

Andy Findlay is Edinboro University's men's and women's Head Tennis Coach. Also, he is head professional at the Pennbriar Athletic Club in Erie. Andy coaches at the USTA Area Training Center and has attended three consecutive national A.T.C. workshops in Indianapolis from where he brings back this year's camp theme-"Strength and Speed"

A 1981 communications graduate of nearby Mercyhurst College, where he posted an 81-32 singles and a 72-27 doubles record, Andy was a five-time All-American and Academic All-American. Also to his credit is the Erie College Athlete of the Year Award, Mercyhurst's Garvey Award and Scholar-Athlete Award.

Findlay brings to Edinboro tennis over 16 years of experience in tennis camps, teaching, coaching and administration. He serves as a USTA clinician, has directed USTA district, sectional and national tournaments and is well travelled, coaching national level players. In 1992, Andy was the Allegheny Mountain Tennis Association "Coach of the Year," was ranked #1, with Edinboro alum Dennis Ranalli, in the Middle States Tennis Association's 35 doubles division and achieved a #68 ranking in national 35's singles.

Andy is an active member of the United States Professional Tennis Association, serves on the East region rankings and awards committees for the ITA, is a member of the Head Tennis Staff and coaches the AMD Men's 35's team.



Facilities/Directions

This camp fully uses Edinboro University's 12 outdoor tennis courts and uses indoor courts in Erie in case of bad weather. Campers may also use other recreational facilities; an AAU-size pool, basketball, complete gymnasium, racketball, pool, sand volleyball, bookstore, convenience store, bank, proshop, stringing and repair service.

Campers are housed in university dorms supervised full-time by coaching staff and counselors. All-you-can-eat meals will be served in Van Houten Dining Hall.

The University is only 18 miles south of Erie and 100 miles from the cultural centers of Buffalo, Cleveland and Pittsburgh.

When traveling north or south on I-79, take the Edinboro exit. Follow Rt. 6N to Edinboro.
