Communique (4 folders), 1984-1991

Includes social events, grants, positions available, retirements/appointments, sporting events, piece done on nuclear war, "in memory" section, commencement, recognition of certain faculty members, BU enrollment, "BU Notes" section, "See You There..." section (added in 1987; highlights upcoming social, athletic, and art exhibits), special issue devoted to Draft Governance Structure for Bloomsburg University (1987), "Personnel and Labor Relations" section (added in 1987), and administrative decisions (budget, tuition, policies, and more)

Communique (5 Folders), 1992-2000

Includes faculty changes and recognition (retirements, promotions, appointments, and openings), calendar (social, athletics, and lectures), social issues (heavily dealing with racism and increasing diversity/social equity), grants/scholarships, administrative decisions (budget, tuition, policies, enrollment, and more), commencement, and crime reports

A shorter summarized version of Communique that was issued daily via email; includes faculty recognition (retirements, promotions, appointments, and openings), social and athletic events, weather reports, announcements important pertaining to students, weekly schedule of events, daily lunch menu, and announcements of special events or notices of things going on around campus or in town
