Recognized University Organization Policy

Organizations receiving the Recognized University Organization (RUO) designation have been classified as such because their operations have been deemed critical to the mission of the University, the University provides and/or funds an advisor for the organization, the organization provides extensive service to the University and/or community and/or the organization is comprised primarily of students but requires extensive faculty and/or staff involvement to successfully operate.

An organization may be deemed an RUO at the discretion of the University President and with a 2/3 vote of the Student Senate. RUOs will enjoy the same privileges of recognition as Recognized Student Organizations; will be required to submit administrator/advisor contact information, a roster of members and student leadership contact information (where applicable) at the beginning of each fall semester or as the information changes and will be eligible to receive funding directly from the Clarion Students' Association (CSA) Board.

The following is a current listing of those organizations with RUO status: The Clarion Call, Clarion International Association (CINTA), Club Sports, Fraternity & Sorority Affairs, Interhall Council, Leadership Programs, Minority Student Services Leadership Council, Speech & Debate Team, Student Senate, University Activities Board (UAB), University Athletics, Music RUO, and University Theatre.
