## Edinboro Men's Basketball Looks To Stay Undefeated In Conference Play

(EDINBORO, Pa.) ~ The Edinboro University men's basketball team will host Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference rival Indiana University of Pennsylvania on Wednesday, Jan. 15 at 8:00 p.m. at McComb Fieldhouse. The matchup will be the first of a home-and-home series between the two schools, as Edinboro will visit Indiana on Feb. 12.

The Scots (6-6 overall, 2-0 PSAC-West), led by eighth-year head coach Greg Walcavich, are seeking their third-straight conference win and fourth victory in a row. In their most recent game, Edinboro defeated Lock Haven University, 82-70 on Saturday (Jan 11) afternoon. Antoine Jefferson, the PSAC-West "Player of the Week," scored a team-high 25 points and pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds for the Scots in the victory. In his last two games, Jefferson has averaged 19 points and eight rebounds, in helping Edinboro off to 2-0 start in the conference. Senior center Brian Ellis continued his offensive hot-streak, scoring 15 points to go along with his 10 rebounds. Ellis also scored 22 points in a 77-71 victory at Slippery Rock in the Fighting Scots' PSAC opener on Jan. 8. Senior guard Dean Doss led the Scots' "passing attack" with a PSAC-best 14 assists against the Bald Eagles. Jefferson, who is ninth in the PSAC in scoring, at 16.8 ppg, is also second in the conference in field goal percentage, shooting 87-148 (.588) from the field. Junior forward Jesse Ogden, who averages a conference-best 4.2 three-point field goals a game, needs just five more three-pointers to pass Tyrone Mason's career record of 165. Offensively, the 'Boro is averaging 77.8 points per game, while allowing 74 points per contest. Last year, IUP won both games against the Scots, including a 74-73 come-from-behind victory at Edinboro. IUP also downed the Scots, 96-86 at Indiana and has won the past four meetings with the Scots. Edinboro last defeated IUP in February of the 1994-95 season, when they knocked off the then-number one team in Division II Indians in Indiana. Senior forward Corey Keyes (6.4 rpg) returns to the Scots after playing in the NCAA-Division II football all-star game last Saturday (Jan.11).

Indiana, guided by first-year head coach Gary Edwards, enters the game at 7-5 overall and 1-1 in the PSAC. In their last contest, the Indians defeated California University of Pa., 80-76, on Jan. 11. Senior guard Terrance Flowers led IUP with 21 points in the win. Junior forward Chuck Karl grabbed a team-high 12 rebounds for Indiana. The Indians dropped a 63-58 road decision to Lock Haven on Jan. 8, in their PSAC-West opener. Flowers (20.3 ppg) and Karl (9.6 rpg) both rank second in the PSAC in scoring and rebounding, respectively. Karl also is shooting a conference-best 89.5% (34-38) from the free-throw line. Indiana is averaging 73.3 points per game, and allowing opponents to score 74.3 points per contest. Indiana assistant coach Kevin Reynolds makes his return to the 'Boro. The Indians are 1-2 on the road in 1996-97. Reynolds served as an assistant coach for Walcavich during the 1995-96 season.
