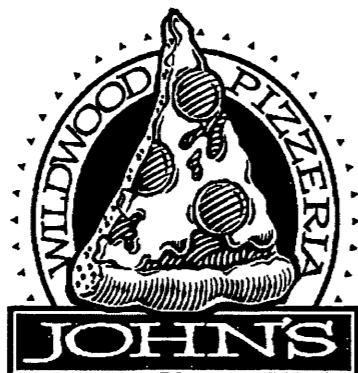

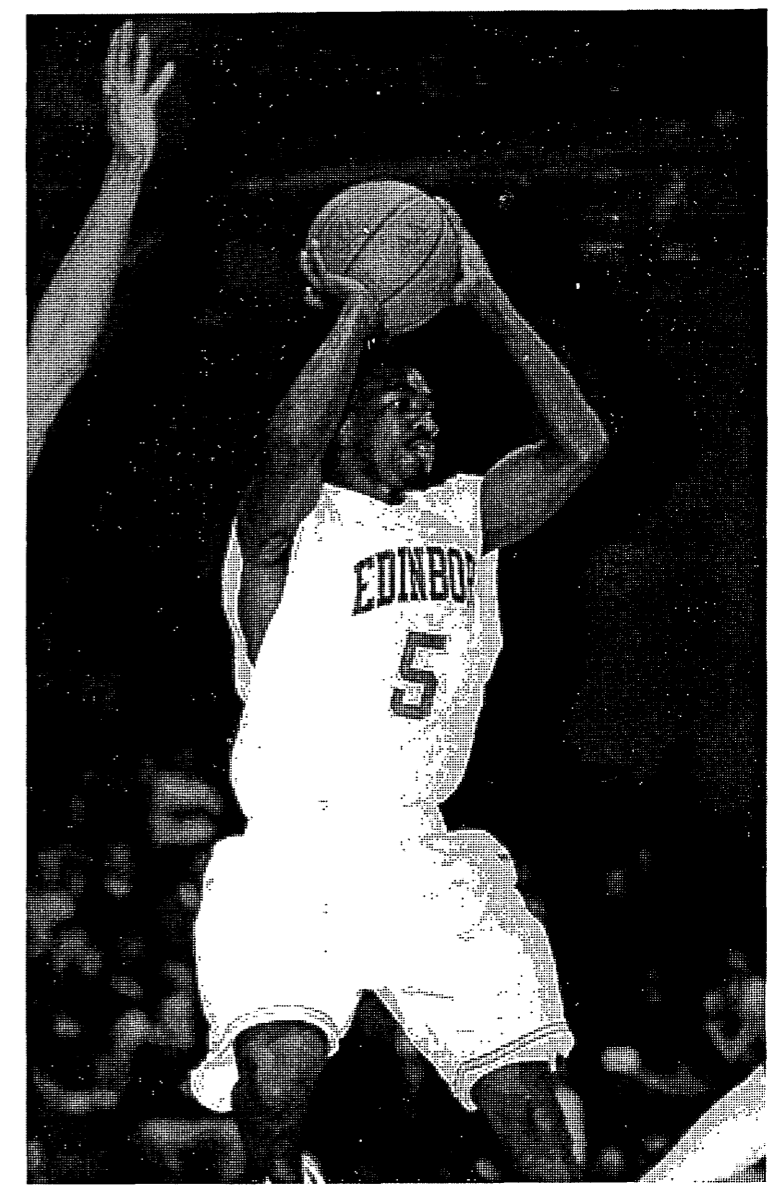

Welcome to the final showing of Edinboro Fighting Scot basketball for 1999-2000 at McComb Fieldhouse. The Boro's playoff light is still flickering, but barely, as the Scots are now 3-6 after suffering their fifth straight loss on Wednesday, a 71-63 decision to IUP. Three of the four PSAC West spots have been taken, with Edinboro and Slippery Rock vying for the lone remaining slot. The Rockets are 5-5 and already own a win over the Boro. Several scenarios still exist, but the most important thing is Edinboro needs to snap its losing skein. Shippensburg did just that on Wednesday, ending an 11-game skid with an 89-73 triumph over Lock Haven. The 89 points represented a season-high.

THE BORO-SHIPPENSBURG SERIES

Edinboro leads 18-7. Edinboro has run off five straight wins in its series with the Red Raiders, including a 65-62 decision at Ship on January 22. The Scots won despite shooting just 34.5 percent from the floor, but held a 42-25 edge on the glass. Kenny Tate led the way with 22 points, with Keith Allen contributing 12 points and 10 rebounds. Tom Roth paced the Red Raiders with 15 markers, Ron Banks adding 12.

THE COACHES

Edinboro mentor **Greg Walcavich** is in his 11th season, posting a record of 194-1134 during that period. The all-time leader in coaching wins at Edinboro, Walcavich has an overall career mark of 348-177 and is in his 18th season as a head coach. Shippensburg mentor **Rodger Goodling** is the dean of PSAC coaches, completing his 30th campaign. Goodling shows a career record of 346-425, all at Shippensburg.

SCOUTING THE SCOTS

You can't fault the Scots for their effort, but the results have not been what Greg Walcavich expects. Edinboro has lost five straight contests, tying the record for a Walcavich-coached team at Edinboro. The 1992-93 Scots opened the season with five straight setbacks. The veteran Boro coach has been unable to come up with a suitable replacement for 6'10" freshman **Jason Roseto**. Roseto went down with a broken

hand and has missed the last six games. It's not for a lack of effort. **Ramee Davis** pulled down a season-high 7 rebounds against IUP, and the sight of 6'2" walk-on **Ryan Leahy** winning his battle with 6'7" IUP star Steve Menifee had to please Walcavich.

KAUFMAN A WARRIOR

Junior point guard **Adam Kaufman's** climb up the PSAC career assist ladder has been well documented. But his ability to answer the bell game-in and game-out is equally noteworthy. He is averaging 39.0 minutes per game, and has now played an incredible 494 of a possible 495 minutes over the last eleven games. And on the season he has committed just 51 turnovers in 896 minutes.

THE TEAM THAT COUNTS SHOOT STRAIGHT?

Want one reason why the Scots have fallen on hard times? Try an inability to hit shots. Wednesday's 25.7 percent field goal figure just exemplified what has become a nightmare for Greg Walcavich. During the five-game losing streak, Edinboro is shooting just 38.8 percent from the floor. Nine times this season they have failed to shoot 40 percent.

AU REVOIR JEAN PAUL

Today's contest marks the final home appearance of senior guard **Jean Paul**. The native of Florida joined the Fighting Scots a year ago after previously playing football and basketball at Indiana University. He finished as the second-leading scorer a year ago, and enters today's contest in the same position. J.P. is averaging 14.5 ppg., and has been particularly effective of late. He led the Scots with 21 points on Wednesday and scored a career-high 27 markers in the recent double overtime loss at Clarion.

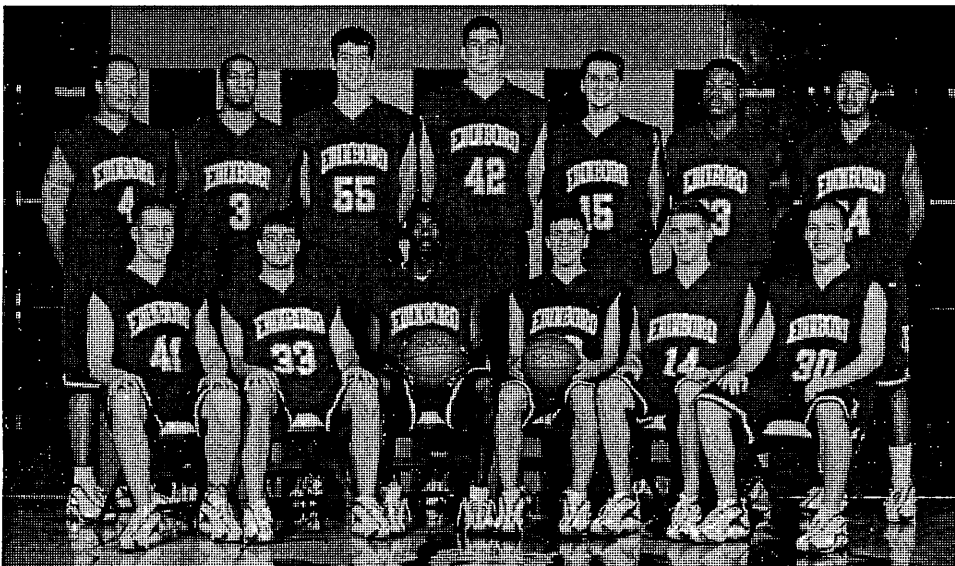

SCOUTING THE RED RAIDERS

Shippensburg snapped an 11-game losing streak with Wednesday's 89-73 win over Lock Haven, scoring more points than in any game all season. Four Red Raiders reached double figures, led by **Jason Lester** with 19 points and **Tom Roth** with 18. The team shot 55.9 percent from the floor ... the duo of Roth and Lester are the lone players in double digits, as the 6'6" Roth comes in with team highs of 12.7 ppg. and 7.7 rpg. Lester, meanwhile, is a 6'2" senior who is second to Roth in both categories at 10.6 ppg. and 5.1 rpg. Roth also owns 36 three-pointers, although five Red Raiders have made at least 20 triples ... like Edinboro, the Red Raiders have struggled mightily with their shooting. In fact, even after shooting 56 percent on Wednesday, they come in at 38.6 percent for the year ... ten players play at least ten minutes per game, with freshman guard **Ron Banks** (9.6 ppg., 7.3 assists) and junior forward **Brian Gleason** (9.2 ppg., 4.9 rpg.) sure to see plenty of PT ... **Michael Means** stepped in at center recently, and while the 6'7", 215 lb. freshman averages just 3.7 ppg. and 1.9 rpg., he comes off a 16-point effort vs. Lock Haven ... one player who hasn't seen much time is freshman **Jeff Madara**. A year ago the 6'0" guard was tearing up the Erie County League for General McLane High School. Now he has played just 32 minutes in six games, with 5 points and 2 rebounds.
