


home- coming




Hey, how come they never show it raining in the college catalogue?

Well, at least the preppies like the rain. It gives them a chance to wear their duck shoes and matching slickers.









Masquers/Music Theater had another successful season of performances in Memorial Auditorium. A select group of students, as well as faculty, poured their hearts and souls into the three shows this year.







Ladies and gentlemen, will you please give a warm welcome for . . . ROAR!!!

Janet Cooke defaulted a Pulitzer, and Robert DeNiro won an Oscar for a film about boxing.










You breathe a sigh of relief as the first exchange day rolls around. A whole 24 hours off without pledging. Your big brother takes you out to the G-Man!





Although the team did not advance into post-season play, ten individuals were honored for their outstanding seasonal play.

In conference action the Harriers were undefeated, outrunning all opponents and tying Indiana, 32-23.

At the Lehigh Invitational, in early October, the men competed against the top Division I teams in the East. Sanders captured seventh place at Lehigh, gaining points for a Raider fifth place finish.

Early in the season, the Raiderettes placed second at the Lebanon Valley Invitational and one week later took third honors at the Kutztown Invitational.


Ann Musser and Bebe Robinson led the team to a 14-20 record competing against some of the best runners in the area, during dual meets and at the Invitational races.


Co-captains Fichter and Peg Pribish led the team in points tallied. Fichter set a school career scoring record with 49 goals.




Game after game, basket after basket, locker room after locker room, the Red Raiders dribbled to their third straight winning season in 1981. In spite of completing the tour with a 14-11 mark, many of the players packed away their sneakers and basketballs disappointed at narrowly missing a berth in the Pennsylvania Conference tournament.

The team started off well, taking three of its first four match-ups. In early January, the Raiders hit their stride, capturing first place honors in the Carlisle Kiwanis tourney with victories over Dickinson and Gettysburg. During the second half of the schedule, the hoopsters played well in streaks while losing a few close games.

Brian Cozzens led the Raider five with a school record-breaking 61 per cent from the field. Other standouts on the squad in '81 were junior guard Ed Henninger, sophomore point guard Rich Dyer, and sophomore forwards Tom Triggs and Tim Marks.

Coach Rodger Goodling is losing only three seniors from the '81 roster. In addition to starter Scott, reserve guard and co-captain Dan Farrell and center Art Fairbanks have graduated.

With many talented veterans and recruits at practice next fall, the Raiders are looking forward to taking the PA Conference by storm in 1982.


At the Clarion Relays, the SSC team took a second place and garnered the top spot at the Indiana Relays.

The SSC grapplers, under the guidance of Coach Bill Corman, jumped off to a good start with two wins over Kutztown and Indiana and ended the season with three consecutive wins over Mansfield, Towson, and Waynesburg.

The Raiders finished the season with a 10-12 record, hampered by mid-season losses to Lock Haven, Bloomsburg, James Madison, and East Stroudsburg.



Pitching led the way to a banner regular season as the Raiders won 30 games. The squad won 18 of their last 19 games, finishing the campaign ranked eighth in the nation among Division II schools. The team won all games against Division II schools, losing only eight games to Division I caliber teams. They won the PA Eastern Division title, winning all 10 games.

York-area hurlers John Seitz and Dave Miller posted identical 7-1 records, leading the staff. Seitz (3.07 era, 44) highlighted the season with a near-perfect no-hitter against Mt. St. Mary's. Miller fired a one-hitter against Mansfield in his best outing. Both pitchers hurled 52 plus innings, far more than anyone else. Joe Darrenkamp led the bullpen hurlers with two wins and five saves.

The Raiders also tallied enough runs, outscoring opponents 269-154. Brian Snell (.366) also led in runs batted in with 28 hits-41, and extra base hits, 16. Freshman John Diehl led the regulars in batting with a .376 average. Centerfielder Glenn Gallagher was second, hitting .371. Gallagher scored 28 runs, stole 14 bases, and stroked 39 hits. Catcher Tom Stoudt was second in rbi's plating 25 Raiders.

Miller and Seitz picked up all but one of the conference wins, going 9-0 in league games. Although senior leftfielder Jeff Laspina hit .236, he came through in the clutch, batting better than .300 against conference pitching.

Losing only three key players including Laspina, Darrenkamp, and first baseman Kris Hitchins, the team should be as strong next year. Freshman reliever Mike Reed (3-0) may be asked to fill Darrenkamp's spot and others will help to improve the team's 30-8 record.



The Raiderettes showed a great improvement in their play during the regular season as well as in the PA Conference, moving from 11th to sixth.



The Raiderettes will play all their matches in the fall, ending the season with the PA Conference Championships.







programs, the student trips to Old Main became much more frequent. The Financial Aid Office became a regular stop.

Go forward proudly under the Red and Blue!



It was 1957, Ford initiated their ill-fated Edsel campaign while Bridgette Bardot made her first film appearance. The East was wracked by a severe drought and Ike was in the White House. The Giants and Dodgers left New York for the West Coast. The Soviets launched the first ICBM — forever changing the concept of global warfare. Against this scenario Gilmore B. Seavers began his administrative career at Shippensburg.

Arriving at Shippensburg State Teachers College in 1957, Gilmore Seavers assumed the post of Director of Admissions. Seavers was no stranger to Shippensburg — having received his bachelor's degree from the college. Undoubtedly, the campus had changed since his undergraduate days. However, the developments to unfold during the ensuing years

would drastically alter the face of SSC.

Under the direction of President Ralph Heiges, a graduate program was added in 1959. By 1962, Shippensburg shed the constraints of being solely a teachers college. A liberal arts and sciences program supplemented the existing curriculum. Shippensburg embarked on a campaign of growth and development. The former teachers college was renamed Shippensburg State College by the Pennsylvania State Assembly.

One year later, Seavers was promoted to the post of Administrative Assistant to the President after having served as Dean of Student Personnel. Also during that year, one of Seavers' first projects became a reality. Shippen Hall opened its doors for classes. Seavers had been one of the original committee members who participated in the planning of the new

facility.

The completion of Shippen Hall heralded an era of expansion for the college. Since the beginning of his administrative career until his appointment as president, Seavers witnessed the completion of twelve buildings, the construction of six others, and the inclusion of a business program, and the enrollment grow from 924 to over 3700 students. Just as the school continued to broaden its horizons, Seavers also increased his scope of understanding. He received his doctorate from the Pennsylvania State University in 1965.

Seavers' doctoral thesis involved an extensive study of the impact of state policy in higher education in Pennsylvania. Dr. Seavers is considered an expert on this subject and has repeatedly urged a greater autonomy for the state college and university system. Dr. Seavers had visions of an even greater growth for Shippensburg. The stage was set for further development.

By 1969, Americans had walked on the moon. Nixon was in the White House while American troops were in Viet Nam. The Saturday Evening Post

Under the new president's supervision, SSC celebrated its centennial year. From September, 1970 through May of 1971, the college continued its expansion. Franklin Science Center, Heiges Field House, the CUB, Dauphin Humanities Center, and Mowrey Hall were all completed to further meet the needs of the changing campus.

SSC also formed a joint ROTC program with neighboring colleges. The SSC/Dickinson Army ROTC program expanded to include 19 male and female undergrads. The co-op Air Force Program at Gettysburg was comprised of 17 members. The International Education Program played host to 18 foreign students.

The physical appearance of the college had finally jelled by the mid-70's. However, President Seavers sought to implement two other changes. After intensive lobbying, the college calendar was altered to its present two-term system. The number of required credit hours for graduation was lowered from 128 to 120.

In 1975, President Seavers announced the addition of a bachelor of science program in office administration to the SSC curriculum. However, the big news of the year was the construction of an apart-

had ceased weekly publication. Dr. Seavers had assumed the post of Vice President of the college. One year later, four students would be killed in an anti-war protest at Kent State, William Calley would be indicted in the My Lai Massacre, and Al Unser would win the Indy 500. Dr. Gilmore B. Seavers would then be appointed the President of Shippensburg State College.


ment-style dormitory complex for the campus — the first of its kind in the PA State School system. The complex was lauded for its economical approach, to student housing. The absence of corridors, elevators, and large central bathrooms and lounges actually decreased the cost of construction. Seavers apartments would house the students moving out of the Horton Hall and Old Main residences. At the same time, a 16-bed health center was to be erected across from the new apartments.

President Seavers was also active in community affairs. He has been involved with the board of directors for the South Central Educational Broadcasting Council, Capital Blue Cross, the United Telephone Company, and the Cumberland Valley Savings and Loan Association. Taking time out from his busy schedule, Dr. Seavers has also spoken at various area high school commencements and honors programs.

Finally, after 23 years of service to SSC, Gilmore B. Seavers announced his retirement as of December 26, 1980. The Board of Trustees accorded him the honor of President Emeritus. Dr. Seavers and his wife currently reside in Carlisle, where the former president still maintains an active role in the community.
