Otherwise the changes in present-day Greenwich Village, both in customs and surroundings, would not reinforce our interpretation of the play. Although some suggestions of current goings-on which we have injected into the play may smack of Shavinism, we used them in order to help young actors dig deeply into a play which touches many American problems and gives us a look at American institutions. But the problems and institutions are no longer peculiarly American - they belong to the world, the whole world, and not only that part seen through Sidney's window.
