Miss Henderson received a B.S. Degree from Miami University, Ohio, and a M.A. Degree from Columbia University, New York. She began her teaching career as an instructor in Physical Education in Piqua, Ohio, and later moved to Williamson, West Virginia. In 1926 Miss Henderson arrived at Shippensburg to teach Health and Physical Education. She left this campus from 1936-1946 to take a position with Lebanon Valley College. Returning to Shippensburg in 1946, she has remained here until the present time.

Our time in college is characterized by expansion in numbers of students and marked increase in standards of achievement. This is good for our Commonwealth; it is exciting and gratifying to you as students.


In the outside world we have exploding populations, breathtaking break-throughs in science and technologies, with old ideas and ideals being replaced right and left and not always for the better.

Getting off to a fast start and playing tremendous football all season, the Red Raiders of Coach Jack Roddick finished the season with six wins and two losses.





The leading ground gainer was freshman Mel Williams, who also had the highest average gain per carry. The leading pass receiver and top scorer was John Freeland.



The record of the team was good enough to give the


Raiders a final conference standing of second place.

Preparation and enthusiasm is noted for days before an important game or match, and competition is keen but friendly among the teams.






