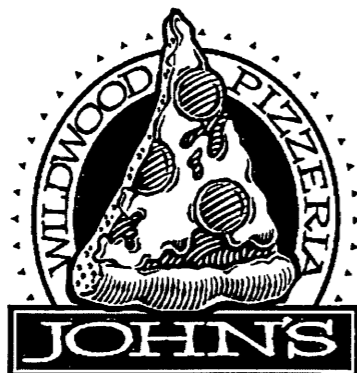

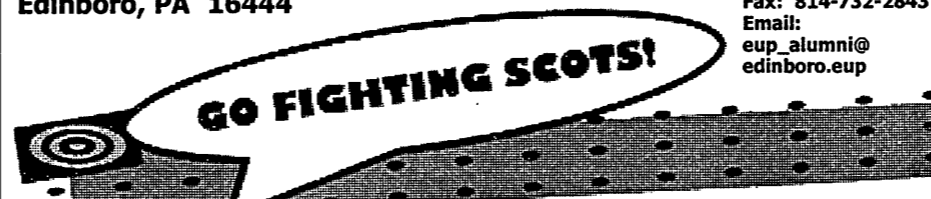

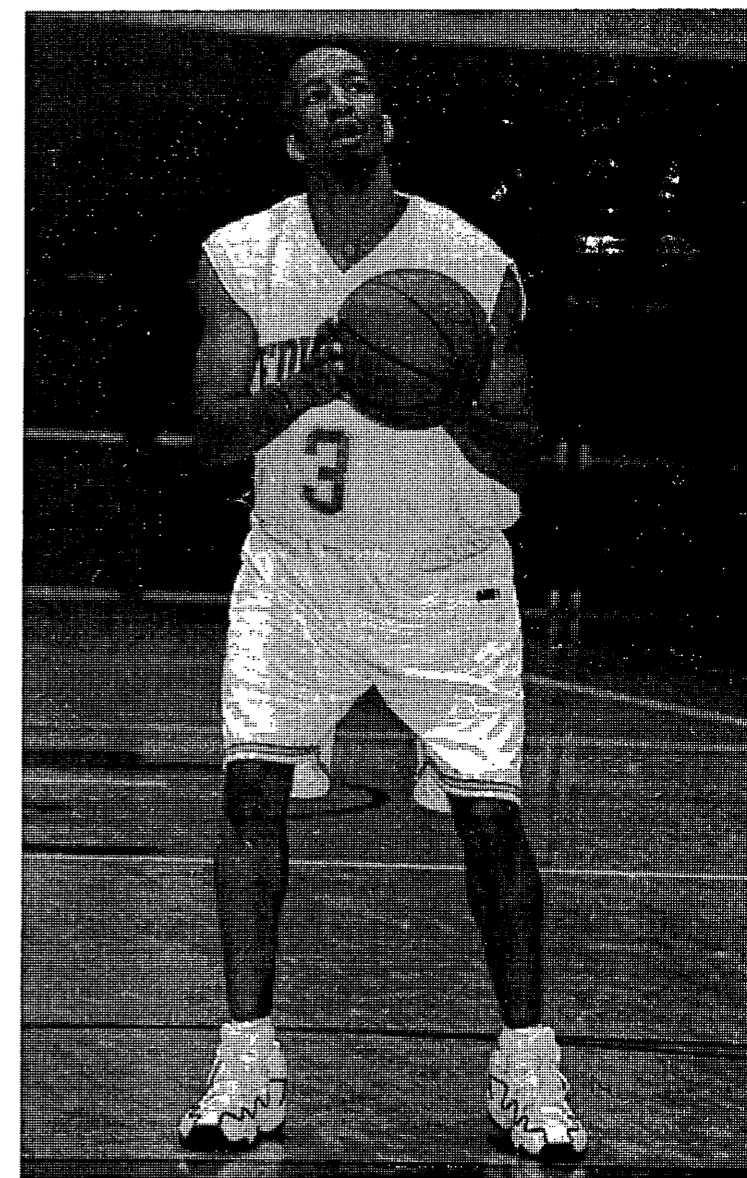

## EDINBORO

"Fighting Scots"

Record: 10-7, 2-2 PSAC West

## LOCK HAVEN

"Bald Eagles"

Record: 6-11, 1-3 PSAC West

Edinboro and Lock Haven hook up in a PSAC West match as conference play approaches the halfway mark. The Fighting Scots, now 10-7 overall and 2-2 in league play following Wednesday's 74-61 loss at IUP, can ill afford a home loss. Lock Haven picked up its first PSAC WEST win the same night, a 70-64 triumph over Shippensburg. The Bald Eagles snapped a four-game losing skid while improving to 6-11 and 1-3 in the PSAC West.

### THE BORO-LOCK HAVEN SERIES

Edinboro leads 68-16

Edinboro captured both meetings with the Bald Eagles a year ago, winning 80-70 at McComb Fieldhouse and 73-67 at Lock Haven. The Fighting Scots own a 12-game winning streak versus LHU, with the Bald Eagles last prevailing in 1992-93.

### THE COACHES

Edinboro mentor **Greg Walcavich** is in his 11th season, posting a record of 193-109 during that period. The all-time leader in coaching wins at Edinboro, Walcavich has an overall career mark of 347-172 and is in his 18th season as a head coach. Lock Haven mentor **John Wilson** is in his first season at the helm of the Bald Eagles but is well-known in PSAC circles as a former assistant at Millersville.

### SCOUTING THE SCOTS

Edinboro led by 12 points late in the first half of its contest at IUP, only to see the Indians run off the final 12 points of the first half and the first basket of the second stanza for a 35-33 lead. The Fighting Scots kept matters close until hitting another dry spell in the final minutes. IUP outscored the Scots 14-2 over the last six minutes. **Kenny Tate** again led the way with 16 points, his 17th straight game in double figures. **Keith Allen** added 14 points, while **Adam Kaufman** had 10 points and 9 assists. The game pitted the PSAC's top two rebounding teams, with IUP 12th in Division II. The Scots won the rebounding war, 40-34.

### KAUFMAN STILL CLIMBING

Junior point guard **Adam Kaufman** broke the Boro career assist record earlier in the sea-

son, and is now climbing the PSAC career assist chart. He owns 626 career assists, good for fifth all-time. In addition, he is climbing on the Boro career charts for steals and three-pointers made. His most impressive numbers must still be 38 turnovers in 647 minutes. And speaking of minutes, he has now played 245 straight minutes without a breather, playing in every minute of the last six games.

JC transfer **Kenny Tate** has registered eight double-doubles in his first 17 games as a Fighting Scot. The 6'4" sophomore is the only Scot to score in double figures in every game, leading the team in both scoring (19.8 ppg.) and rebounding (10.2 ppg.). He ranks 33rd in Division in scoring and 14th in rebounding.

### PATROLLING THE PAINT

Freshman **Jason Roseto** continues to lead Division II in blocked shots. The 6'10", 255 lb. center now owns 71. That figure is the third-highest total ever at the Boro, one shy of Michael Johnson's 72 blocks last year.

## SCOUTING THE BALD EAGLES

John Wilson picked up his first conference win on Wednesday as his Bald Eagles clipped Shippensburg, 70-64. Lock Haven featured four players in double figures, led by **Cedric Hameed** with 15 points and 12 rebounds. **Rico Abbondanza** had his usual solid all-around night with 12 points, 9 rebounds and 7 assists ... Abbondanza, a 6'4" guard, was a second-team All-PSAC West choice last year. He is leading the Bald Eagles in scoring (13.5 ppg.), rebounding (6.6 rpg.), assists (6.2) and steals (3.3). There's no truth to the rumor he sells popcorn at halftime of home games ... Hameed, a 6'6", 240 lb. junior, is a juco import who has had a large impact. He is averaging 10.4 ppg. and 5.7 rpg. while shooting 63.0 percent from the floor, second in the PSAC. Hameed also owns 25 blocks, good for fourth in the league ... **Justin Seitz** is a third double figure operative. The 6'3" freshman averages 11.5 ppg. in a reserve role ... **Joaquin Porrata**, a senior guard, is the top three-point threat with 28 in 83 attempts. He averages 9.4 ppg... Lock Haven has a 1-6 record in away games, but is 2-1 on neutral courts.
