## Fighting Scots Seek Fifth Straight Victory vs. Red Raiders

Ogden Poised To Break Mason's Career Three-Point FG Record

(EDINBORO, Pa.) ~ The Edinboro University men's basketball team will host Shippensburg University of Pennsylvania on Saturday, Jan. 18 at 3:00 p.m. at McComb Fieldhouse. The Fighting Scots, who are in first-place in the PSAC, are playing the third game of a four-game homestand. Edinboro will also host local rival Mercyhurst College on Jan. 22 at 7:30 p.m., before starting a three-game conference road trip that will take them to California (Pa.), Clarion and Lock Haven.

Edinboro (7-6 overall, 3-0 in the PSAC-West), led by eighth-year head coach Greg Walcavich, has won four games in a row, and five of their past six contests. The Scots have registered conference wins over Slippery Rock (77-71 in overtime), Lock Haven (82-70) and most recently, Indiana (90-70 on Jan. 15). In the win over the Indians, four different Scots scored in double-figures. Senior forward Antoine Jefferson made 10-13 (.769) shots from the field and led all scorers with a game-high 21 points. Senior forward Brian Ellis added 18 points, while Jesse Ogden (17 points) and Tim Miller (13 points) rounded out Edinboro's offensive leaders vs. IUP. Ogden also made three more three-point baskets in the contest, tying him with Tyrone Mason's career record of 165. He has been among the leaders in Division-II all-season in three-pointers made per game, and is averaging 4.1 treys a contest this season. Last year, the Scots won both games against the Red Raiders (94-83 at Shippensburg and 96-69 at Edinboro). Ogden scored a team-best 22 points in the game at Shippensburg, while senior guard Tyrone Mason led Edinboro with 31 points in the home victory. Shippensburg last defeated the Scots in the 1994-95 season, as they nipped EUP, 74-71. Walcavich is 11-3 vs. Shippensburg since arriving at Edinboro

"We have been playing very well lately and getting some solid contributions from a lot of people," said Walcavich. "It's always important to get off to a good start in conference play, and so far we have been able to achieve that."

Shippensburg, led by 27th year head coach Rodger Goodling, enters the contest at 5-10 overall and 1-1 in the PSAC-West. In their last game (Jan. 15), the Red Raiders dropped a 65-63 decision to Lock Haven University. Despite having four different starters scoring in double figures, Shippensburg could not overcome a 32-21 half-time deficit. Junior forward Kevin Lee and senior guard Brandon White both had a team-high 15 points for the 'Ship. White also had the Red Raiders only three-point basket in the contest. Shippensburg opened up PSAC-West play with a victory at Slippery Rock (80-70 on Jan. 11). Statistical leaders for Shippensburg include: Lee (16 ppg, 10.0 rpg), freshman forward Wayne Morris (1.7 blkpg, 2.1 stpg) and junior guard Tyrone Burton (3.2 apg). Shippensburg is 3-5 on the road this season.
