#### TENNIS OUTLOOK

Predicting the outcome of eight varsity intercollegiate tennis matches to be played by the Bloomsburg squad this year, would be a tough job for anyone. This is the first time in nearly a score of years that the activity has ranked as a varsity sport.

Only two members of the team have had any experience in competition, and none of them have had experience at the intercollegiate level.

## CRAIG L. HIMES, VARSITY TENNIS COACH

Varsity tennis and Coach Craig Himes are both newcomers to Bloomsburg State College campus this year. Himes joined the faculty in September, 1961, as a member of the Science Department, and shortly after, was appointed tennis coach.

A 1949 graduate of Clarion State College, Coach Himes taught eight years in the South Butler County Joint Schools, a year in the Butler Area Joint Schools, and two years with the Army Dependent Schools in Orleans, France. He also spent a year as a Graduate Research Assistant at the University of Pittsburgh where he earned the Master of Science Degree in Botany in 1957.

While in France, Himes was active in athletics in the role of Assistant Football Coach and Head Basketball Coach. His cagers amassed a record of 19 wins and 7 losses, and finished in fourth place in the European Tournament at Bremerhaven, Germany, in 1959.
