The team shows strength in both base running and hitting but its major strength lies in the exceptional field defense.

The BSC softball team will be looking for not only a fine season record but also a bid for the Pennsylvania Conference Championships and the EAIAW Division III Regional Championships.





## **COACHING STAFF**

JAN HUTCHINSON, a member of the Health, Physical Education and Athletics staff at BSC since January 1978, is in her third year as head softball coach. She is also the Husky field hockey coach.

A native of Newton, NJ, Mrs. Hutchinson received her Bachelor of Science degree in 1971 from East Stroudsburg State College and her Master of Education degree in Physical Education from the same institution in 1979.

Before coming to BSC, Mrs. Hutchinson was on the faculty at Blair Academy, Blairstown, NJ, where she initiated the women's interscholastic sports program and served as head coach of field hockey, basketball and softball. Her softball coaching record while at Blair included 51 wins, 13 losses and several trips to the state championship finals.
