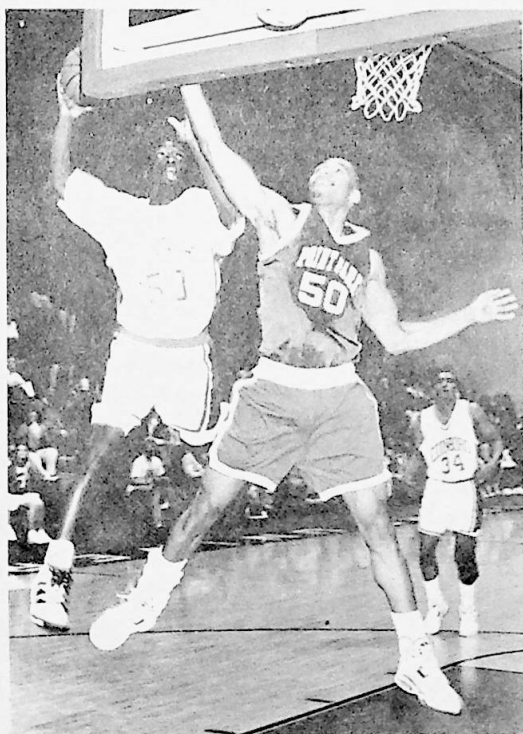


FIGHTING SCOTS BASKETBALL CAMP

GREG WALCAVICH, director

Greg Walcavich has completed six years directing Edinboro University's men's basketball program. With 92 wins in five seasons, including three seasons with 20 or more, his career collegiate coaching record is 246-104, 72 percent in twelve seasons as a head coach. The 1993-94 season was Edinboro's finest ever as a NCAA Division II member.

Coach Walcavich has taken his teams to both the NAIA and NCAA playoffs. His teams have been ranked in top 20 polls nationally seven times in 12 seasons as head coach.

Coach Walcavich was selected as an assistant coach for the South squad in the 1981 Olympic Festival where Michael Jordan was a member of his team.

He has conducted basketball camps on three different college campuses and has worked as a counselor, instructor and lecturer across the country. Noted for his ability to break down the fundamentals of the game, teach, and motivate, he has proven to be one of the best in a camp experience.

STERLING WASHINGTON

Sterling Washington, a volunteer assistant under Coach Greg Walcavich in 1991-92, begins his third season as Edinboro's assistant basketball coach.

Washington, who played for the Scots from 1988-91, was an All-PSAC first team choice following his senior season. He was also tabbed to the All-East Region second team by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).

Edinboro's 16th best all-time rebounder with 526, Washington also netted 931 points to rank in the top 20 among Fighting Scot players. He played just two and one-half seasons at Edinboro after spending three years in the United States Army. Also a great defensive player, Washington totaled 161 career steals including 75 his senior year, the second most for a single season in Fighting Scot history.

Washington graduated from Edinboro University in May 1992 with a bachelor of arts in criminal justice and a minor in geography.

"We are thrilled that Sterling has chosen to come to our program," Walcavich said. "He brings a great deal to our team, our program and our University. His dedication and intensity as a player will serve him well as a coach. Sterling's vast experience in the military certainly will be a positive trait in his coaching career."
