I am simply loafing around today. I am on detail as room orderly today. I swept the

place this morn-
ing, swept and
scrubbed the bath-
house, cleaned about
twelve commodes,
carried six or eight
buckets of water, -
outside of that, I
hain't done very
much.

There was a
large number of
new fellows came
in yesterday. They
have them lined
up all around,
giving them their
physical examina-

tions and drilling them.

I did not do very much Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. I was sort of on the sick list those days. I do not know whether it was coming from my vaccinations, or not.
