

## LOCAL CONSTITUTION

### Beta Beta Beta Biological Society of Clarion University of Pennsylvania

Preamble - This constitution of the local chapter of Tri Beta at Clarion University of Pennsylvania hereby supplements the National Constitution of the Beta Beta Beta Biological Society with its own laws which only apply to the needs of the local chapter Upsilon Xi as to the date of Spring Semester 1979.

#### Article I

##### Name

This chapter shall be known as the Beta Beta Beta Biological Society of Clarion University of Pennsylvania.

#### Article II

##### Purpose

The purpose of this society is to promote scholarship and honor the high achievement in the majors of biology.

#### Article III

##### Membership

In compliance with (Article IV Section 2) of the 1978 National Constitution:

Section I - The requirements for active membership at C.U.P. include all of the following:

- a. The student must be a Biology, Biology Education, or Med Tech major;
- b. The student must have completed at least 3 Biology courses;
- c. The student must have a Q.P.A. of at least 3.0 in Biology and a minimum Q.P.A. of 2.0 overall.

Section II - Membership in the society shall be granted to those who meet these requirements and those required in (Article IV Section 1-5).

Section III - No one shall be excluded from membership because of race, color, creed, sex, or religion.
