STAFF

Stan Swank, Head Womens Basketball Coach, has just completed his eighth season at Edinboro University. His Lady Scots own an impressive 135-90 overall mark which includes a pair of PSAC Western Division Titles and a State Championship. His teams have participated in four state championship games and been in three NCAA Eastern Regionals. His 1989-90 squad completed it's season by making the Sweet Sixteen of the NCAA tournament. In the past eight seasons, he has produced five All-Americans and numerous PSAC All-Conference players. Four of his former players have received professional contracts to play basketball after college. Under Coach Swank, the Edinboro program has made a strong turn around and is always considered a top program in the Eastern United States, as evidenced this past season by being ranked as high as #2 regionally and #20 nationally. Prior to his stint in Edinboro, Swank guided Parkland College in Illinois. During his four years there, he led his teams to a stellar 104-20 record, including several sectional, regional, and national honors. Coach Swank is a 1976 graduate of Purdue University where he also received his M.S. Degree in Educational Administration in 1979.

In addition to Coach Swank, several high school coaches, former players, and past staff will be on hand to assist with all phases of the camp. Trainers and the training facility will be available for assistance with water, ice, and advice with injuries.

CAMP

The **Stan Swank Basketball Camp** is geared for high school girl's basketball teams for grades 9 through 12. The main objective of camp is to establish an environment where high school girls receive the opportunity to play competitive games against other high school teams. A game clock, officials, and keeping score to simulate a regular high school game award the opportunity for each individual and team to improve their game. There will be **Varsity & Junior Varsity** leagues to provide appropriate levels of play for everyone. The basic format of camp is designed for playing games, although time is scheduled for each coach to practice with his/her team in order to improve. In addition, there will be "Mini-Seminars" that players may attend on their own or as a team. These "Mini-Seminars" will include such topics as Offense, Defense, Rebounding, Weight Training, Academics, Positive Attitude, Motivation, etc.

Individuals are welcome to sign up for Camp. Individuals will be grouped into teams and coached by a staff member for the week, so they will benefit from a team concept. Each team will play a minimum of 14 games during the course of the week. Each game will consist of four eight minute quarters.

Each night there will be optional recreation for swimming, watching game highlight films, or just lounging in the dormitory. In addition, a tradition of camp is the talent show which always brings fun and laughter.

The Stan Swank Basketball Camp is an opportunity for high school girls to improve their skills as individuals and within a team concept. It will be an experience to enhance each player and build a championship team for next basketball season.
