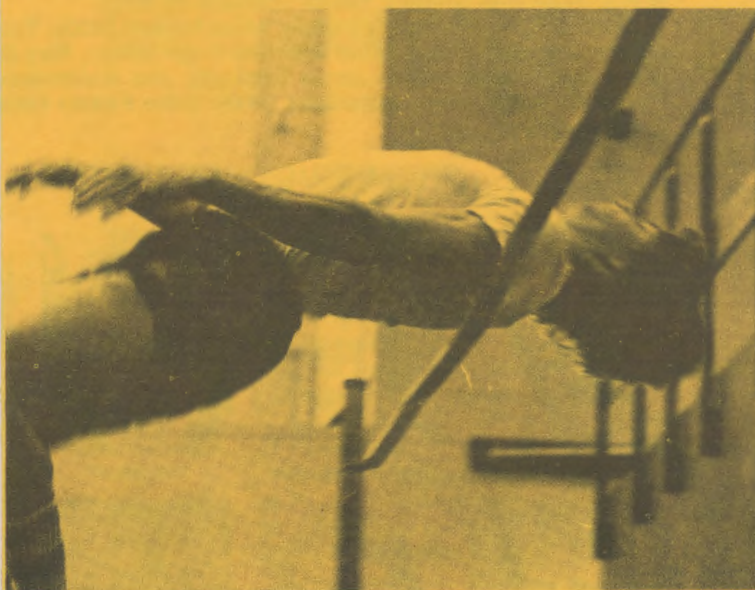

SEASON'S OUTLOOK

The Bloomsburg State College Husky Track slate reflects an optimistic outlook for head coach **Carl Hinkle** and his staff for the 1979 outdoor season. Past performances with competent lettermen and some promising freshmen should continue the Husky tradition of being a top contender in the Pennsylvania Conference race.

Last year BSC was 8-4 for indoor track and 5-5 during the outdoor season. Distance runner Steve Eachus and high jumper Jeff Carruthers gained All-American honors for the second consecutive year.

Carruthers leads the returnees this year since Eachus graduated in December. In addition to his All-American honors, he is a two-time conference champion and team captain. His 7'¼" school record last year makes him a prime prospect for national honors again this year.

Eachus, a two-time All-American, was the greatest distance runner in BSC history. In 1978 he won both the 5,000 and 10,000 meter events in the PC competition and placed second in the 5,000 meters at the NCAA Division II nationals. In 1977, he was the NCAA Division II 10,000 meter champion.

Other returnees include: cross country captain and track co-captain Mark Bond (steeple chase); national qualifier and 1977 PC champion and state record holder, Carter White (880 meters); national qualifier and PC runner-up, Ken Curcio (110 meter hurdler); national qualifier Jim Mailey (100 meters); national qualifier and PC runner-up, Robert McIntosh (100 meters); PC runner-up, Jerry Werkheiser (triple jump); PC runner-up, Chuck Stathopoulos (high jump); Bob Kantner (mile); Gary Coldren (shot and discus); Mark Wark (pole vault); Rich Loman (I.H.); Pete Henzy (400); Steve Johnson (5,000).

Promising new talent includes: Mike Nelson (800); Tom Graff (mile); Chuck Johnson (mile); Mike Wenrich (high jump); Ray Distasio (shot); Chris Hager (shot); Rick Jones (discus); Joe Malinowski (I.H.); Scott Feinstein (400); Gary Gottschalk (400); John Feeley (mile); Brad Tozer (pole vault).

COACHING STAFF

Carl Hinkle, Assistant Professor of Physical Education, joined the BSC faculty and coaching staff in September of 1971. In addition to his teaching assignments in Health and Physical Education, he is in his third year as head track coach. He also serves as an assistant football coach (8 yrs.) as a defensive specialist.



A native of Berwick, Pennsylvania, Hinkle received his B.S. Degree from Montana State University and the M.S. Degree from Ithaca College. His coaching experience involves two years in public schools and the colleges of Ithaca, Cornell and Cortland State before coming to Bloomsburg in 1971.

In his last two years as head track coach, the Huskies have compiled consecutive winning seasons. Each year Bloomsburg has been represented in the NCAA Division II Nationals with three individuals he has coached, taking five All-American honors.

Assisting Hinkle are **Stewart Nagle**, Associate Professor of Art at BSC, and **Joe Kelly** of the Central Columbia School District.
