'Boro to Host D'Youville College in Non-Conference Game

The Edinboro Fighting Scot men's basketball team will host the Spartans of D'Youville College on Monday, Jan. 19, at McComb Fieldhouse with tip-off scheduled for 7:30 p.m.

Edinboro is now 12-4 overall and 3-1 in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference after splitting a pair of games last week. The Scots have won 11 of their last 13 games.

The last time out, the Boro men scored an 84-75 victory over the Red Raiders of Shippensburg University this past Saturday. Six Fighting Scots scored in double figures led by senior guard Jesse Ogden. Ogden hit five treys to give him 15 points for the game, including hitting four straight in the second half. Adam Kaufman continues to play well for the Boro. The freshman point guard from Coraopolis, PA hit four of five three-point attempts in the second half to give him 12 points in the contest. He handed out a game-high seven assists, and continues to lead the PSAC in assists per game with 7.4. Others in double digit scoring were Dwayne Butler (12), Amos Upshaw (10), Warren Chance (10), and Dominic Robinson (10).

Upshaw, the PSAC West's Rookie of the Week for the

past two weeks, had a game-high 12 rebounds and continues to lead the Scots on the boards averaging 7.3 rebounds per game. Butler is currently second on the team averaging 6.8. Chance (18.3), Butler (16.6), and Ogden (10.7) are the Boro's top scorers.

The Scots continue to hit from behind the three point line as the team averages just over 7.1 treys per game. Ogden has hit a team-best 49 from behind the arc, and is averaging 3.1 makes per game. Chance has hit a Boro-best .410 of his attempted threes.

In Saturday's win over Shippensburg, the Scots hit 51 percent of their shots from the floor, including a torrid .586 in the second half. As a team, the Scots recorded their highest free throw percentage, converting on nine of 10 attempts.

Ogden is appraoching a career milestone, the senior guard needs only 15 more points to break the 1,000-point plateau. Ogden holds five Edinboro records for three-point shooting, including threes in a single game (10 vs. Indiana, PA), threes in a season (106) and career (267).

D'Youville College comes in to tonight's game with an 0-14 record. The Spartans are led by freshman Rob Brodie. The 6-1 forward is averaging a team-best 8 points per game while also leading the squad in rebounds with 7.3 per contest.

D'Youville was in action this weekend as they dropped games to both Keuka College and Cazenovia College.

The Fighting Scots will next be in action on Wednesday, Jan. 21, when they host Central State out of Ohio. The marauders were 11-7 going into games this past weekend. The game is scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. start time at McComb Fieldhouse.


