

Clarion University Student Senate Meeting Minutes

- I. Call to Order
 - A. President Mason called the meeting of the Fall 2020 semester of the Clarion University Student Senate to order at 7:30.

 - 1. The CSA Board meeting was last Thursday.
 - 2. The integration process with Edinboro and CalU has not really taken off that much yet.
 - a) There are financial reasons for integration, which was brought up due to a concern of the possibility of getting rid of some unnecessary administrative positions rather than just faculty. Less faculty could hurt the quality of the education offered at Clarion.
 - (1) This could be brought up to the Faculty Senate.
 - (2) A concern was brought up that the university does have to meet a certain ratio of faculty to students.
 - 3. Dr. Dale will be coming to a meeting soon.
