At least my windshield wipers worked!






Before the start of the 1979 football season, it appeared that the Shippensburg Red Raiders were destined to repeat as Western Division Champions in the PA Conference, the title they shared with California in 1978. Under rookie head coach Vito Ragazzo, the team struggled to a disappointing 4 - 6 record, their first non-winning season since 1973.

For the month of September the season seemed to be going as planned. SSC won three of their first four games, including an upset victory over Slippery Rock, 54 - 14, at Michigan Stadium. On October 6th things began to unravel. The Raiders were leading Indiana, 24 - 9, after three quarters only to fall behind and lose, 31 - 24, as the Indiana team posted 22 points in the final quarter. From this Saturday on, the Raiders were able to defeat only one more opponent - Edinboro, 28 - 18.

In spite of the misfortunes of the team as a whole, some old school records were broken as several individuals had outstanding seasons. Defensive end John Wertz tied the school record for career quarterback sacks with 23. He set a single season record with five opponent fumble recoveries. His career total of 125 solo tackles also marked a school record. Safety Brian Clement finished his career at SSC with a new school record of 13 interceptions for 213 yards. Cornerback Linwood Bradley intercepted 11 opponent passes to tie the old school record. Linebacker John Pavin had 51 solo tackles to set a new school single season record.







It was the chance of a lifetime. Two small Pennsylvania schools, Shippensburg and Slippery Rock, were going to square off in Michigan Stadium, in Ann Arbor, before one of the biggest crowds in NCAA Division II history! Although Slippery Rock was the crowd favorite, the Red Raiders soundly crushed the Rock, 45 – 14.

The star of the game was freshman running back Steve Moskowitz who broke for two touchdowns on runs of 75 and 63 yards. It was the chance of a lifetime!







The team was composed of seven outstanding returning lettermen and a big group of nine promising freshmen. Included are seniors Brett Wagner and Tyrone Cornbower; juniors Gregg Sanders, Gary Bicking, and Dave Weisgerber; sophomores Mike Knause and Mike LaMarca; and freshmen Jim McHenry, Steve Shaull, Nick Boyer, Todd Zimmerman, Mike Erdley, Brad Diehl, Bob Ricks, Mike Gilligan, and Jim Talailai. Together they composed a total win/loss record of 86 — 22, only being narrowly defeated twice by Millersville and Indiana in dual meets; fourth at the Lebanon Valley Invitational, fourth at the California Invitational, fourth at the Penn State Open Meet, third at the Division II Northeast Regional Meet, and proudly boasts being eighth in the nation in Division II. The team and SSC is also proud to have another All-American in Gregg Sanders who placed ninth overall in the nation. Always remember: Behind every superstar is a team that pushed him and made him work for his achievements.

In the words of the Raider's Gary Bicking, 1979 PA State Conference 1500 meter champion: "We worked hard all year . . . as a team; we had our moments of triumph and defeat . . . as a team; we enjoyed ourselves and had a good time . . . as a team; and we combined all these things and placed eighth in the nation . . . as a team."

Despite the loss of SSC's first All-American John Doub, the team returned just as strong as last year and proved to get even stronger as the season progressed. Coach Paul Kaiser recognized this hungry desire in his team and geared them through much planning, sacrifice, and strategy that brought the success to the team. The team stayed hungry the entire season and never showed signs of weakening or losing sight of their goals. From Lebanon Valley to Nationals, the Raiders remained very intense about their running. From the experience of senior co-captains Brett Wagner and Tyrone Cornbower, the team derived the inner strength along with their physical strength, to run the best possible races that they could — always 100% or better. V Veteran SSC runner Brett Wagner summed up the season as: "definitely the best team we've ever had. I'm very proud of our complete team efforts because we accomplished our goals and even went beyond them."

The SSC men's swim team hung up their suits after the completion of a successful 11-2 season.




The women swimmers displayed their talents by placing fifth at the Philadelphia Invitational and capturing third at the PA Conference Championships held at Indiana University



in late February. Conference winners included Debbie Polak, Michelle Priest, Patti Grove, Liz Beall, Kelly Lightner, and Missy Brown.


With nine qualifying team members

Taking seventh at Nationals, returning with eight All-Americans, and completing a 15-1 season, the women swimmers again proved their excellence.





are not easily accomplished and Corman attributes much of his success to all the young people who sacrificed their time for the sport.



Coach John Trail had a team of returning starters with the exception of three positions. The team should be back as strong as ever in 1981 losing only two players to graduation.



Coached by John Hubert the team won key matches against Shepherd (5-4), Messiah (8-1), East Stroudsburg (5-4), and Juniata.


Coach Sara McGrath and the SSC women's tennis team was led by captain Karen Hart and a group of returning veterans. Several talented freshmen rounded out the squad.


was pleased with the defense, especially with goaltender Patti McElroy who had a terrific season.

The squad garnered third place in the second game, a rematch against Millersville, with a 14-3 win. Satina noted that it was the best game of the season and the girls' passing was excellent.



Next year's squad should return just as tough as this one, losing only a few to graduation and anticipating the return of Fichter, Dotzman, and Ross.

When the SSC Raider track and field team opened their season in late March, the outlook appeared very dim for the team to be a contender in the conference — costly injuries, some weak events, and not enough talent plagued a young and hungry squad.

It was very difficult for the team to perceive great success in the distance events due to four crucial injuries to key distance runners. Gary Bicking, Gregg Sanders, Dave Wiesgerber, Steve Shaull were all sidelined for an unquestionable period of time early in the season. Gary Bicking was the only one of the four to overcome his injury and make a magnificent comeback. His first race back on the track told him where he stood and he played it smart by training hard and avoiding injury.

The season started out slow due to the cancellations of several meets. After impressive wins over Millersville, Kutztown, and Alfred, the team gained momentum to roll past Bloomsburg, but was halted by a solid East Stroudsburg team. They got back on the track by defeating Messiah, Gettysburg, Juniata, and Lock Haven. "This was one of our best seasons ever, compiling an 8-1 record, we beat teams that we haven't beaten before," claimed Coach Paul Kaiser. The 8-1 season was only the tip of iceberg as the team made a vicious assault on the record books.

The records started to crumble late

in the season around the championship meets. One such record, the 100m. dash (10.8), was set in the opening meet by veteran Phil Silver who later became hampered by a nagging injury. This record was later tied by teammate Tom Trea. The 1600m relay record showed signs of disappearing in the first meet. The quartet of 400m men came back after running other events to speed to a sizzling 3:21, just missing the record. From there the time gradually went down until the Lock Haven meet where it was broken — the first time. The second time came at IUP where the record time went from 3:19 to 3:16. At the conference meet it was lowered to 3:15. Todd Leber broke the 400m record twice, first going 49.3 and then 49.0 at the conference. He broke a record that had been standing for 49 years. Gary Witmer consistently tied the high jump record throughout the season until the conference meet where he set a new record of 6'8". The 3200m relay quartet of freshman Mike Gilligan, veteran Steve Taylor, freshman Todd Zimmerman, and Gary Bicking broke the old record by 18 seconds recording an outstanding 7:40.7 at the Millersville Relays. Gary Bicking, after recovering from an injury, set two SSC records in both the 1500 and 800m runs. Gary ran 3:51 in the 1500 against Lock Haven to break the record and qualify for Division II Nationals. At the conference meet, he ran

1:52 in the 800m to set a new SSC record.



The conference meet was the icing on the cake after an almost perfect season. It was one that made the coaching staff very happy. In the field, Coach Basehoar's men got much-needed points. Pole vaulter Doug Bushong soared 14-6 for a third. Ed Noon, '79 conference champ in both the long and triple jumps repeated his '79 effort, gaining two golds and the distinction of Outstanding Fieldman at the meet. Dan Specia, a top javelin thrower in the conference, chucked the spear for a fourth place. Shot-putter Jack Slick hoisted the shot for a fifth. Gary Witmer, the SSC record holder in the high jump, went 6'8" for a third and a new record.

On the track seniors Phil Silver and Tom Trea got fourth and sixth respectively in the 100m. In the 400m Todd Leber got a fifth in a record 49.0. In the 400m hurdles Todd Zimmerman and Tom Austin blazed to a solid 2-3 finish. Gary Bicking and Steve Taylor went 2-3 in the 800m run, both under previous SSC records. Bicking won the 1500m run and earned the Outstanding Trackman award at the meet. After all the points were tallied, Slippery Rock won with 158 points, SSC placed second with 93, and East Stroudsburg was third with 79.

Raiders Gary Bicking, Todd Zimmerman, and Tom Austin traveled to the national meet.






The SSC Raiderette track team, only in its second year of competition, established four new records at the Lock Haven meet and showed their talents on the track as well as in the field.




SSC had a strong backing in the field events and depth in the distance events, but was lacking in sprints and hurdles.




My deepest personal thanks goes out to a select group who deserve more than these few words. To Deb


The violent protests of the 60's carried over into the 70's. May, 1970 marked the killing of four students at a Viet Nam protest rally at Kent State.

The Watergate scandal put Washington in an uproar, caused the public to lose faith in their elected officials, and forced Richard Nixon to resign.





Once they got through the lines, they had quite a shock waiting for them at the pumps.






Militant students captured the American Embassy in Iran, holding our citizens captive under the leadership of Ayatollah Khomeini.


Things even happened at SSC. New buildings, a new president, and new programs were added.

For many, the Big Mac and other junk food became an integral part of the American diet.




Culture went "pop" as the treasures of King Tut went on display, attracting thousands.


