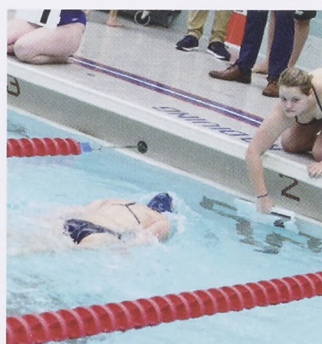

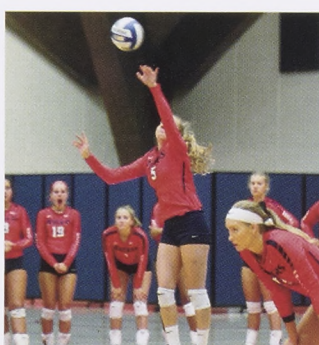

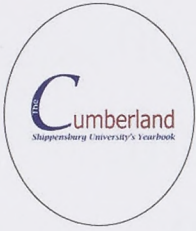
## Defending the Regional Title

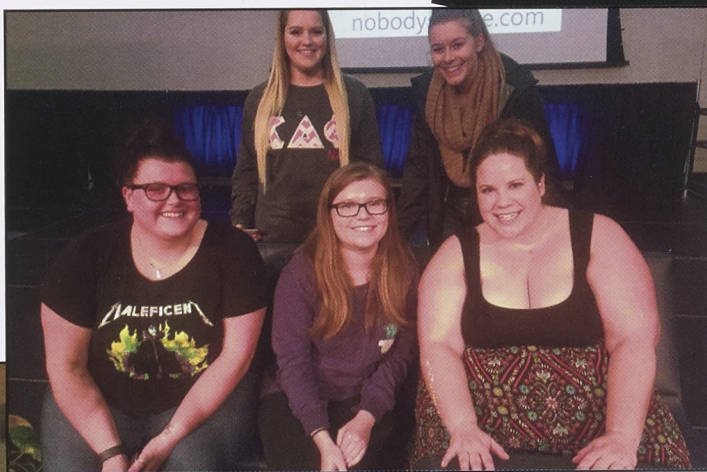

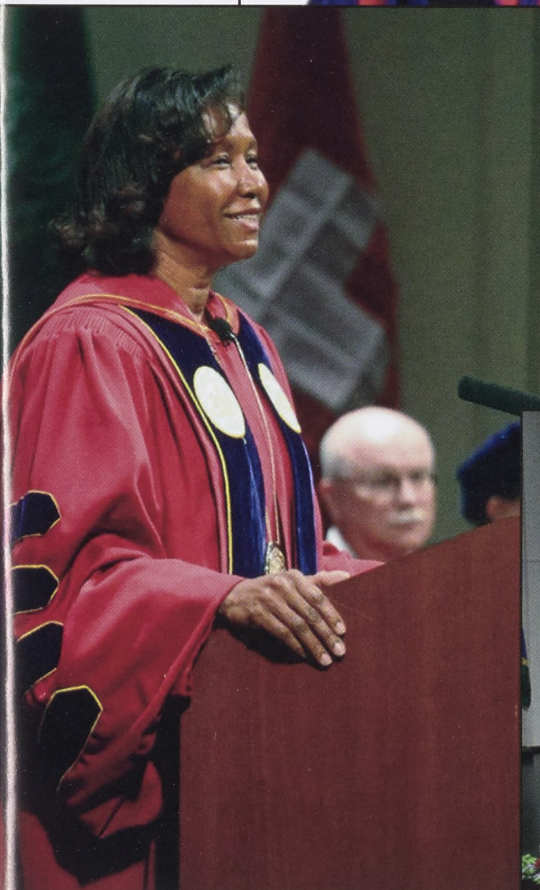

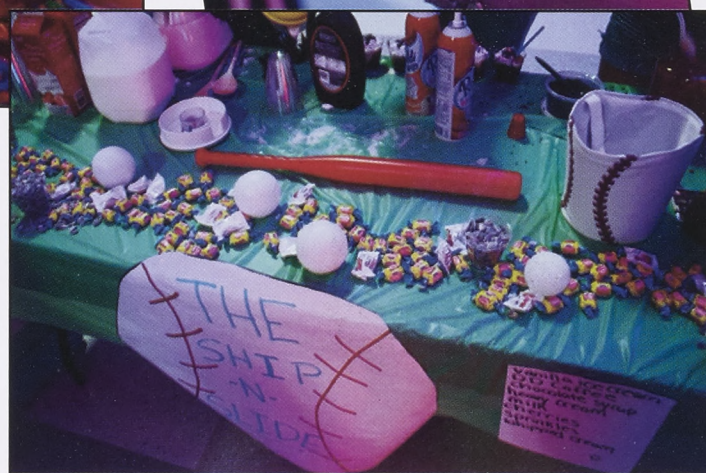
