The board also voted to cut overall amounts of funding to RUO and RSO by 11.75%. This cut was lower than expected, expected at least a 15% decrease. Board voted to increase the activity fee an additional \$20.00 over and above the automatic CPI increase. The motion was passed unanimously. Thank you Senate for your recommendation.
