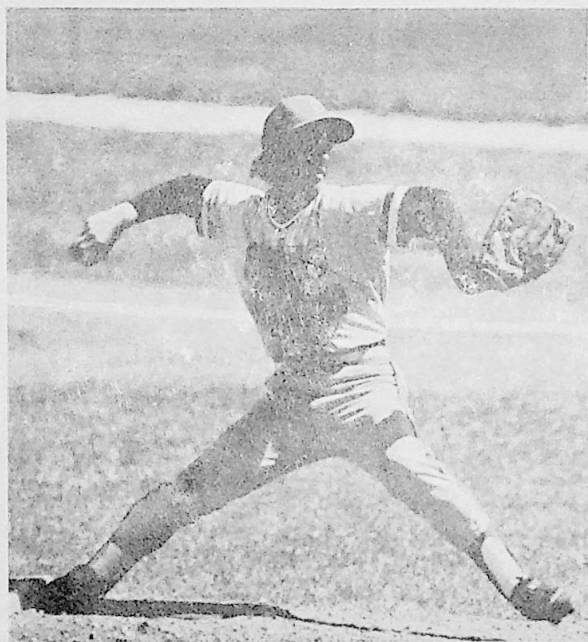

CAMP DIRECTOR



Coach John Radovich is in his eighth year as Edinboro University's head baseball coach. Here at Edinboro, Radovich has turned the baseball program into a perennial contender in the well respected Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference, one of the largest and most competitive Division II conferences in the nation.

Last year, he led the Fighting Scots to the PSAC Western Division championship with a school-record 35 wins and a 17-3 mark in the league. Edinboro made its first trip ever to the NCAA II regional championships and finished the regular season ranked number 16 in the country.

This is the sixth year for the Fighting Scots Baseball Camp under Coach Radovich. All campers receive a great deal of personalized instruction with a very good camper to staff ratio. It is a fundamentals camp, emphasizing all facets of the game and teaching the same concepts taught at the college and professional levels. "This is not a playtime camp. We expect a great deal from our campers as far as work ethic. We have a tremendous amount of fun as well, but be prepared to work hard and be willing to learn," commented Radovich.

CAMP STAFF

Coach Radovich staffs the camp with highly qualified collegiate and high school coaches. In addition, current Edinboro University players will teach various aspects of the camp during the week. The availability of such resources will allow for plenty of personalized instruction.

ELIGIBILITY

Players will be divided into groups by level of experience. Anyone 9 to 17 years old is eligible for the camp. NCAA rules prohibit anyone who is eligible to enter college in the fall of 1995 from attending our camp.

CAMP FEES: \$190.00 – resident camper
\$120.00 – commuter camper

Camps will run Sunday through Friday. Check-in registration is on Sunday between noon and 2:00 p.m. All campers will be given a meal pass for three meals a day. Meals begin Sunday at dinner time and end Friday at lunch.

Commuter campers will report to the dining hall for breakfast in the morning. They will depart after the evening session each day at approximately 8:30 p.m. Resident campers are housed in resident halls and will be staffed by camp counselors, instructors and Edinboro personnel. PLEASE BRING OWN LINENS AND PILLOWS.

Check out for residents will be after the Friday workout at approximately 4:00 p.m.

The camps will be conducted on the Edinboro University campus in Edinboro, Pennsylvania.

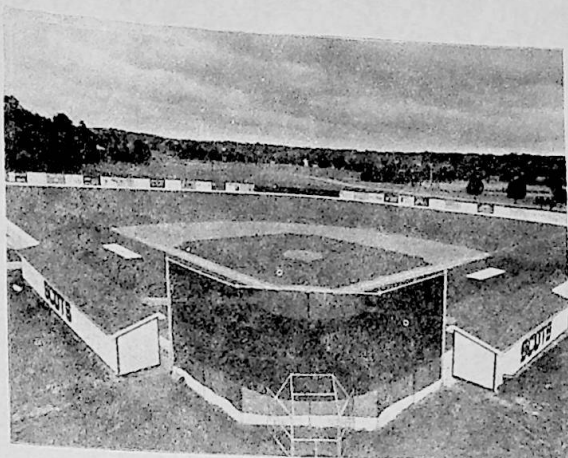

With the substantial field improvements since John Radovich's arrival, Edinboro now boasts one of the finest facilities in Division II baseball, including a major league caliber complex with two batting cages, large bullpens, and two practice fields.

Campers will also enjoy free use of the University's facilities:
