J. Faculty Senate Report- Senator Skunda

The Faculty Senate met today. Maryanne talked about changes to bookstore. Pearson will now be rent only and transition into eBook formats. Cullo discussed the budget. The budget was pretty flat, but there was a little bit of a deficit because of a decrease in enrollment.

Faculty Senate also discussed housing. The University is going to buy housing back from The Foundation. This is supported by the state system's chancellor and Clarion University's president. Clarion has to prove to the state system that it is beneficial to us. As of right now the foundation is in control of financing housing using 30-year bonds. If we can fill the housing to 85% of the maximum capacity, they can pay back on the bonds easily. As of right now, The Suites on Main are at 60-70% filled, the Hilltop Suites are 80% filled, and Reinhard Apartments are 90% filled. By buying it back, we would be able to refinance the bonds and have control over the housing prices. We would then be able to lower housing prices. This would attract more potential students and would boost on-campus living. This will not change the 2 year on campus policy. It will allow Clarion to be more flexible with how we incentivize students to stay on campus. The university is also looking into adding other Living Learning Communities, such as animal friendly and quiet living groups.
