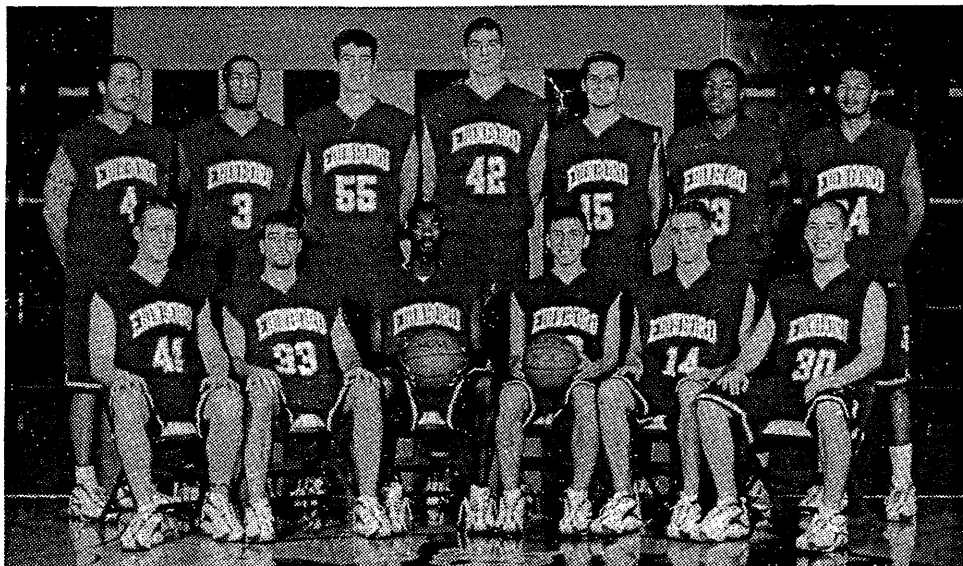

## SCOUTING THE VULCANS

After winning the PSAC Championship, reaching the NCAA Division II Tournament and finishing with a 24-6 record, the Vulcans were chosen as the logical preseason favorite in the PSAC West. Some would say that their current 12-4 record is somewhat disappointing. But don't tell that to coach Bill Brown. And remember an old saying: let sleeping dogs lie. Three of their four losses have come to teams ranked in the NABC Division II Top 25 -- to 12th-ranked Northern Kentucky (73-63), 16th-ranked Charleston (90-74) and 19th-ranked Ashland (85-83). Cal also owns a 63-60 win over 9th-ranked Metro State ... the Vulcans possess an imposing frontline led by consensus preseason All-American **Seth Martin**. The 6'8", 225 lb. junior is averaging 16.4 ppg. and 5.6 rpg., while shooting 57.4 percent from the floor. He was a first team All-PSAC West choice last year ... after sitting out the '98-99 campaign, **Rah-Shun Roberts** is once again a force in the middle. The 6'9", 245 lb. senior shows averages of 13.7 ppg. and 6.3 rpg., with 15 blocks. Roberts, a second-team All-PSAC West choice in '97-98, shoots 59.4 percent from the floor ... **Melvin Myers** (12.8 ppg., 3.5 rpg.) completes the trio. He owns 31 three's in 87 tries ... the top three-point threat is **Matt Molinaro**, a sophomore guard who has made 35 of 77 triples while averaging 8.6 ppg. ... **Cort Hamilton** is the Vulcan floor general. The 6'0" junior has 68 assists and 30 steals, both team highs.
